

- **2011 Gallety Cotes du Vivarais** (\$15)
 50% Grenache, 50% Syrah
 From the Ardèche region of the Rhone, This wine comes from very old Grenache and Syrah vines, average of 50 years old. This gives the wines extra layers of wild berry fruit tinged with local herb, thyme and garrigue flavours, deep concentration, power and complexity. Biodynamic. **Was \$26, Now \$15**
- **2007 Il Celeste Chianti Clasico Reserva** (\$15)
 90% Sangiovese, 10% Caniolo
 Potent, luscious and velvety, with notes of black berry and raspberry fruit. It shows perfect ripeness and balance. Savoury, spicy finish in oak frame. **Was \$24, Now \$15**
- **2007 Quinta do Carma** (\$15)
 40% Aragonez, 30% Alicante Bouschet, 20%Trincadeira, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon
 A big Portuguse Red with complex aromas of red fruits and traces of vanilla. It is a very balanced and elegant wine that has a good structure, concentrated flavors and soft tannins. **Was \$23, Now \$15**
- **2011 Chapoutier Pinteivera** (\$15)
 Toriga Nacional
 From Rhone producer, M. Chapoutier, this is a new venture. The style is elegant while also powerful and complex. It brings out strong minerality, black currant fruit and tense acidity. **Was \$30, Now \$15**
- **2013 Avignonesi Vino Nobile di Montepulciano** (\$33)
 Sangiovese
 "There's loads of Sangiovese character here, from the earthy, tobacco-scented beginning to the cherry, leather and earth flavors, all underlined by stiff, chalky tannins. Rustic yet soulful.
- **2012 Les Mille Vignes Fitou Atsuko** (\$25)
 Grenache
 Only produced in exceptional vintages, Atsuko is a regal expression of seventy-five-year-old Grenache, taut with energy and buried layers of complexity that will unfurl onto your palate and over many years in bottle. Organic **Was \$70 now \$25**
