

SIX REDS

- **2011 I Campi Valpolicella Ripasso** \$15
85% Corvina and Corvinone, 10% Rondinella 5% Croatina
Rich and persistent aromas with hints of dried cranberry. The palate is powerful and enveloping of black cherry and currant. **Was \$28 now \$15**

- **2015 Podere La Berta Sangiovese Superiore** \$14
A delicious Sangi from Emilio Romagna with notes of red fruits like cherry, strawberry and plum. Fresh and lively in the mouth, sweet and fragrant, with soft tannins, good structure, with a rich and enveloping ending.

- **2013 Scopone Rosso di Montalcino** \$13
Sangiovese
Big aromas of cherry and olive notes come floating off this wine. The palate is more chewy with a dry finish.
Was \$20 now \$13

- **2013 Kennedy Shah Merlot** \$14
A NW Merlot with aromas of dusty black cherry and black cherry with cocoa. Inside, it's filled with dark plum and currants, backed by blueberry skin tannins and a black licorice finish.

- **2012 Domaine Sorin Cotes de Provence Tradition** \$11
60% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 15% Carignan, 5% Mourvèdre
A southern French Red powerfully flavored and full-bodied wine with complex aromas of blackberries and peppers. **Was \$14 now \$11**

- **2015 Notre Dame des Pallieres Les Riens Cotes du Rhone** \$10
60% Grenache, 35% Syrah, 5% Cinsault
A good everyday Cotes Du Rhône from a Gigondas winery.

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SIX WHITES

- ☐ **2013 I Campi Campo Volcano Soave** \$14
Garganega
A rich Soave from Flavio Prà, grown on the volcanic soils of a sunken volcano. Tangerine, and melon fruit with a leasy body and a crisp mineral finish. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$22 now \$14**
- ☐ **2013 Bastianich Pinot Grigio** \$10
A bone-dry Pinot Grigio. Refreshing and delicious, with delectable notes of pear and ripe apple. 13% alcohol by volume. **Was \$18 now \$10**
- ☐ **2014 Natalino La Caplana** \$10
Gavi di Gavi
Smells of orchard blossoms and orange peel, light bodied with good acidity. Citrus flavors, from orange peel, lemon oil, tangerine notes, with hints of lime and grapefruit. 12% alcohol by volume. **Was \$13 now \$10**
- ☐ **2016 Locus Modo White** \$14
50% Semillon, 50% Sauvignon Blanc
A bordeaux style blend from our local Locus guys. The Semillon rounds out the grassiness of the Sauvignon blanc. An easy drinking combination. 12.5% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2016 Stift Gottweig Grüner Veltliner** \$14
These high-elevation Gruner Veltliner vineyards in Kremstal (all facing slightly to the north) produces gorgeously precise wines with finesse and tension. The SGGV is animated in the nose, with notes of citrus fruits, red apples and rosewood, and on the palate fresh, fruity, and expressive with good length.
- ☐ **2016 El Coto Rioja Blanco** \$12
Viura
The El Coto Blanco is intensely aromatic, well balanced, with body and the fruit has a refreshing tart character. Pleasant acidity combines perfectly with an exquisite aftertaste of flowers, fruit and fine herbs. 12.5% alcohol by volume

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SIX MORE REDS

- **2010 Les Hauts de Trintaudon Haut Medoc** \$12
60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot
The second wine from Larose Trintaudon. Aromas of small berries - woodland strawberries, redcurrant. In the palate this wine has good tannic structure.

- **2013 Andeluna 1300 Malbec** \$13
Andeluna's 1300 Malbec begins with floral notes of violets and a fruity expression of red plum and strawberry. The palate is fresh, smooth and balanced.

- **2013 El Coto Crianza** \$13
Tempranillo
A clean, bright Rioja with fresh fruit, with notes of vanilla and toasted oak. On the palate it is silky and persistent presenting a taste of well blended spice. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2015 Ferraris Bric d'Bianc** \$16
Ruchè
A unique Piedmont grape. The Ruchè has berry, cherry, and cranberry layered with juniper, dried rosemary & lavender, thyme and rosehip, white pepper, sour cherry, dried cherry and dried fig. Bright and perfumed and crisp and floral on the palate.

- **2013 Altos las Hormigas Colonia las Liebres** \$8
Bonarda
Mendoza Region Bright raspberry fruit flavors. Rich and tasty. A great summer red.

- **2014 Tormentoso Pinotage** \$13
This low-yielding, bush-vine vineyard gives Pinotage grapes with exceptionally concentrated flavor. The Tormentoso is a full-bodied Pinotage with hints of floral aromas and black cherries, followed by soft, rich tannins, along with plum and berry flavors.

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SIX ROSÈS

- **2016 Castel des Maures Provence Rosé** \$14
50% Grenache, 50% Cinsault
This wine is dry and fruity with a clear focused character. The taste of red fruit dominates. On the palate, it has a long, lingering finish. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Clos des Lumieres Cotes du Rhone Rosé** \$10
40% Cinsault, 30% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 10% Mourvedre
Fresh off the boat the 2016's are starting to land. Strawberry and citrus aromas followed up by strawberry and cherry flavors with spiciness, and pink grapefruit. 13.5% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Sleight of Hand Magician's Assistant Rosé** \$15
Cabernet Franc
The Magician's Assistant is a single-vineyard 100 percent cabernet franc, with strawberry, black raspberry, and dried spice aromas. It's round and balanced on the palate, where intense black cherry, strawberry and crisp citrus notes carry through to the finish; peppery-herbaceous hints add complexity. 13.3% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Les Trois Couronnes Cotes du Rhone Rosé** \$11
85% Grenache, 10% Cinsault, 5% Syrah
Elegant lychee fragrance with white summer fruits bouquet. Full flavored and refreshing with a crisp berry finish. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Eugène Carrel Jongieux Rosé** \$14
Gamay and Mondeuse
Vin de Savoie Outstandingly crisp, this Savoy rosé has aromas of black cherry, strawberry, wild flowers and minerals. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Vetriccie Île de Beauté Rosé** \$10
40% Niellucciu, 30% Sciaccarella, 15% Grenache, 15% Merlot
A Corsican rosé with briny aromas, hint of fresh vanilla, fresh raspberry, cranberry with red and white currants notes. Crisp and fresh. 12% alcohol by volume

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
