

- **2013 I Caqmpi Campo Volcano Soave** (\$22)  
Garganega  
A rich Soave from Flavio Prà, grown on the volcanic soils of a sunken volcano. Tangerine, and melon fruit with a leasy body and a crisp mineral finish.  
12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2010 Chateau Peyrabon Haut Medoc** (\$32)  
59% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot, 6% Cabernet Franc & Petit Verdot  
This Haut Medoc is a succulent and solid Bordeaux from the great 2010 vintage that is drinking well now so you don't have to wait. "Some roasted herbs, damp earth, interwoven with red and black currants, cherries and spice box are all present in this classic Bordeaux, which exhibits medium body, good density and plenty of balance and elegance. " Wine Advocate
  
- **2012 Animale Dolcetto** (\$25)  
The last Dolcetto from the Gilbert family's "24K" vineyard before the vines were ripped out. A full-bodied, food-friendly wine with flavors of fresh cherry and vibrant acidity. 24 cases made.
  
- **2011 Château la Baronne Pièce de Roche** (\$34)  
100% Carignan from vines planted in 1892  
This family run winery has a long tradition of winemaking. Their Pièce de Roche is complex, voluminous with beautiful fruit density, velvety tannins, and a great length of black fruits and spices with a final licorice finish. Organic
