SIX WHITES

- 2012 La Miranda di Secatilla Garnacha Blanca (\$10)
A full Spanish white with lots of body, citrus and herbal notes. Delicious with seafood or just by itself.
Was \$15 now \$10
- 2012 Stephen Vincent Chardonnay (\$13)
A toasty, but not overly buttery California Chardonnay.
- 2012 Domini Veneti Custoza (\$10)
Trebiano, Garganga, Fernanda
A great deal in a Veneto white. Full of lemony citrus and pineapple flavors.
12.5% alcohol by volume
- 2013 Locus Dineen Vineyard Sémillon (\$15)
A single vineyard semillon from a new Madrona winery. The full lemon cream body of the fruit is balanced out by a refreshing acidity.
- 2011 Anselmann Kabinett Off Dry (\$10)
Riesling
A full and complex riesling with aromas of sage and lemongrass, lots of ripe peach flavors and a citrusy spicy finish. **Was \$15 now \$10** *13% alcohol by volume*
- 2013 Hiruzta Getariako Txakolina (\$15)
93% Hondarrabi Zuri, 7% Gros Manseng
A crisp Basque white in the classic style. Aromas of pear, apple, grapefruit and passion fruit enveloped in the perfume of white flowers orange blossom, accentuated by the subtle effervescence of natural carbon dioxide gas. *12% alcohol by volume*



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SIX REDS

- 2012 Palama Archangelo (\$10)
Primativo
A dry and full Primativo that is an angle of a deal. Lush, yet bright and approachable, with notes of dark anise, cedar, and blackberry confit. **Was \$15 now \$10**

- 2008 Garofoli Agontano Riserva (\$16)
100% Montepulciano.
From a single vineyard, aged in barrique for 18 months, matured in the bottle for 12 months. This great Reserva has notes of cocoa, nutmeg cassis, blackberries with intergrated tannins. **Was \$36 now \$16**

- 2008 In Situ Carmenere (\$10)
A herbed and spiced edge complement aromas of black currant and black cherry permeated by dried thyme. Firm tannins add structure to the bitter cherry and liquorice flavor, with good mineral lift to the finish. **Was \$13 now \$10**

- 2010 Cloudlift Panorama (\$14)
57% Merlot, 26% Cabernet Sauvignon, 17% Cabernet Franc
A veryaromatic Washingtgn blend with lots of plum, herbal notes, sweet cherries, and spice. The palate is medium bodied with tart fruit flavors and a modest 13.3% alcohol. **Was \$20 now \$14**
13.3% alcohol by volume

- 2012 Terre Fagetto Rosso Piceno (\$10)
50% Montepulciano, 50% Sangiovese
Ruby color, intense small black fruits and balmy memories. Full-bodied and rounded wine of remarkable depth and structure.—Winemaker’s Note. Good fruity wine with a spicy finish. **Was \$12 now \$10**

- 2007 Cantelle Telero Rosso (\$8)
Negro Amaro
A dark and smoky southern Italian red with a spicy finish. Good barbeque wine or the classic spaghetti and meatballs. **Was \$13 now \$8**



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SIX MORE REDS

- **2011 Vinosia Neromora** (\$11)
Aglianico
From volcanic soils, and aged in French oak for 8 months., the Neromora is full of dark, dark fruit with smoke, resin and spice notes and a dry bitter chocolate finish. **Was \$13 now \$11**

- **2013 Statti Lamezia** (\$14)
Gagliopo, Grecco Nero, and Nerello Cappuccio
A light and fruity red from the toe of the boot. Black cherry, cocoa, tobacco, plum and spice notes are structured with excellent integration of the fruit, tannins and acidity. *13% alcohol by volume*

- **2008 Beronia Elaboración Especial** (\$12)
Tempranillo
A big extracted tempranillo, aromas of licorice, and red and black fruits with chocolate and mineral tones. **Was \$17 now \$12**

- **2012 Château Labarthe Bordeaux** (\$10)
50% Merlot, 50% Cabernet Franc
A Franc heavy Bordeaux with aromas of red fruits, mingled with toasted and roasted notes. The body has silky but also thick tannins. *13% alcohol by volume*

- **2010 Cox Malbec IGP du Lot** (\$13)
This Malbec from Cahors is a refreshing summer wine. Cox is the word for ladybug, and this lady has intense aromas of berries, red fruits and violet. The body has soft juicy tannins, and a stylish, rich attack.

- **2011 Terre di Gioia Marzemino** (\$15)
Marzemino Gentile is an indigenous grape in Trentino in the Alto Adige. Mozart mentions the wine in Don Giovanni. The Marzemino has medium body, a dark ruby almost purple color but with a delicate and unmistakable nose of violets. The taste is fragrant. *12.5% alcohol by volume*
