Saturday Night Selections

- **2006 Melini La Selvanella Chianti Classico Reserva** (\$24)
Sangiovese
La Selvanella Chianti Classico Reserva is Fattorie Melini's top wine, it was the first single vineyard wine from Chianti. The 2006 won the Tre Bicchieri. An Excellent Chianti with the right amount of age on it.

- **2005 Frontaura Aponte Reserva** (\$40)
Tempranillo
A high quality flagship wine from Toro. Made from 100 year old vines and aged for 22 months in new french oak. The wine's aromatic complexity stands out with a cornucopia of fruit, spice and herb notes. The mouthfeel is smooth and expressive with a broad deep aftertaste.

- **2013 Cave de la Bouquette Sancerre** (\$22)
Sauvignon Blanc
Cave de la Bouquette is a 5.5 hectare estate of 30 year old vines on the sloping hills around Chavignol, and is one of the smallest producers in Sancerre. This Sauv. Blanc has a dry citrus body packed in a mineral wrapper. Organic 12.8% by volume

- **2011 Domaine de l'Herms, Terrasses du Larzac** (\$27)
60% Syrah, 40% Mourvedre
Domaine de l'Herms in the Languedoc makes just one white and one red wine. The red has a large percentage of Mourvedre and is deeply knitted and full with notes of red and black fruit and, menthol, thyme, and small fine tannins.
