## SIX REDS

- **2012 Roc de Levrault Bordeaux** (\$10)  
60 Merlot, 40% Cabernet Sauvignon  
A sturdy little Bordeaux from a 3rd generation wine making family in Entre deux Mers. Dark plummy fruit.  
13% alcohol by volume
- **2011 Marcato Colli Berici** (\$13)  
Cabernet Franc  
From Veneto comes this neutral barrel aged Cab Franc with cherry/chocolate aromas. Ripe and medium concentrated palate with sweet fruit flavors. Ripe and soft tannins with a pleasant leafy aftertaste.
- **2012 Cave de Rasteau Cotes du Rhone** (\$11)  
70% Grenache, 20% Carignan, 10% Cinsault  
With no Syrah in this CDR, the wine ends up showing off its fruit more and has some lovely perfume notes.
- **2013 Bodegas Vegalfaro Rebel.lia, Utiel-Requena** (\$12)  
Equal parts Bobal, Tempranillo and Garnacha Tintorea (Alicante Bouchet)  
A rebel with a mission, the Rebel.lia is an intense red with an expressive nose bursting with red and black fruits, smoky herbs, baking spices, chocolate and clove. It is loaded with fresh fruit on the pallet than finishes with wonderfully balanced acidity and a smooth with a nice long finish.
- **2013 Torre Gajo** (\$11)  
Montepulciano  
Tore Gajo is produced by a cooperative of growers located in Abruzzo. The wine has aromas of cherry and light spice with a palate of smooth, juicy red fruits and light earthiness on finish. 1 LITER
- **2012 Pratesi Locorosso** (\$11)  
Sangiovese  
Not sure what is crazy bout this wine but it is a big fruit basket Sangiovesi with "jammy tannins and a long finish." Was \$16 now \$11

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## SIX WHITES

- **2013 Marchesi di Gresy Langhe Sauvignon** (\$14)  
From vineyards situated in Barbaresco and Treiso, this lees aged Sauvignon Blanc has crisp sharp limey acidity over creamy fruit of apple and pears. **Was \$21 now \$14**
  
- **2013 Campodelsole Chiccobianco** (\$10)  
Sauvignon, Albana & Pagadebit.  
A fresh white blend from Emilia-Romagna with aromas of white peach and citrus blossom and a honey flavored palate. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2012 Cave de Rasteau Cotes du Rhone Blanc** (\$11)  
60% Grenache Blanc, 30% Clairette, 10% Bourboulenc  
A Rhone white with aromas of citrus and white-fleshed fruit and notes of flowers, almonds and menthol in a nice structure both full and fresh. 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2012 Cave de Lugny Les Pierres Blanches Macon Villages** (\$10)  
Chardonnay  
Another bottling from this solid Macon producer. Citrus and apple notes, hint of blossom and faint traces of butter, along with a hint of pear, finishing on a lovely mineral streak. **Was \$12 now \$10**
  
- **2012 Fantinel Pinot Grigio** (\$13)  
From Friuli, the Fantinel has fresh, aromatic floral aromas and a light elegant body. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2013 Dom. Des Roy Silex Touraine** (\$13)  
Chenin & Pineau Menu  
A unique Loire blend from Gabrielle Roy with aromas of white fruit and mineral notes on a supple palate. Organic. 12% alcohol by volume

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## SIX MORE REDS

- **2011 Pratesi Carmignano** (\$15)  
70% Sangiovese, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot  
A Tuscan red from very very low yield vines. Aromas of red and black berries, including cherries, and sweet spices, like vanilla and licorice. It is well-balanced on the palate with juicy tannins and mouth-watering acidity.

- **2013 Le Cantine de Indie Langhe Rosso** (\$15)  
50% Nebbiolo, 20% Barbera, 30% Dolcetto  
Aged in both stainless and barrel, this Lange red is a ballanced and great tasting food wine. "The Barbara brings the acidity and bright fruit, the Nebbiolo brings the tannins and the aromatics, and the Dolcetto brings the softness and rounds out the blend. "

- **2012 Marchione Grignolino d' Asti** (\$16)  
A light Piedmont grape this old-fashioned Grignolino delivers a combination of fresh fruit, light body, and surprising but delicate tannin. A red that works with fish. 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Bastide Miraflores "Vieilles Vignes" Côtes Catalanes** (\$14)  
70% Syrah, 30% Grenache  
"Six week maceration, which no doubt explains the wine's seriously intense fruit. Notes of violets, forest floor, black cherry jam and blackberries make an appearance in this medium-bodied, high-toned, dense, rich, complex, well-delineated red wine. Drink it over the next several years. An excellent joint venture between importer Eric Solomon and Jean-Marc Lafage, these three cuvees represent fabulous bargain."~91pts WA
  
- **2010 Claude Lafond Les Grande vignes** (\$15)  
Pinot Noir  
A lighter aromatic Pinot for a small estate in the Loire. Lots of rose petal, pie cherry and citrus peel.

12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2012 Helderberg Stellenbosch Cabernet Sauvignon** (\$14)  
A wilderbeast of a wine, the Helderberg is dark and smoky with flavors of dark plums, black berry and cedar undertones.

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
