

SIX REDS

- **2012 Fortant Coast Select** (\$10)
Cabernet Sauvignon
A Languedoc Cab that for some reason they want to look like it came from California. The wine features an intense nose with notes of blueberry and violet. Round and juicy on the palate with lovely flavors of freshly picked black fruit.

- **2011 Chateau Les Hauts de Plaisance Haut Medoc** (\$15)
50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 45% Merlot, 3% Petit Verdot, 2% Cabernet Franc
The Heights of Pleasure (Hauts de Plaisance) promises a lot and delivers. This second wine from Chateau Pontoise Cabarus has a complex aromatic nose of red fruit, berries, coffee, and spice. The palate has a delicious balance of fruit, tannins, and acidity this wine tastes of cherry and blackberry, with a hint of coffee and chocolate.

- **2011 Hightower Cellars Murray Cuvée** (\$15)
64% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Malbec, 12% Petit Verdot, 6% Merlot
The Murray has aromas of red berry fruits and cassis mingled with herbal notes. The cool vintage acidity makes this wine mouthwatering and juicy with a fruity mid-palate, finely textured tannins and toasty oak notes on the finish.

- **2012 Torcidas Malbec** (\$13)
An earthy, chewy Malbec that has a lot going on in it. Blueberry, bramble, violets, smoke and dark juicy fruit.

- **2011 Notre Dame des Pallières Les Ribes Rasteau** (\$13)
75% Grenache, 15% Mourvedre, and 10% Cinsault.
Fuller-bodied, dry. This wine has a youthful purple color and a complex nose of clove and earthy tobacco. The palate is full of dark plum, mocha, and licorice followed by a very long finish of fine tannins.

- **2011 Barone Cornacchia Montepulciano d'Abruzzo** (\$12)
A good bodied rustic red with lots of fruit, leathery notes and smooth tannins. A notch above most Montepulciano. Organic

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SIX WHITES

- **2013 Casale del Giglio Satrico** (\$13)
34% Chardonnay, 33% Sauvignon, 33% Trebbiano
A uncommon blend that really works. Fruity, lightly aromatic yet mineral aromas are confirmed on the palate by a pleasing crispness and a lengthy finish. 13% by volume

- **2013 Les Anges Sauvignon Blanc** (\$10)
A Loire Blanc, the Les Anges is crisp and citrus filled without being too grassy. 11.5% by volume

- **2012 Ontanon Vetiver** (\$12)
Viura
Citrusy aromas like lemongrass and lime zest meld with grassy overtones and hints of grapefruit and white pepper. The wine's surprising density serves as a foundation for its blend of earth and fruit flavors.
13% by volume

- **2010 Labbé Abymes** (\$13)
100% Jacquère
Vin de Savoie
A dry white from Northern France at the foot of the Alps. The "Abymes" moniker actually refers to the boulders present in the vineyard. It is punctuated by flavors of freshly sliced lemon, green apple, white pear, and a textbook Savoie minerality. The perfect wine for Fondue. 11% by volume

- **2013 Gibault Touraine Sauvignon Blanc** (\$14)
A full and crisp lees aged Sauv Blanc. The vinification at low temperature gives the Sauvignon Blanc white fruit aromas, citrus and candied citrus, exotic fruits. 12.5% by volume

- **2011 Peirano Estate Vineyards 'The Other' Estate Grown White Wine** (\$14)
65% Chardonnay, 25% Sauvignon Blanc, 10% Viognier
Aromas of apples, pears, tropical fruit, and a whiff of bubble gum are complemented by hints of coconut and vanilla. Lush flavors of fresh ripe pears, apples, tropical fruit and homemade lemon pie.

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SIX MORE REDS

- **2012 Oraison Côtes du Rhône** (\$10)
80% Grenache, 10% Syrah, 10% Mourvedre
A inexpensive Rhone from a big year makes a great bargain. Good cherry fruit, garrigue and pepery finish.
- **2011 Velenosi Brecciarolo Rosso Piceno** (\$15)
70% Montepulciano, 30% Sangiovese
Il Brecciarolo refers to the broken stones typical of the soils in this area. The heartiness of the Montepulciano dominates while the Sangiovese lifts the aromatics and brightens it. Its tannins give the wine structure, but are so soft and refined they almost feel creamy, while great acidity follows through the finish.
- **Toschi Family blend** (\$9)
A juicy Zin heavy blend from the San Joaquin valley. No vintage and no pretentions. Just drinkable juice.
12.7% by volume
- **2011 Domaine Denois Les Garrigues** (\$12)
Syrah, Grenache, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Sauvignon
A tasty little southern French wine with aromas of small red berry fruit and delicate hints of spice box, subtle notes of tobacco leaf and licorice. Organic
12.9% by volume
- **2011 Peirano Estate Vineyards 'The Other' Estate Grown Red Wine** (\$14)
50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot, 10% Syrah
The aromas of blackberries and plums are complemented by spice, toasty oak and cedar notes. On the palate, sweet black cherries and boysenberries, with a hint of smoky, dark.
- **2012 Oinos Les Cardères Corbières** (\$12)
50% Syrah, 25% Grenache, 25% Carignan.
A Syrah heavy southern French red, with aromas of blackberries, black pepper, and Provençal herbs. Spicy and lively on the palate, berry fruit joins with nuances of tarry earth, bitter herbs, leather and fennel.

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
