

- ❑ **2010 Château Haut-Segottes Saint Emilion Grand Cru** (\$40)
65% Cabernet Franc, 35% Merlot
A lush, earthy right-bank red Bordeaux from a fourth-generation woman winemaker in a small cru near the renowned Cheval Blanc. And Like Cherval Blanc it is mostly Cabernet Franc with a soft blend of Merlot.

- ❑ **2012 Flegenheimer Reserve Red** (\$27)
85% Shiraz, 15% Petite Sirah
Flegenheimer's McLaren Vale vineyard consists of ironstone and clay over limestone and benefits from cool maritime breezes each afternoon. The wine "exudes aromas of warm blackberries and crushed black plums with hints of mulberries, black pepper, tree bark and charcoal. Very big and full-bodied, it fills the palate with warm berry preserves flavors and just a touch of pepper that is offset by chewy tannins and up-lifting acidity."
- ❑ **2012 Airfield Estates Dauntless** (\$15)
72% Merlot, 13% Malbec, 11% Petit Verdot, 4% Cabernet Franc
An estate grown red blend, the Dauntless has aromas of plum and spice, the palate is full bodied with smooth tannins, soft oak and flavors of black cherry and spice.
- ❑ **2013 Domaine Montrose** (\$12)
35% Merlot, 35% Syrah, 30% Grenache
Domaine Montrose is a family wine estate founded in 1701 when the "Three Lizards" coat of arms was given to our ancestor. Montrose is located in the Languedoc region of Southern France. A juicy red from the Côtes de Tongue, that coats the tongue. Full of red fruit, black currant, and cocoa. Sustainable
12.5% alcohol by volume
- ❑ **2011 Nicolis Valpolicella Classico** (\$13)
65% Corvina, 20% Rondinella, 10% Sangiovese, 5% Molinara
A solid red Veneto blend with notes of cherries, marasca cherries and plums. The flavour is dry, bodied, slightly bitter, savoury and harmonious. **Was \$17 now \$13**
- ❑ **2012 Valdecampaña Ribera del Duero Crianza** (\$15)
Tempranillo
A dark and chewy Tempranillo with notes of blackberry, tabacco and roasted vanilla bean.
