

- **2011 Domaine Fleuriet Sancerre Cote Mariloup** (\$20)
Sauvignon Blanc
A Reserve Sancerre aged in Concrete eggs (tanks) . This Cuvée is made of grapes from their oldest vineyards, preferably on south-facing slopes. The bouquet offers a hint of elderflower and gooseberry green. The taste is very fresh and intense with great energy and with delicate notes of lime and mineral facets and a rich oily mouthfeel. Was \$26 now \$20

- **2010 Château Haut-Segottes Saint Emilion Grand Cru** (\$40)
65% Cabernet Franc, 35% Merlot
A lush, earthy right-bank red Bordeaux from a fourth-generation woman winemaker in a small cru near the renowned Cheval Blanc. And Like Cherval Blanc it is mostly Cabernet Franc with a soft blend of Merlot.

- **2012 Flegenheimer Reserve Red** (\$27)
85% Shiraz, 15% Petite Sirah
Flegenheimer's McLaren Vale vineyard consists of ironstone and clay over limestone and benefits from cool maritime breezes each afternoon. The wine "exudes aromas of warm blackberries and crushed black plums with hints of mulberries, black pepper, tree bark and charcoal. Very big and full-bodied, it fills the palate with warm berry preserves flavors and just a touch of pepper that is offset by chewy tannins and up-lifting acidity."

- **2005 Rioja Bordón Gran Reserva** (\$27)
80% tempranillo, 10% Grenache, 10% Mazuelo
A great deal on a Gran Reserva. Marked balsamic tones and elegant spices and tobacco leaves notes with smoothness, great elegance and persistence.
