

## SIX REDS

- **2014 Menhir Negroamaro** (\$9)  
A big shouldered southern Italian red with full fruit and bitter undertones.
  
- **2010 Felsner Zweigelt** (\$14)  
A single vineyard hand harvested Austrian Red -plum & berry fruit with a plush silkiness. **Was \$18 now \$14**  
12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2009 Basciano Il Corto** (\$17)  
90% Sangiovese, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon  
An elegant, lovely expression of Old World Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. Full-bodied and supple with very attractive black fruit and smoke aromas and flavours. Mouth-watering and generous. Decant.  
**Was \$25 now \$17**
  
- **Eric Jamet Le Sang du Peuple** (\$12)  
50% Grenache, 50% Syrah  
A thick and jammy Rhône blend with lots of black berry and cherry fruit and a bit of toasty notes to keep the blood of the people pumping.
  
- **2010 Cotoval Tempranillo** (\$11)  
A big and juicy Tempranillo for Castilla Y León. Sees a year in barrel for a modest price.
  
- **2011 Rivetto Langhe Nebbiolo** (\$15)  
Medium bodied with a wonderful scent of ripe prune. In the mouth it is pleasant with a soft tannin taste. It's really well balanced wine, round, smooth, it represents the best nebbiolo soil characteristics.  
**Was \$19 now \$15**

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## SIX WHITES

- **2013 Erste & Neue Salt Chardonnay** (\$14)  
A single vineyard Chardonnay from Kaltern Caldaro in Alto Adage. Subdued fragrance of exotic fruits. Well balanced on the palate with delicate acidity; very harmonious wine with fruity and long lasting aftertaste.
  
- **2014 Palazzo Malgara Grillo** (\$11)  
A Sicilian white that has more weight than the average Grillo and outperforms for the price.  
13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Pallavicini Frascati** (\$10)  
Malvasia di Candia, Malvasia del Lazio, Bombino, Chardonnay, Greco  
From vineyards just south of Rome, this lively & floral white is a refreshing summer white as well as a good match to lighter meals.  
12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Cave de Saumur Les Pouches Blanc** (\$10)  
Chenin Blanc  
A single vineyard, Chenin from 45 year old vines. Aromas of peach, lemon zest and grapefruit that carry on through an incredibly suave ending with a long persistence of peach on the finish. 11.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Château. De Fontenille** (\$14)  
Entre-deux-Mers Blanc  
40% Sauvignon Blanc, 20% Sauvignon Gris, 20% Muscadelle, 20% Semillon  
Aromas of citrus fruit and white peaches, the entry is sharp and ample at the same time. The palate is nicely well balanced. It has a pleasant fat and the finale is lightly peppery, with a nice lingering finish.  
12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Château Teulon Nimes Rosé** (\$10)  
85% Syrah, 15% Grenache  
Rich, mouth-filling, medium-bodied, and broad. It speaks of woodland strawberries, but also of garrigue, rosemary and thyme."

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## SIX MORE REDS

- **2014 Andeluna 1300 Malbec** (\$11)  
A high altitude Malbec takes a drop in price. Lots of dark fruit and toasty nuance.  
Was \$15 now \$11
  
- **2012 James Cabernet Sauvignon** (\$15)  
Big and lush Cabernet Sauvignon sourced from lodi and Napa, California made by Jim Neal for Indie Wines.  
It is a chocolatey wine with a deep color, dark plummy fruits, and a nice dose of warm baking spices on the finish.
  
- **2013 Les Terrasses d'Eole Ventoux** (\$12)  
Grenache, Syrah  
From a small gravity powered winery in Provence, this Ventoux is full dark fruit, violets, and minerals with indulgent flavors of blackberries, violets, and anise and earthy undertones.
  
- **2012 Tormaresca Primitivo** (\$15)  
From Antinori's Puglia estate, this Primitivo shows notes of black cherry, blackberry, plum and hazelnut as well as hints of spice. On the palate, the wine is fruity, with integrated tannins and a bitter chocolate finish.
  
- **2014 Cavatappi Sangiovese** (\$10)  
A juicy Washington Sangiovese jumps in a great price due to it being Washington Wine Month once again. It is a nice friendly little sipper.
  
- **2012 Menhir Quota 31** (\$11)  
Primitivo  
An oaked Primitivo from Sicily. The wine is dark and smooth and rich with flavors of blackberry, Kirsch, cassis, chocolate, a hint of tar, a little leather, caramel, stewed raspberry, and baked figs. NEW VINTAGE

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## TWO ROSÉS

- **2014 Lafage Miraflores** (\$15)  
70% Mourvedre, 30% Grenache  
Medium-bodied, fresh and racy, yet with solid depth of flavor, it gives up pretty strawberry, white peach and rose petal-like aromas and flavor. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Gournier Rosé** (\$10)  
35% Merlot, 10% Syrah, 30% Grenache, 15% Sangiovese, 10% Mourvedre  
A odd blend from Nimes, this rosé has red berry aromas with a dried cherry note. It is soft and lush on the palate with good acidity, depth and intensity of flavor. Organic 12.5% alcohol by volume

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
