

## SIX REDS

- **2009 Roccafiore Rosso** (\$14)  
Sangiovese  
From a modern gravity fed winery in Umbria, this full and rich Sangiovese overdelivers for the money. Black cherry, tobacco and tea notes dominate. **Was \$16 now \$14**
  
- **2013 Contini Tonaghe** (\$12)  
Cannonau di Sardegna  
Sardinian Grenache that taste like it comes from nowhere else. Intense, with a well-defined vinosity and a hint of ripe plums and blackberries, lovely grippy tannins; warm and full-bodied with blackberry notes and juicy, ripe plum flavors. 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2011 Domaine de Mas Blanc Piloums ~ Collioure** (\$11)  
Syrah, Mourvedre, Grenache, Counoise  
Just off the boat from a small estate near Banyuls, this full rich southern French out delivers for the money. 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2013 Massaya Le colombier** (\$13)  
35% Cinsault, 35% Grenache, 15% Tempranillo, 15% Syrah  
From the Beqaa Valley in Lebanon the Colombier speaks of the French vigneronns that shape it (Cheval Blanc's Dominique Hébrard and the Bruniers of Vieux Télégraphe) Lots of dark fruit, & spice notes.
  
- **2014 Bonny Doon \$\$\$\*#! Merlot** (\$11)  
76% Merlot, 17% Cabernet Franc, 5% Syrah, 1% Grenache, 1% Mourvedre  
A riff on the movie Sideways, this Doonish blend is as playful as the back label.
  
- **2009 Valdueza Extremadura** (\$15)  
Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot  
A rich, generous wine, with red and dark fruit flavors, that also manages to retain wonderful freshness. The Washington blend of Spain.

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## SIX WHITES

- **2014 Novellum Chardonnay** (\$12)  
70% of the wine is aged in stainless steel, and 30% is aged briefly in one-year old barrels. But the real uniqueness in this wine comes from its aging method: it is aged on the "lees" of previously fermented Viognier for three months, imparting a luscious floral character that's different from the average Chardonnay. Balanced with fresh acidity, ripe fruit and a touch of minerality.
  
- **2013 Santos Lima Confidencial Branco** (\$9)  
A blend of 10 different local & international grape varieties, this Portuguese white is a nice lemony citrus wine with notes of thyme and lavender. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2012 Château d'Argendens Bordeaux Blanc** (\$15)  
65% Sauvignon Blanc, 35% Semillon  
Aromas of citrus fruit and boxwood, underpinned by notes that tend more towards vanilla and roasted almonds. 12% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Rablais Touraine** (\$13)  
Sauvignon Blanc  
A family estate since 1790, the Rablais has a grassy nose along with good citrus fruit and a touch of mineral note. 12% alcohol by volume
  
- **2010 Bertrand MuscatO, IGP Pays d'Oc** (\$13)  
A blend of the Muscat d'Alexandrie and Muscat Petit Grain varieties, this cuvée comes from vines with limited yields giving the wine a rare quality and great complexity. This wine offers a bouquet boasting aromas of orange blossom, apricot and peach. Its highly expressive flavors give it astonishing freshness enhanced by great aromatic presence. Organic. 10% alcohol by volume
  
- **2012 Le Petit Xavier Blanc** (\$12)  
50% Sauvignon, 30% Picpoul, 20% Grenache Blanc  
Blended from grapes from the Languedoc and the Rhone and designed to be "Fruit, flowers, spices & foremost fun." The blanc offers notes of citrus, tropical fruit, and floral white flowers with a fresh palate. 12% alcohol by volume. **Was \$17 now \$12**

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## SIX MORE REDS

- **2013 Domaine de Mougin VDP L' Aude** (\$10)  
30% Syrah, 30% Merlot, 20% Carrignan, 10% Grenache, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon  
A dark and fruit driven everyday drinking wine with enough going on so your tounge never gets bored. What Vin de Pays should always be.
- **2012 Michel Gassier Cercius Vieilles Vignes Visan** (\$15)  
85% Grenache and 15% Syrah  
Made from 80+ year vines the Cercius has dark berries and wood smoke lifted by a spicy element. It finishes with gentle tannins and subtle anise and cola qualities.
- **2013 Le Petit Xavier Rouge** (\$12)  
50% Syrah, 50% Grenache  
A fresh and easy style red, Le Petit rouge displays notes of pepper, red fruits, and floral notes including violet. The palate is rich, fresh with a mineral finish. **Was \$17 now \$12**
- **2012 Château Flotis Fronton** (\$14)  
Negrette  
An organic and bio-dynamic coloboration of 3 women winemakers in the Southwest of France. 100% Negrette, which is the primary red grape of the region, the Flotis exhibits a mound of terroir, black fruits, exotic spice and structure and a solid note of earthy funk. Organic
- **2011 Château De Fontenille Bordeaux** (\$14)  
80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet  
A good basic Bordeaux with red fruit aromas, a clean and sturdy palate with a long lingering of flavors.
- **2012 Sarrail Cabernet Sauvignon** (\$10)  
A deal of a Cabernet from the Languedoc with full dark fruit and smooth tannins.  
13% alcohol by volume

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
