

## SIX REDS

- **2012 Nicosia Frapatto** (\$10)  
Created from an ancient grape variety typical of southeastern Sicily, this wine is distinctive for its pleasantly fragrant bouquet of fresh red fruits, raspberries and blueberries, while its taste is both lively and soft.  
13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Raffault Chinon Rouge** (\$15)  
Cabernet Franc  
Classic Chinon. R. Parker says “ Deep black cherry and aromas tinged with vanilla, chocolate...lead to a bright yet quite silken-textured palate loaded with ripe, pit- and herb-accented black cherry fruit...it draws to a lip-smacking finish.” 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2013 Echeverria Gran Reserva** (\$12)  
Malbec  
A Chelian Malbec that sets itself off from its Argentinian neighbors. Full and soft plummy fruit, with violet aromase and a smooth round finish.
  
- **NV Vina Salida Vino Rojo** (\$15)  
Malbec, Tempranillo  
From Doug McCrea, this bottling of Vino Rojo comes mainly from the cooler 2011 vintage with some 2010 added to fill out the body. The combo is totally successful balance between the spiceiness of the cooler vintage and the full fruit flavors.
  
- **2011 Fondo Filara Syrah** (\$10)  
A Sicilian Syrah, this wine bears the characteristic scents of jam and spices, with a full-bodied, velvety smooth and lingering taste.
  
- **2012 Cavalchina Bardolino Superiore Santa Lucia** (\$15)  
60% Corvina, 25% Rondinella, 15% Marzemino and Barbera  
A solid Veronese red with an intense bouquet, nuances of cherries and marasca. On the palate it has a persistent peppery, spicy character. **Was \$25 now \$15**

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## SIX WHITES

- **2013 Fondo Filara Catarratto** (\$10)  
Catarratto is Sicily's most widely grown white grape. The wine has a fresh and concentrated bouquet with notes of bread crust, honey and a sweet almond finish.  
13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2011 Di Marzo Donatus** (\$11)  
Fiano  
A big, fuller bodied Fiano, the aromatic pallet begins with a distinctive note of Mediterranean wild flowers and eucalyptus evolving into pear and exotic fruits. In the mouth an initial taste of lime gives way to the floral nature of the wine. **Was \$20 now \$11**
  
- **2014 Parejas Cellars Albarino** (\$15)  
A local take on the Spanish varital, the Parejas has stone fruit and spice notes and a good crisp mouthfeel.  
13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Chiroulet Java** (\$10)  
50% Columbard, 25% uni Blanc, 25% Sauv Blanc  
No coffee notes in this Gascogne Blanc, just beautiful aromatic citrus and exotic fruits with a round, refreshing finish. 11.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Haut de Mourier Viognier** (\$13)  
A full viognier with floral notes mixed with a peach and mineral foundation.
  
- **2013 Château de la Roche Touraine** (\$12)  
Sauvignon Blanc  
The Château de la Roche is one of the oldest single estates of Loire Valley, planted mostly with Sauvignon Blanc. The vines provide a complex wine on the nose, aromatic and mineral. Ripe fruits and citrus aromas, very subtle and delicate on the palate. 12% alcohol by volume

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## SIX MORE REDS

- **2006 Château Mayne-Vieil Fronsac** (\$12)  
90% Merlot, 10 % Cabernet Franc  
Made from 40 year old vines, The Mayne-Viel has earthy aromas, tart red fruits flavors enriched with riper plum with a silky tannin finish. **Was \$16 now \$12**
  
- **2011 Castlefeder Reider Lagrein** (\$15)  
From the Alto Adige the Reider has fresh aromas of wild berries & violets along with rich notes of cherry and tobacco.
  
- **2012 Terre del Barolo Nebbiolo d'Alba** (\$13)  
A full-structured Nebbiolo that drinks above its price. Chewy tannins mixed with red cherries and floral notes.
  
- **2012 Shooting Star Blue Franc** (\$14)  
Lemberger  
A very clean Lemberger with medium body and cherry and plum fruit along with notes of traces of pepper, almond, cherry and cinnamon.
  
- **2013 Les Terrasses d'Eole Ventoux** (\$12)  
Grenache, Syrah  
From a small gravity powered winery in Provence, this Ventoux is full dark fruit, violets, and minerals with indulgent flavors of blackberries, violets, and anise and earthy undertones.
  
- **2010 Ivica Pilzota Plavina** (\$15)  
A unknown Croatian varietal with a lot of upside. Fresh red berry fruit combined with good structural tannins, along with hints of chocolate and earth. 12.7% alcohol by volume

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## THREE ROSÉS

- **2014 Dupeuble Beaujolais Rose** (\$15)  
Gamay Noir  
Domaine Dupeuble has been running almost continuously since 1512. The wine according to how Google translates their web site has “Dress salmon with raspberry nuances with many tears. A fruity nose spawning and reveals aromas of gooseberry and white flowers. Bouches fresh, drinkable, light and round.”  
Unfiltered. 12% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 L'Opaline Provence Rosé** (\$14)  
65% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 15% Cinsault  
A full Provence Rosé with fresh red berry flavor accented by dried red fruits, mineral overtones, and a crisp, dry, and elegant finish. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Campuget Rosé** (\$11)  
70% Syrah, 30% Grenache  
Always a great value, the Campuget has aromas of red fruits such as raspberries and black currants. The finish is dry, leaving a delicate impression of fruitiness. 3 ltr box ~\$27 (\$6.75 / bottle) 13% alcohol by volume

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
