

SIX REDS

- **2010 Valle dell 'Acate Cerasuolo di Vitoria** (\$15)
70% Nero d'Avola, 30% Frappato
Sicily's only DOCG, the Cerasuolo has scents of mature blackberry and raspberry with notes of soft spices like liquorice and cacao. The flavors are soft and velvety. The tannins are balanced. The wine is addictive. And now on deal. **Was \$23 now \$15**

- **2012 Sichel Bordeaux** (\$10)
Merlot & Cabernet
A fruit forward Bordeaux that drinks better than its price or its plain label.

- **2009 Larochette Bourgogne Vieilles Vignes** (\$14)
Pinot Noir
Nice and full for an unassuming Bourgogne. It drinks really well after a bit of air. A delicious Pinot Noir who is balanced with a sweet beginning and a mineral finish. There are notes of black and sour cherries along with a hint of mushrooms. **Was \$18 now \$14**
13% alcohol by volume

- **2012 Arizona Stronghold Nachise Red** (\$12)
42% Syrah, 30% Petite Sirah, 18% Grenache, 10% Mourvedre
A very spicy Southwest red blend with aromas of blackberries mixed with hints of mint, juniper, roasted desert herbs and white pepper corns. Long firm finish, with the a hint of oak well-embedded and framed by medium tannins. **Was \$26 now \$12**

- **2013 Valle dell'Acate Ibidini Nero d'Avola** (\$11)
From Sicily, The Ibidini has aromas of fresh raspberries lead to a hint of cocoa on the finish ~ a clean, easy-drinking red. **Was \$16 now \$11**
13% alcohol by volume

- **2013 Brusset Les Boudalles ~ Ventoux** (\$12)
Grenache, Mourvedre, Carignan and Clairette
This wine not only looks like raspberries in the glass, but it shows them on the nose as well. On the palate it is supple, elegant and harmonious, and the aromatics give it a lift which make it very moreish!
Was \$14 now \$12

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SIX WHITES

- **2014 Pichot Coteau de la Biche ~ Vouvray Sec** (\$13)
Chenin Blanc
This wine is warm, rounded and packed with fruit. Baked apple and spice are combined with almond and honey flavors. The wine is dry, very fresh while also concentrated and dense.
12% alcohol by volume

- **2013 Sichel Bordeaux Blanc** (\$10)
Sauvignon & Semillon
This good little everyday Bordeaux from the makers of Château Palmer has good body, and some grassy notes to match the citrus & pineapple fruit.
12% alcohol by volume

- **2014 Château Pajzos Furmint (Tokaji)** (\$13)
The bright, fresh and zesty flavors range from grapefruit to apricot with notes of nuts, minerals, and spice. The Furmint has aspects that remind one of Viognier, Pinot Gris, and Sauvignon Blanc, yet it is a unique wine. Its flavors are as appealing as they are original.
11.5% alcohol by volume

- **2013 Marcato La Giaretta Pinot Grigio** (\$11)
Lively aromas of pear, peach, lemon zest, wild herbs and a touch of spice.
12% alcohol by volume

- **2013 Gård Vintners Freyja White Blend** (\$14)
67% Viognier, 33% Roussanne
More Roussanne gives this Rhone inspired white more volume and weight. The Freyja has a mixture of pear, citrus and stone fruit with notes of honeysuckle and white tea.

- **2014 Cantina Sociale Trento 1339 Müller Thurgau** (\$11)
The Thurgau has delicate, aromatic notes of herbs and dry citrus and a smooth body, with a good balance between the acidity and the structure of the wine.
12.5% alcohol by volume

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SIX MORE REDS

- **2013 Juan Gill Jumilla Red Wine** (\$15)
Monastrell
A big shouldered old vine Monastrell that sees 12 months in French oak barrels. Rich without being jammy. Structured without being too tannic.

- **2012 Les Fiefs d'Anglars Malbec** (\$10)
Vin de Pays du Lot
A great value Malbec from Cahors with good full fruit and scents of red and black fruit, pepper and spices. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2010 Ginkgo Forest Sangiovese** (\$15)
A Wahluke Slope Sangi that shows pretty well with lighter, lower acid and hints of fresh strawberry, rose petals and a tart cherry finish. Aged in new American oak for one year.

- **2013 Esporão Alandra Red** (\$9)
Moreto, Castelão, Trincadeira
Esporão's easy drinking red is made of a blend of three indigenous varietals. It has youthful fruit aromatics and light floral notes.

- **2013 Fattoria le Terrazze Praeludium Rosso Conero** (\$13)
85% Montepulciano, 15% Syrah
Praeludium is full of ripe red fruits, rich, full-bodied, warm, fresh, with soft tannins and a long finish. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2013 Bielsa Garnacha Vinas Viejas** (\$12)
A fresh and juicy greanche from 45 year old vines. Fresh, earthy, floral, medium to full bodied, lush fruit, bright acidity, and a smooth finish.

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
