

SIX REDS

- **2008 Colognole Chianti Rufina** (\$13)
Sangiovese
Medium deep red. Hints of fruitiness red berries, herbs and tobacco. Dry, acid finish, perfect with short ribs, good value. **Was \$16, now \$13**

- **2013 Echeverria Propuesta** (\$10)
85% Cabernet Sauv., 10% Petit Verdot, 5% Malbec
From Chile, this dry chaulky red has plenty of dark fruit without being overripe or pretentious.

- **2014 Domaine Amido Lirac** (\$14)
Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre
According to Abaji: "This is a very drinkable wine and a good value. Tobacco, clove, light fruit, almost absent of tannins but has good depth, not too light. This bottle vanished frighteningly quickly."
Was \$16, Now \$14

- **2014 Petroni Corsican Red** (\$12)
50% Niellucciu, 35% Syrah, 15% Grenache
A good versatile red for Corsica, the wine has aromas of red fruit (strawberries, blackcurrant and raspberries) as well as delicate spice and a light minerality. It is supple on entry to the palate with red fruit flavours and subtle roasted notes.
12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2014 Corsini Barbera d'Alba** (\$15)
The 2014 Corsini Barbera is fantastic. It jumps from the glass with loads of ripe plum, bright acidity and rich earthy undertones that keep your palate guessing. **SPECIAL WINE CLUB PRICNG - Normally \$16**

- **2014 Kerloo Cellars Red Blend** (\$15)
70% Grenache, 20% Mourvedre, 10% Syrah
A bare bones bird from Kerloo. A bouquet of red fruit, minerals, dried herbs, white pepper, and smoky notes, with elegant yet plump, plum flavors and dialed back oak.

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SIX WHITES

- **2013 St. Cosme Little James' Basket Press Blanc** (\$12)
50% Viognier, 50% Sauvignon Blanc
Plenty of apricot, citrus and marmalade notes, this soft, supple and decidedly delicious white.

- **2013 Mt. Beautiful Sauvignon Blanc** (\$15)
A New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc that tones down the grassiness and pushes forward more tropical flavors, bringing a creamy mid-palate all the way through to a crisp finish with bright minerality.

- **2014 Lamouthe de Haux Bordeaux Blanc** (\$13)
40% Semillon, 40% Sauv. Blanc, 20% Muscadelle
A sullen and more supple Bordeaux Blanc due to the large amount of Semillon.

- **2014 Terre Margaritelli Pietramala** (\$12)
85% Trebbiano, 15% Pecorino
From Torgiano, a small hill town in the heart of Umbria, The Pietramala has lovely grassy aromas and slightly citrus flavors and a fresh finish.

- **2013 Selbach Riesling** (\$12)
A crisp Mosel Riesling with just a touch of residual sugar. Lip smacking good and great for spicy food or patio sipping. 1 ltr.

- **2014 Trinacria Bianco** (\$9)
Catarratto & Insolia
A fresh medium-bodied everyday drinker, with citrus fruit and a silky palate.

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SIX MORE REDS

- **2014 Cantina del Indie Vino al Popolo Lange Rosso** (\$13)
50% Nebbiolo, 20% Barbera, 30% Dolcetto
Made especially for Indy Wines by a barolo prouducer. A wine for the people, "the Barbara brings the acidity and bright fruit, the Nebbiolo brings the tannins and the aromatics, and the Dolcetto brings the softness and rounds out the blend. **SPECIAL WINE CLUB PRICNG – Normally \$15**
Organic

- **2014 Moulin de Gassac Guilhem Rouge** (\$14)
40% Syrah, 30% Grenache, 30% Carignan
The young wine from Gassac, this distinctive Syrah-blend has a fragrant, earthy nose of black fruit and herbs, and a fresh, moderately-tannic palate of baked blackberry pie, nutmeg and cedar.

- **2012 Domaine de la Rablais Mis en Bouteille Cuvée Rouge** (\$14)
Cabernet Franc
Loire Valley
This 100% Cabernet Franc is just off the boat and tasting great. Lighter bodied ~ nice spice notes.

- **2012 Cantine due Palme Salice Salentino** (\$15)
85% Negroamaro, 15% Malvasia Nera
Earthy with ripe dark plum and dark chocolate on the nose. The palate is soft and ripe, with structured tannins, giving a smooth lingering finish,
12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2014 Tarima Monastrell** (\$10)
This is your brain on Monastrell. Red raspberries, cooked cherries, and mulberries show in this wine's expressive nose and mouth; the middle and finish also offer black plums and black raisins. Spices, herbs, and chocolate mark the finish as well.

- **2014 Notre Dame des Pallieres Sablet** (\$13)
65% Grenache, 35% Syrah
A well-balanced Village Rhone with all the fresh cherry, spice and undergrowth that you could want. It out performs its price.

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
