

SIX REDS

- **2012 Chateau Paret Bordeaux** (\$10)
85% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc
A great everyday Bordeaux that has nothing to do with tropical pets or pirates. It's a supple and medium-bodied wine, with dark fruit, a soft glycerin texture and very velvety tannins. Easy to like.

- **2009 Tertulia Cellars Redd Brand Red** (\$12)
52 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 23% Cabernet Franc, 20% Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot
A good deal on Tertulia's 2nd label blend. Aromas of cherry, coconut and black olive followed by full ripe fruit and a nice structure. **Was \$15 now \$12**

- **2014 Statti Lamezia** (\$11)
40% Gaglioppo, 40% Greco Nero, 20% Nerello Cappuccio
Aromas with dark notes of black cherry, plum, cocoa, tobacco, Indian ink and spices. It has an excellent balance between fruit, tannin, and acidity with a pleasant finish of fruit and spices.

- **2013 Velenosi Brecciarolo Rosso Piceno** (\$15)
70% Montepulciano, 30% Sangiovese
Notes of blackberry and black cherry, along with a hint of vanilla and coffee. Its warm, lingering, full-bodied and well-orchestrated flavor makes it a distinguished and equally charismatic wine.

- **2012 Domaine de Petit Romain Vieilles Vignes Rouge** (\$13)
90% Syrah, 10% Grenache
From Costières de Nîmes in the south of France the Petit Romain reveals fruity and fresh aromas of red fruit and spice. On the palate the wine is fat, round and warm, carpeted with jammy fruit and supported by drying tannins that make you want more.

- **2013 Brunn Blauer Zweigelt** (\$14)
An Estate-grown Zweiglet in a big bottle. A spicy nose with nuances of pepper. Mature and full-bodied mouth that delivers notes of morello cherry. 13% alcohol by volume

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SIX WHITES

- **2012 Gouleyant Gaillac Blanc** (\$10)
80% Lion de l'oeil, 20% Sauvignon
The Lion has an extremely aromatic nose, mainly dominated by citrus aromas and hints of flowers. Its mouth is fresh, long, and crisp with flavors of white peach and plum. 12% alcohol by volume

- **2014 Lucien Lardy Beaujolais Blanc** (\$13)
Chardonnay
A beautiful expression of an unmasked Chardonnay that lifts up your spirits with wonderful nuances of pears, apples and a hint of citrus. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2014 Las Colinas del Ebro Garnatxa Blanca** (\$10)
A Catalonian white with aromas of spring flowers, white peach, and melon that jumps from the glass. On the palate it is exceptionally concentrated, mouth-filling, and vibrant with plenty of spicy fruit, good depth, and a fruit-filled finish. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2014 Cantina Sociale Trento 1339 Vendemmia** (\$11)
Pinot Grigio
Trentino
A crisp Pinot Grigio: fruity on the nose with a scent of pear; on the palate dry, full with a balanced acidity. Very refreshing.

- **2013 Gran Passione Gavi** (\$13)
Cortese
This passionate wine from the Piedmont has delicate aromas of white flowers, lemon, and green apples. A crisp, medium-bodied palate showing underlying hints of chalky minerality. Well-balanced and distinctly fruit driven with underlying hints of almonds on the finish. 12% alcohol by volume

- **2014 La Jara Pinot Grigio Rosé** (\$9)
After the tide of summer rosés you sometimes find the gems in the receding surf. The La Jarra blossoms with rose petal and red fruit, lots of blood orange and lively goodness. And due to the season it is **now \$9. Was \$12**
Organic 12.5% alcohol by volume

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SIX MORE REDS

- **2010 La Fleur Bibian Listrac-Medoc** (\$14)
50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 50% Merlot
La Fleur Bibian is made from a selection of young vines grown on several distinct parcels at Chateau Bibian. The combination of merlot and cabernet sauvignon results in a smooth wine with a lot of juicy red fruit aromas and flavours and light tannins.
- **2013 Nicosia Falde** (\$12)
80% Nero d'Avola, 20% Syrah
The full cherry fruitiness of the Nero d'Avola is bucked up and filled out a bit by Syrah. An easy drinking Sicilian Red. 13% alcohol by volume
- **2014 Jacky Marteau Touraine Gamay** (\$13)
Partially harvested by hand for a fruity, delectable taste. Partially destemmed to add suppleness to the tannins and the right touch of spice.
- **2013 Viña Reboreda Mencía** (\$13)
A small vineyard Mencia with good acidity and ballanced berry fruti that gives way to a clean dry mineral finish.
- **2012 Montaña Rioja Crianza** (\$12)
Tempranillo
The Montaña ages for 12 months in French oak instead of the more common American. The wine's spice and leather complement the deep blackberry fruit and ferrous minerality of Rioja's red soils.
13% alcohol by volume
- **2013 La Mijane Arpege ~ Cabardes** (\$14)
60% Grenache, 40% Merlot
Where the Atlantic influence meets the Mediteranian, the blend mixes notes of blueberry and dark fruit with some sunny spice.

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
