

- **2011 Il Conventino Vino Nobile de Montepulciano** (\$30)
80% Sangiovese, 20% Colorino, Canaiolo, and Mammolo
A quality Nobile this wine has a refined bouquet of violet, iris and baking spices. The palate delivers a core of dark cherry and raspberry flavors with white pepper and a hint of herbs. It's elegant, with a bright, silky palate and nice length. Organic

- **2011 Domaine Grand Veneur Lirac Clos de Sixte** (\$30)
50% Grenache Noir, 35% Syrah, 15% Mourvèdre
The vineyards of Lirac face those of Châteauneuf du Pape on the opposite side of the Rhône river, with similar soil on sides. Owned and farmed by Alain Jaume, the Clos de Sixte vineyard uses certified organic practices. On the nose, aromas of red and black ripe fruit (kirsch and wild blackberry) are dominant. The mouth is full, with aromas of blackcurrant liquor and spice. Tannins are both harmonious and elegant thanks to the fleshy of the wine. The end display hints of licorice and vanilla, which give to the wine length and complexity.

- **2014 Corsini Barbera d'Alba** (\$15)
The 2014 Corsini Babera is fantastic. It jumps from the glass with loads of ripe plum, bright acidity and rich earthy undertones that keep your palet guessing. **Special Wine Club Price**

- **2011 Tenuta Fanti Sassomagno, Sant Antimo** (\$13)
Sangiovese, Merlot, Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon
This Family winery has been around since the 19th century. Their Sassomangno is a sturdy little young vine Sangiovesse, bucked up with some super Tuscan varietals. Chewy cherry skins and a lovely fruit sweetness. Pure and refined, medium-bodied plus, textured tannins and great balance

- **2012 Les Bagatelles de Gallician Costieres de Nimes** (\$15)
70% Syrah, 20% Greanache, 10% Mourvedre
A syrah heavy Southern French red with dark smooth full fruit and lingering spice notes.

- **2013 Château Petit-Freyton Bordeaux** (\$10)
75% Cabernet, 25% Merlot
An easy, Cab heavy Bordeaux with notes of rounded black fruits and licorice.
