

## SIX REDS

- **2014 Corsini Barbera d'Alba** (\$15)  
The 2014 Corsini Babera is fantastic. It jumps from the glass with loads of ripe plum, bright acidity and rich earthy undertones that keep your palet guessing. **Special Wine Club Price**  
Sustainable

- **2011 Tenuta Fanti Sassomagno, Sant Antimo** (\$13)  
Sangiovese, Merlot, Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon  
This Family winery has been around since the 19th century. Their Sassomangno is a sturdy little young vine Sangiovesse, bucked up with some super Tuscan varietals. Chewy cherry skins and a lovely fruit sweetness.  
Pure and refined, medium-bodied plus, textured tannins and great balance
  
- **2012 Les Bagatelles de Gallician Costieres de Nimes** (\$15)  
70% Syrah, 20% Greanache, 10% Mourvedre  
A syrah heavy Southern French red with dark smooth full fruit and lingering spice notes.  
13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2013 Château Petit-Freydon Bordeaux** (\$10)  
75% Cabernet, 25% Merlot  
An easy, Cab heavy Bordeaux with notes of rounded black fruits and licorice.  
13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2013 Ludovicus Garnacha** (\$11)  
From organically grown grapes in the high elevation Terra Alta region, the Ludovicus shows boisterous and exuberant black cherry/kirsch liqueur notes, medium to full body, and a terrific purity and exuberance.

- **2013 Stema Pinot Noir** (\$13)  
A northern Italian Pinot that show a full pinot character in a straight forward and fresh fashion with nice dark cherry and smooth tannins.

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- **2014 Mas des Mas Picpoul de Pinet** (\$10)  
A crisp southern French white with aromas of fresh tropical fruit to sweet peach.

- **2014 Corsini Langhe Bianco** (\$14)  
50% Arneis, 30% Sauvignon Blanc, 20% Chardonnay  
This unique white blend from the Langhe immediately impresses with an engaging array of apple, pear and gooseberry aromas and a bright palate of layered fruit and crisp acidity. Over delivers. Sustainable

- **2013 Ontañon Vetiver** (\$12)  
Viura  
The Ontanon Vetiver is aged for six months in a mix of new and used oak. The wine displays subtle hints of a lifted floral & mineral notes as well as a voluptuous mouth-feel, reminiscent of tropical fruit, grapefruit, a touch of white pepper and toast.

- **2014 Anima Negra Quíbia** (\$14)  
60% Callet, 40% Premsal  
A full and layered white wine from Mallorca. Notes of white peach, pear, saline, and jasmine with a creamy texture. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Douloufakis Vidiano** (\$15)  
Vidiano  
On the Greek island of Crete, Domaine Douloufakis's estate vineyards span over 70 acres. The Cretan variety Vidiano was neglected and almost had become extinct but now is coming back to front stage. The wine has a unique apricot aroma, rich body and transfixing buttery taste. Organic

- **2014 Tenuta Nera La Novella** (\$14)  
92% Nebbiolo & Rossola, and 8% Chardonnay & Incrocio Manzoni  
The Nera winery started back in 1940 by Guido Nera and his son, Pietro, is now it is owned by two brothers, Stefano and Simone Nera. This Lombardy winery makes this unique made from red and white grapes. The wine is light to medium bodied with nice green apple and some tropical hints.

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## SIX MORE REDS

- **2013 La Celestiere Cotes du Rhone** (\$15)  
60% Grenache, 20% Cinsault, 20% Mourvedre  
From 50-years-old vines this CDR is loaded with red berries, earth and herbs, medium-bodied with a light cherry note in the finish.
- **2014 Grands Bois Cuvée Les Trois Soeurs** (\$14)  
60% Grenache, 30% Syrah, 10% Carignan  
From 30- to 60-year-old vines, "a delicious mouthful of wine for a song." Dark Chocolate tannins and crushed berry fruit, earth, and licorice. Organic
- **2014 Ferrandiere Cabernet Sauvignon** (\$10)  
A good little everyday Languedoc Cabernet. Blackcurrant fruit, rich, full and dry with typical French style. The vineyards are flooded at the end of each winter for 40 days – an ancestral technique to regulate the natural salinity of the soils which allows the vines to be grown on their own rootstock and not attached to American root stock and be uniquely protected from phylloxera.
- **2010 Castillo de Daroca Selection Especial** (\$9)  
Old Vine Grenache  
A great little Spanish value. Dusty earth texture and smokey black currants & blueberry fruits along with well-knit tannins.
- **2014 Nicosia Frapatto** (\$10)  
Created from an ancient grape variety typical of southeastern Sicily, this wine is distinctive for its pleasantly fragrant bouquet of fresh red fruits, raspberries and blueberries, while its taste is both lively and soft.  
13% alcohol by volume
- **2014 Cantina Filodivino Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi DOC** (\$14)  
From the Marche, Filodivino's Verdicchio comes from an organically farmed vineyard of 30-40 year old vines. The wine has aromas of acacia blossom, chamomile and peach. Delicate citrus and mineral notes tag along a generous mouthfeel that finishes with a subtle savory touch.
