

6 Reds

- **2012 Salida Two Coyote Tempranillo,** (\$15)
92% Tempraillo, 8% Grenache
Doug McCrea makes this Tempranillo from Two Coyote Vineyard near Zillah. A wisp of smoke leads into rosemary and sage with fruit tones of Marionberry, dark plum and blueberry and polished tannins that make for delicious length. **Was \$22 Now \$15**

- **2015 Lucchetti Lacrima di Morro d' Alba** (\$11)
From the Marche region of Italy, this Lacrima di Morro has a big floral quality and a little salinity from the salt air of the Adriatic Sea. Distinct and delicious. Now with a Lichtenstein lable. POW!!

- **2010 Péricou Bordeaux** (\$14)
70% Merlot, 30% Cabernet
It takes a few minutes to open up, but this mid body Bordeaux from a good vintage has bright acidity, ripe blackcurrant and berry fruit are framed by notes of cedar and crushed herb and silky smooth tannins.
13% alcohol by volume

- **2011 Grand Caumont Corbieres** (\$12)
45% Carignan, 40% Syrah, 15% Grenache
Intense & powerful with black berry fruits, violet & pepper aromas. The palate is dominated by dark berry fruit flavors; this wine is well balanced & structured with good length & a lingering finish.

- **2014 Somail Le un de Plume Minervios** (\$14)
80% Mourvedre, 20% Syrah
Baby Bandol? Pretty close. This Mourvedre heavy red has losts of dark black fruit and spicy notes with a silky texture and full tannin finish.

- **2012 Bodegas Rauda Ribera del Duero Roble** (\$11)
Tempranillo
Aged for 4 months in barrel, this Roble has fresh fruit and light toasty notes that make for easy drinking.

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6 Whites

- **2013 Salida Albarino** (\$10)
Aromas of grapefruit, pear, white melon and bold citric elements, the wine zings across the palate with a relentless citric character, yet a subtle emollient richness, slight bitterness and great texture. **Was \$16 now \$10**
- **2015 Collefrisio Pecorino** (\$13)
A a fuller-bodied Pecorino with subtle tannins and great fruit, topped with tea and peach aromas.
- **Giacomelli I Campi vino Bianco** (\$10)
50% Albarola, 50% Vermentino
From Liguria and vineyard around Cinque Terra, this coastal Italian white has aromatic complexity with hints of golden apple and hawthorn flowers, fresh-savory notes, and crisp creamy richness.
- **2015 Vaillet Vin de Savoie** (\$12)
Discreet and smoky nose with aromas of stewed fruits and notes of honey.
The mouthfeel is light and straight, with a good minerality and a slight saltiness on the finish.
11.5% alcohol by volume
- **2013 Gilbert Cellars, The Grower White \$10**
70% Chardonnay, 30% Riesling
An unusual blend of Washington's two premier white grapes, is made even more mysterious by the fact that there is no mention of the grapes on the label. The two varietals complement each other perfectly showing off the best qualities of both grapes. **Was \$15 now \$10**
- **2014 Beau Joubert Sauvignon Blanc** (\$11)
Single vineyard Stellenbosch Sauv Blanc. Tropical fruit and subtle grassy flavors which linger on to a light mineral and crisp finish.
12.5% alcohol by volume

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6 More Reds

- **2013 Magellan le Fruit Defendu Rouge** (\$10)
90% Cinsault, 10% Grenache
From 6 hectares of 40-year-old vines of Cinsault located on our sandstone soils parcels. They let the grape speak for itself. Clean cherry and plum fruit along with a bit of spice and a touch of smokiness.
Was \$13 now \$10

- **2012 Pamplin Red I.Q.** (\$15)
Cabernet, Merlot
A second label that kicks out a good bit of Washington juice for the money.

- **2013 La Celestiere Cotes du Rhone** (\$15)
60% Grenache, 20% Cinsault, 20% Mourvedre
From 50-years-old vines this CDR is loaded with red berries, earth and herbs, medium bodied with a light cherry note in the finish.

- **2011 Freja Willamette Valley Pinot Noir** (\$15)
A Oregon Pinot form a lighter vintage. Slight blueberry and wet stone on the nose with just a hint of oak (20% new wood) Wild strawberry and pomegranate on the palate with a slightly tannic finish.

- **2014 Dupre Beaujolais- Villages** (\$13)
Gamay
Single vineyard Gamay from vines planted in 1940. The wine has a good concentration full of red fruit and dring tannins.
12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2013 Altos las Hormigas Colonia las Liebres** (\$8)
Bonarda
Mendoza Region Bright raspberry fruit flavors. Rich and tasty.

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6 Rosés

- ❑ **2015 Château de Lancyre Pic Saint-Loup Rosé** (\$15)
50% Syrah, 40% Grenache, 10% Cinsault
The 2015 Languedoc Pic Saint-Loup le Rosé is juicy and crisp, with bright acidity and classy notes of strawberries, citrus rind and flowers.
13% alcohol by volume

- ❑ **2015 Domaine Montrose Côtes de Thongue Rosé** (\$12)
65% Grenache, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Syrah
Montrose is located in the Languedoc region of Southern France, 15 km away from the Mediterranean coast. The name refers to its geographic location on a volcano (Mont) and to the pink (Rose) flowers and almond trees surrounding the vineyard. The domaine was founded in 1701 and is still in the family. The Rosé has notes of red berries and peach flavors with spicy overtones making an elegant wine combining roundness and freshness.

- ❑ **2015 Contini Nieddera Rosé** (\$12)
A unique rosé made from a local Sardinian varietal. It is full of fruity aromas with a dry body and a lingering finish. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- ❑ **2015 Warwick Pink Lady** (\$15)
Pinotage Rosé
A crisp fresh pink from South Africa's signature grape. Notes of Pomegranate, wild strawberry, citrus, & peach along with just a hint of smoke.
12% alcohol by volume

- ❑ **2015 Sainte Eugénie, Corbieres Rosé** (\$11)
80% Cinsault, 10% Syrah, 10% Grenache
A bright rosé displaying fresh raspberry and strawberry notes with a slight touch of minerality and dried herbs.

- ❑ **2015 Rimauresq, le petite Rimauresq Rosé \$11**
Cinsault, Grenache, Syrah
A Provence winery, Rimauresq takes its name from the Real Mauresque, the river that flows through the vineyards. The estate benefits from both the cooling mistral winds and the shade of the mountains above. This shade gives a longer ripening period in the crucial weeks prior to harvest. The Petite jumps around with notes of red currant, raspberry, orange zest, white flowers and Provencal herbs.

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
