

## SIX REDS

- **2013 Château Pech Celeyran Cuveé Ombline** (\$10)  
40% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Malbec  
A smooth and silky southern French blend of the big bordeaux grapes but with a different twist. The wine has flavors of cassis, licorice and candied cherries. **Was \$12 now \$10**
  
- **2013 Allegret Laudun, Cotes du Rhone Villages** (\$13)  
52% Grenache, 48% Syrah  
Laudun is a lesser known Village from the Southern Rhone, The Allegret overdelivers for the money. Elegant, complex and with a fine minerality, lovely concentration. Tannins are melted and the finish is round.
  
- **2014 Kermit Lynch Languedoc Rouge** (\$13)  
60% Syrah, 30% Grenache, 5% Cinsault, 5% Carignan  
Made by Jean-Claude Zabalia of Château des Deux Rocs from Cabrières (schist) and Terrasses du Larzac (clay-limestone) with each parcel and grape variety are vinified separately. The wine is full of dry dark fruit with classic southern French spice and garrigue.
  
- **2010 Torre Oria Gran Reserva** (\$10)  
70% Tempranillo, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon  
Aged in American and French oak for twenty four months, the Torre Oria has notes of blackberries at first that expand into plums and red fruit leading to a long finish of toasty oak.
  
- **2014 Triton Tinta de Toro** (\$15)  
Tempranillo  
A big old-vine Tempranillo with dense aromas of surprisingly red fruits—dried pomegranate, cranberry, and cherry—with a fruit-leather quality join hints of crème de cassis, roast meat, licorice, and brush. Flavors are dark, with blueberry, black cherry, and touches of florality and almost peppery spice.
  
- **2013 Scagliola Barbera** (\$16)  
For four generations, the Scagliola family have been growing vines on the last hills of Monferrato, on the edge of the Langhe. Their Barbera is traditional with a nose of dusty cherry with some sage notes. The palate is medium-bodied with raspberry and dried fruits and spice.

## SIX WHITES

- **2014 Ganzo Pinot Grigio** (\$10)  
A fuller Pinot Grigio from Umbria that has well rounded tropical fruit and spice. **Was \$12 now \$10**  
12% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Popolo di Indie Bianco del Popolo** (\$11)  
100% Cortese  
A declassified Gavi, made by Terre di Mate for Indie wines. It's round, fresh and fun.  
Organic. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2015 Suavia Suave Classico** (\$15)  
Garganega  
A rich full-flavored Soave from one of the best producers. Fresh aromas of apple, pear and almond balance clean minerality and a hint of fresh herb. Crisp and refreshing on the palate, the flavors and aromas build toward a harmonious and lingering finish. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2013 Casale del Giglio Satrico** (\$13)  
34% Chardonnay, 33% Sauvignon, 33% Trebbiano  
From a 100-year-old winery in Lazio comes this uncommon blend of international and local varieties that really works. Fruity, lightly aromatic with mineral aromas which are confirmed on the palate along with a pleasing crispness and a lengthy finish. 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2015 Brichot Les Pierres Blanches** (\$12)  
50% Gros Manseng, 40% Sauvignon Blanc, 10% Ugni Blanc  
A fuller Gascogne blanc that blends the classic citrus grapefruit crispness with a lush mouthfeel.  
12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Claude Lafond La Grande Piece** (\$13)  
Pinot Gris  
From a single vineyard in the Loire, the Pinot Gris is left on its skins during its fermentation and the light pink of the grape transfers to the wine. Light berry fruit and light apples notes with some herbal underpinnings. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$20 now \$13**

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## SIX MORE REDS

- **2009 Camp Galhan Les Perassieres** (\$12)  
50% Grenache, 50% Syrah  
Les Pérassières, literally a field of wild pear trees, is a single vineyard of 22-year-old vines with a very rocky soil of gallets roulées. The wine is full of cassis, black cherry, and garrigue notes with deep black fruit flavors, black pepper spice and a bit of southern French funk. **Was \$17 now \$12**
  
- **2014 Villa Trasqua Traluna** (\$12)  
95% Sangiovese, 5% Alicante Bouschet  
A tasty little Tuscan. Aromas of ripe red cherry with spicy hints of cinnamon and cloves. Soft and ample with a smooth finish. 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Vinum Cellars Petite Sirah** (\$13)  
From Clarksberg, this PS is ripe with blueberry and boysenberry fruit which are elegantly wrapped in a silky vanilla wrapping the lush fruit is balanced by a tannic bitter chocolate finish.
  
- **2013 Château de Ruth Côtes du Rhone** (\$15)  
Grenache, Syrah  
A full and supple Rhone red with aromas of cherry and raspberry. Smooth silky tannins and a juicy finish.
  
- **2012 Grosbois Chinon Gabare** (\$14)  
Cabernet Franc  
A rich and lush Loire Cabernet Franc. Dark berries, blackcurrant and a hint of mint leaves on the nose carry through to a beautifully balanced palate that displays nuances of earth and spice. Organic  
12.5% alcohol by volume **Was \$25 now \$14**
  
- **2011 Kestrel Tribute Red** (\$13)  
40% Merlot, 29% Syrah, 11% Mourvedre, 6% Sangiovese, 4% Tempranillo  
“A blend of innovative winemaking, passion and dreams.” Aged in French Oak for 18 months. Aromas of ripe dark fruit (cherry, pomegranate, and blueberry) accompanied by dried herbs, cola, caramelized fruit, white pepper and floral aromas. The body of the wine is full and smooth with a lingering finish, and supple tannins.

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# THREE ROSÉS

- **2014 Claude Lafond La Grande Piece** (\$13)  
Pinot Gris  
From a single vineyard in the Loire, the Pinot Gris is left on its skins during its fermentation and the light pink of the grape transfers to the wine. Light berry fruit and light apples notes with some herbal underpinnings. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$20 now \$13**
  
- **2015 Commanderie de la Bargemone Coteaux d'Aix en Provence** (\$16)  
30% Syrah, 30% Grenache, 15% Cinsault, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon  
Aromas of wild strawberries and red currants, with a light, floral character and a crisp, bone-dry palate with a complex long finish.
  
- **2015 Jean-Paul Brun Terres Dorees Rosé l’Folie** (\$15)  
Gamay  
The Rosé d’Folie is fermented in tank with no carbonic maceration. It is fresh and vibrant with raspberry on the palate and a nice lingering finish. 12% alcohol by volume

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
