

SIX REDS

- **2011 Mantellassi Punton del Sorbo** (\$13)
Cabernet Sauvignon
A Tuscan Cabernet aged for 12 months in barrel. Ribena, cassis nose, concentrated on the palate with a hint of mint. **Was \$21 now \$13**

- **2013 Secoli Ripasso** (\$14)
Corvina, Rondinella, Molinara
This red wine is dark and plummy, with a mouthfeel that's silky and full-bodied. The traditional Ripasso vinting method makes for a complex wine that is generous and bold with a dry, lingering finish.
Was \$18 now \$14

- **2012 Centonze Cerasuolo di Vittoria** (\$12)
60% Nero d'Avola, 40% Frappato
A full Sicilian Red with pleasant floral and sour black cherry aromas. The body is rich and lush with ripe fruit and a good finish. Organic . **Was \$20 now \$12**

- **2012 Bergandano Langhe Nebbiolo** (\$15)
A fresh and expressive Nebbiolo with tar, roses and cherry fruit. **Was \$22 now \$15**

- **2014 Louise Dubois Cotes du Rhone** (\$13)
Syrah, Grenache, Mourvèdre
A smooth lighter Rhone with floral aromas of white flowers and pepper with smooth dark flavors of fig and spice. Organic

- **2012 Quintessence Chinon** (\$12)
Cabernet Franc
Aromas of freshly picked ripe black plums, blackberry, pencil shavings and wet earth. On the palate, dense flavors of crushed black fruits with hints of earth and graphite. It is well structured and very food friendly with a nice finish. 13% alcohol by volume. **Was \$20 now \$12**

SIX WHITES

- **2014 Popolo di Indie Bianco del Popolo** (\$11)
100% Cortese
A declassified Gavi, Bade by Terre di Mate for Indie wines. It's round, fresh and fun. Organic
12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2015 Adamo Cattarratto** (\$13)
SicilyPale straw yellow color, good aromatic bouquet, with hints of herbs, floral and citrus notes. Fruity, with good acidity and a balanced softness, excellent taste structure. Serve with fish and white meats.

- **2014 Pascal Bouchard Chablis Le Classique** (\$15)
Chardonnay
Soft, crisp and fresh, this light wine has some tangy fruit as well as bright citrus. A slight texture and attractive final acidity are enhanced at the end by a juicy apple character. **Was \$24 now \$15**

- **2015 Montinori Borealis** (\$14)
34% Gewurztraminer, 30% Muller Thurgau, 28% Pinto Gris 8% Riesling
A blend of their major white grapes, the Borealis is Intensely aromatic, with a nose of tropical flowers, ripe kiwi and melon, the silky soft palate is brimming with rose petals, pink grapefruit, mango and white nectarine then finishes on a high, clean note of bright key lime. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2015 Rizzardi Soave** (\$13)
75% Garganega, 20% Chardonnay , 5% Trebbiano
The estate Soave gives fresh, cool climate fruit on the nose leading into the palate which is light in body, but with good density of fruit. Again cooler citrus and pear fruit and an underlying refreshing mineral character persist on the palate. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2013 Viticoltori Alto Adige San Pietro, Pinot Bianco** (\$13)
Viticoltori Alto Adige is a co-operative of six wineries in Veneto. Their Pinot Blanc is aged in stainless steel and delivers crisp and clean flavors of peach and apple, supple complexity and a hint of minerality.
13% alcohol by volume

SIX MORE REDS

- **2007 Bacalhôa Sò** (\$15)
Touriga Nacional
Terras do Sado The most recognised Portuguese grape variety but not often associated with this part of the country, close to Lisbon. Grown on the foothills of the Arrábida range, the climate is fantastic. The wine has a deep red color and delightful fresh fruit flavors. 12.5% alcohol by volume. Was \$20, Now \$15

- **2011 Glorioso Rioja Crianza** (\$12)
Tempranillo
Notes of candied fruit and berries with hints of cinnamon and pipe tobacco from fine oak ageing. It is a wine of great intensity, leaving delicious flavours in the mouth. A good balance between body and acidity with notes of caramel and dried fruit on the finish. **Was \$18 now \$12**

- **2011 Brady Cabernet Sauvignon** (\$15)
Paso Robles
The Brady Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is a big and bold wine with deep color and aromas of dark berries and oak. The smooth and silky palate is complimented by delicious fruit flavors and rounded tannin and balanced acidity. **Was \$25 now \$15**

- **2015 De Fages Cahors** (\$13)
Malbec
A full, dry and smokey Malbec from the Southwest France. Organic. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2013 El Gran Loco** (\$12)
Bobal
Frm Valencia, this Bobal has ripe red fruit, sweet spices and fresh aromas. With a touch of oak. Delicious on the palat with bitter notes on the finish.

- **2012 Gonnet Rasteau, La Mado** (\$15)
80% Grenache, 20% Syrah
Highly aromatic, and with lovely concentration of fruit on the palate, and a great price.

A COUPLE OF ROSÉS

- **2014 Corne-Loup Tavel Rosé** (\$15)
65% Grenache, 15% Cinsault, 10% Syrah, 10% Mourvèdre, Clairette and Carignan.
A big full Tavel Rosé with aromas of strawberry and berry pie. The wine is drinking better than ever with a bit of age on it. **Was \$20 now \$15**

- **2015 Castel des Maures Provence Rosé** (\$14)
50% Grenache, 50% Cinsault
This wine is dry and fruity with a clear focused character. The taste of red fruit dominates. On the palate, it has a long, lingering finish. 12.5% alcohol by volume
