

## SIX REDS

- **2012 Robert Hall Paso Robles Merlot** (\$12)  
Blueberry, leather and creosote swirl together on the nose. The fruit flavors are very dark, touching on blueberry, and the tannins are strong. There is a lifting bit of spearmint on the finish, and a vanilla aftertaste.  
**Was \$20 now \$12**
  
- **2008 Enate Reserva** (\$16)  
Cabernet Sauvignon  
This CS has a good amount of currant berry fruit, black olive tapenade and some loamy earthy notes. A big and chewy wine with lots of wild strawberry jam like fruit, dark spices and earthy notes through the finish. 12 months in French oak. **Was \$26 now \$16**
  
- **2015 Domaine de l'Amauve vdp Vaucluse** (\$12)  
80% Grenache, 20% Syrah  
A great little Rhone Red with aromas of black plums, wild cherries, game, tar, and herbal garrigue and a black fruit core. stains the palate, and finishes with echoes of cherries infused with lavender-scented garrigue.
  
- **2014 Vidal- Fleury Ventoux** (\$13)  
60% Syrah, 30% Grenache, 10% Mourvedre  
A Syrah-heavy Southern Rhone blend with dark, velvety, brambly charm, perfumed with violets and black pepper and spice.
  
- **2010 Convey Priorat** (\$12)  
50% Grenache, 30% Carrignan, 20% Syrah  
This blend of Grenache, Carignan, and Syrah has plenty of raisiny ripe red and black fruit with accents of fresh herbs, and spice. **Was \$16 now \$12**
  
- **2014 Mantellassi Maestrale Ciliegiole** (\$10)  
A lighter Tuscan red that escaped the blending vats. The Ciliegiole has a flowery bouquet and wild berries, cherry and raspberry. A good fish red.

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## SIX WHITES

- **2015 Les Hauts de Bel Air Bordeaux Blanc** (\$11)  
Sauvignon Blanc  
The Hauts de Bel Air is intensely aromatic, fresh with a combination of floral notes and tropical fruit (mango, passion fruit). 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2013 Viticoltori Alto Adige San Pietro, Pinot Bianco** (\$13)  
Viticoltori Alto Adige is a co-operative of six wineries in Veneto. Their Pinot Blanc is aged in stainless steel and delivers crisp and clean flavors of peach and apple, supple complexity and a hint of minerality.  
13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2015 Ferraton Côtes du Rhône Blanc** (\$14)  
60% Grenache Blanc, 40% Clairette  
This Blanc has aromas of white flowers and white fruit. The palate is nicely balanced. Clairette brings the freshness and white Grenache body and softness.  
Organic, Bio dynamic
  
- **2015 Hecht & Bannier Lanuedoc Blanc** (\$12)  
50% Picpoul, 25% Rousanne, 25% Grenache Blanc  
The Piquepoul Blanc brings this crunchy and vivid character, which, blended with the Roussanne citrus fruits and white flowers notes, complete perfectly the aromatic pallet and give us a delightful volume in mouth.
  
- **2015 Vigna del Lauro Pinot Grigio** (\$13)  
CollioFrom terraced vineyards in Northeast Friuli, The PG is fresh and fruity with tones of pear and apple with a rich and smooth body. 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2012 Specht Alsace Pinot Blanc** (\$12)  
This is a fresh and fruity easy drinking wine, light and soft with notes of white flowers and almonds.  
12% alcohol by volume

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## SIX MORE REDS

- **2014 Rivière Minervois** (\$11)  
A young vine Syrah & Grenache from the languedoc. Dark Rainier cherries, macerated cherries, black currants, raspberries lingering with white pepper spice, garden herbs and soft tannin. 13% alcohol by volume
- **2008 Enate Reserva** (\$16)  
Cabernet Sauvignon  
This CS has a good amount of currant berry fruit, black olive tapenade and some loamy earthy notes. A big and chewy wine with lots of wild strawberry jam like fruit, dark spices and earthy notes through the finish. 12 months in French oak. **Was \$26 now \$16**
- **2015 Luccarelli Negroamaro** (\$12)  
From Puglia, Luccarelli makes this workhorse Negroamaro that is full of blackberries, cherries with a touch of thyme, earth and bitter chocolate.
- **2015 Vigna del Lauro Cabernet Franc** (\$13)  
A Cabernet Franc from Northeast Italy. This CF has aromas of cherry, raspberry, blackberry and blueberry, soft tannins and fresh herbal notes. 12.5% alcohol by volume
- **2015 Franco Serra Dolcetto d'Alba** (\$11)  
A clean, great value Dolcetto with red cherry, red berries, cranberry, raspberry, herbs, cocoa and smoke. 13% alcohol by volume
- **2014 Domaine de Couron Marselan** (\$10)  
Marselan is a hybrid cross between Cabernet Sauvignon and Grenache. The wine has good dark fruit, a medium body and is immensely drinkable.

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## TWO ROSÉS

- **2016 Clos des Lumieres Cotes du Rhone Rosé** (\$10)  
40% Cinsault, 30% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 10% Mourvedre  
Fresh off the boat the 2016's are starting to land. Strawberry and citrus aromas followed up by strawberry and cherry flavors with spiciness, and pink grapefruit. 13.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2016 Bonny Doon Vin Gris de Cigare Rosé** (\$15)  
49% Grenache, 19% Grenache Blanc, 13% Mourvèdre, 12% Carignane, 4% Cinsaut, 3% Roussanne  
The new release of BD's Rosé. Crisp with lots of fresh fruit flavors. Rosehips, cassis, fraises de bois, citrus rind, with a wonderfully austere stony finish. Sustainable. 13.5% alcohol by volume

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
