

## SIX REDS

- **2010 Otazu Primum Cuvée** (\$12)  
50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Tempranillo, 15% Merlot  
Super Navarra?? Boysenberry and a touch of herbal mint are the lead aromas on this blend of Tempranillo, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. There's power and mild heat to the palate, along with warm berry flavors that finish with a lot of intensity and push. This is generous and expressive. **Was \$15 now \$12**
  
- **2015 Ca' del Baio Langhe Nebbiolo** (\$14)  
Young vine Nebbiolo from a Barbaresco producer shows raspberry, high toned grapey essence, and hints of earth. 13.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2015 Château Teulon Costieres de Nimes Rouge** (\$10)  
60% Syrah, 30% Grenache 10% Mourvedre  
Gorgeous purity along with abundant notes of cranberries, black cherries, black currants, crushed rocks and spring flowers. Medium to full-bodied, beautifully pure and textured. Organic
  
- **2012 Tornatore Etna Rosso** (\$14)  
Nerello Mascalese, Nerello Cappuccio  
A fresh and pretty Etna wine with active aromas of white flowers and cherry notes. It is medium-bodied and has a mineral quality from the volcanic soils. **Was \$19 now \$14**
  
- **2010 Bodegas Ayuso Estola Reserva** (\$10)  
75% Tempranillo, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon  
Another Great Bargain from La Mancha. A juicy blend of fruit and spice blended together with oak aging all for very small price.
  
- **2014 Robert Ramsay Mason's Red** (\$15)  
42% Cinsault, 19% Syrah, 19% Mourvedre, 10% Grenache, 10% Counoise  
This "everyday wine" has a lot more going on it than the price suggests. Full spicy fruit in a dark Rhone style.

## SIX WHITES

- **2015 Château Teulon Costières de Nîmes** (\$10)  
Roussanne  
A great little organic white. Floral, citrus, mineral, wet rock, with lemon peel and lime with a wisp of fresh citrus. Organic. 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2015 El Coto Rioja Blanco** (\$12)  
Viura  
The El Coto Blanco is intensely aromatic, well balanced, with body and the fruit has a refreshing tart character. Pleasant acidity combines perfectly with an exquisite aftertaste of flowers, fruit and fine herbs. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **Fattoria Moretto Pignoletto Frizzante** (\$14)  
Lambrusco Secco  
A wonderful white sparkler packed with cherries, cranberries, and strawberries. 12% alcohol by volume

- **2015 Beau Joubert Old Vine Chenin Blanc** (\$13)  
This barrel-fermented Chenin Blanc spent 6 months in French oak barrels. The wine has subtle oak and crisp acid along with the zesty citrus, vibrant tropical fruit and sweet honey flavors .11.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2016 Locus Modo White** (\$14)  
50% Semillon, 50% Sauvignon Blanc  
A bordeaux style blend from our local Locus guys. The Semillon rounds out the grassiness of the Sauvignon Blanc. An easy drinking combination. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2015 Mark Ryan The Vincent Chardonnay** (\$15)  
A racy number, this wine offers spiced pear and traces of pineapple before giving way to a palate featuring green apple and ripe citrus. The mouthfeel is relatively full, with more rich apple and stone-fruit tones.

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## SIX MORE REDS

- **2011 Roques de Jeanlice Le Ringue Bordeaux** (\$15)  
90% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc  
Organic practices. 30-year-old vines. Cassis and blackberry mingle with deep-toned notes of espresso and loam in this dry, spicy, full-bodied red from the right bank of Bordeaux. **Was \$20 now \$15**
  
- **2012 Vasco Sassetti Montecucco Rosso** (\$13)  
25% Sangiovese, 25% Merlot, 25% Syrah, 25% Alicante  
A bright Tuscan blend – savory, raspberry, plum, and a bit smokey and spicy with finishing tannins.
  
- **2014 Ferraton Côtes du Rhône** (\$14)  
80% Grenache, 15% Syrah, 5% Cinsault  
The Samorens Rouge comes from vineyards situated on the left bank of the Rhône with alluvial and gravelly soil. It has aromas of ripe red fruit, spice notes and a nicely structured palate with firm and meaty tannins.  
Organic and Biodynamic
  
- **2015 Bosca La Linda Malbec** (\$12)  
Aromas of red fruits, like cherries and blackberries, layered with spicy and delicate floral notes. This wine expands on the palate with fruity flavors, while delivering a full-bodied and silky texture. Ripe tannins and balanced acidity.
  
- **2014 Kermit Lynch Vacluse** (\$11)  
55% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 15% Merlot, 10% Marselan  
The wine is made by Domaine de Durban, harvested by hand and fermented by carbonic maceration, then aged for 8 months before being bottled unfiltered. "Explosive red fruit is gracefully harnessed by a clay and limestone mineral structure, notes of violet, licorice, and garrigue. So delightfully drinkable, you'll wonder where the rest of the bottle went." Kermit Lynch
  
- **2013 Chapoutier La Cibois Luberon** (\$12)  
Grenache, Syrah  
A supple southern French red, La Cibois has complex and delicate with spicy notes (nutmeg and pepper) and black fruit aromas. The wine is well-balanced on the palate with black fruit (blueberry, blackberry, and blackcurrant) flavor. 13% alcohol by volume

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## TWO ROSÉS

- **2016 Mont Gravet Cinsault Rosé** (\$10)  
A dry Languedoc Rosé with aromas of raspberries and pears. 12% alcohol by volume
  
- **2016 Gorman 42, 39, 56** (\$15)  
Primarily of Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah and bits of everything else, the new vintage of this Washington Rosé "bled" off the crush of Gorman's big reds. The 2016 is drier than the last vintage with a citrus crispness. Zesty, aromatic and refreshing. 12.8% alcohol by volume

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
