

## SIX SATURDAY NIGHT REDS

- **2014 Usseglio Châteauneuf du Pape Cuvée Girard** \$30  
90% Grenache, 4% Mourvèdre, 4% Syrah, 2% Cinsault, 2% Counoise  
From 80-year-old vines. Cuvée Girard is a custom blend for importer Peter Weygandt. Showing a touch darker fruit and possibly more concentration, it has building tannin and a solid finish. It has outstanding potential. Biodynamic. **Was \$43, now \$30**
  
- **2011 Chantegrive Graves** \$25  
50% Merlot, 50% Cabernet Sauvignon  
A pleasing and complex bouquet of toasted bread and ripe black fruits and gunpowder. The attack is full-bodied with dry silky tannins. There is a good balance here between the ripe blackberry fruits and the solid tannins. This wine shows new wood and a touch of green flavor. 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Andeluna Altitude Malbec** \$30  
From vineyards 1300 meters high, the Altitude Malbec spends 12 months in barrel to develop the balance between the fruit and the tannins. The wine offers a deeply spiced aroma, with richly concentrated flavors of dark chocolate, mocha and roasted plum, showing some serious tannins. Asian spice and black pepper accents emerge on the dense finish.
  
- **2014 Locus Yakima Valley Red** \$25  
40% Syrah, 35% Grenache, 25% Mourvèdre  
A clean dark fruited Rhone-style blend from our neighbors down the street. The 2014 is beefed up this year with a good dose of Mourvèdre.
  
- **2014 Mas de Gourgonnier, les Baux de Provence, Rouge** \$22  
Grenache, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Carignan  
The wine aromas suggest lavender, thyme and rosemary, with plums and black raspberries enlivened with a pinch of white pepper. The mouth delivers spiced cherries and plums, with hints of ginger and bass notes of dark chocolate. Organic 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Underground Wine Project Idle Hands** \$33  
90% Syrah, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon  
A big Red Mountain Syrah, the Idle Hands has ripe notes of Bing cherries, cola, and raspberry liqueur intermix nicely with subtle notes of vanilla from barrel aging. The wine is full-bodied and lush in texture, with more red fruits and the classic peppery spicy, note.
