

SIX REDS

- **2015 Monteabellon Avaniel Ribera del Duero** (\$10)
Tempranillo
Suprisingly complex and spicy, the wine has an attractive nose of spice box, blueberry and blackberry. This is followed by a medium-bodied wine with a supple texture. **Was \$12 now \$10**

- **2012 Basel Cellars Claret** (\$15)
52% Cabernet Sauvignon, 31% Malbec, 12% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc
Ripe red berry fruits integrate well with soft toasty oak on the palate, with smooth tannins framing the structure of this Claret. **Was \$20 now \$15**

- **2015 Chapelle St. Arnoux Cotes du Rhone Vieilles Vignes** (\$12)
Grenache, Syrah
Aromas of dark berry, roasting meat, black, pepper and spice. (from 50+ year old vines) medium bodied fruit flavors combining black cherry, herb and light allspice with a long fruit/spice finish.

- **2015 Val Joanis Luberon Tradition** (\$15)
Syrah
A Southern Rhone Syrah with earthy animal aromas, full smooth, dark fruit and a nice finish.

- **2012 Châtea De Fontenille Bordeaux** (\$14)
80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon
A solid Bordeaux for the money, dusty aromas, dark fruit a juicy mid palate and a dry finish with a deep resin note.

- **2009 Airlie Marchal Foch** (\$10)
This early ripening hybrid grape make a dark red from the Willamette Valley. The 2009 shows lots of blackberry pie flavors, cardamon spice, and dry light finish. Drink it up now. **Was \$18 now \$10**

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SIX WHITES

- **2015 Terre Margaritelli Pietramala** (\$12)
85% Trebbiano, 15% Pecorino
From Torgiano, a small hill town in the heart of Umbria, The Pietramala has lovely grassy aromas and slightly citrus flavors and a fresh finish. Organic. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2014 M. Chapoutier La Ciboise Luberon Blanc** (\$13)
Grenache Blanc, Ugni Blanc, Vermentino, Roussanne
Chapoutier is known for his Northern Rhone wine which fetch a pretty penny. But his vineyards in the South are great values. The Luberon Blanc is a dry white with aromas of white blossom, lemons and exotic fruits. Good balance between the freshness and roundness with great length. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2012 Brunely Cotes du Rhone Blanc** (\$9)
50% Rousanne, 50% Marsanne
A smooth Rhone white with notes of apple, and citrus notes mixed with a savory herbal character. 13% alcohol by volume **Was \$11 now \$9**

- **2014 Colterenzio Altkirch Chardonnay** (\$13)
A clean and crisp unoaked Chardonnay from the Alto Adige, with sliced apple, pear, and lime aromas and flavors with hints of pineapples and mango. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2015 Barone Cornaccia Pecorino** (\$13)
The name for the grape comes from the sheep that like to snack on them. An intense fruity wine with mineral notes from the limestone soils and good body from some lees contact. Organic. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2014 Eugene-Carrel, Jongieux Blanc** (\$13)
Jacquère
Situated at the start of the French Alps, Jongieux vineyards are on very steep, clay-limestone slopes carved out by ancient glaciers. The Carrel shows off a fruit essence of citrus and very ripe pears, followed by a floral overtone and a slight mineral note on the finish. 11.5% alcohol by volume

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SIX MORE REDS

- **2014 Varvaglione Primitivo del Salento** (\$12)
A fruit-forward primitivo from a winery that ferments to just 12.5% alcohol. Aromas of ripe plum, espresso, and allspice lead the nose. The palate offers blackberry, black pepper and roasted coffee bean alongside juicy tannins. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2013 Puente Austral Grand Reserva** (\$14)
70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Syrah
Chile
When Gabriel Edwards, took over his family's vineyards (planted in 1945 by his grandmother Luz) in the Almahue Valley, he wanted to make his own wine. The vineyards are ungrafted, non-clonal and organic and are mowed by sheep and plowed by horse. The vinification is as natural as possible, with native yeasts and aging in used barrels that allow the fruit aromas to persist.

- **2014 Grifoll Declara, Tossals Junior, Montsant** (\$12)
60% Granacha Negra, 30% Cariñena, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon
The wine comes from 30-50 years old vines in Montsant. The wine has notes of ripe red fruit, sweets and spicy balsamic with a touch of vanilla.

- **2014 Scarpetta Squadra Rosso** (\$10)
70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Syrah, 10% Merlot
A easy quaffer from Sicily, medium-bodied with ripe red fruits and hints of cinnamon. It tastes old-world and very modern at the same time. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2011 Terre Rouge Mourvedre** (\$16)
A limited production wine - 350 cases. The classic game, meat, smoke, blackberry characteristics of Mourvèdre
Was \$28 now \$16

- **2014 Maculan Brentino** (\$15)
55% Merlot, 45% Cabernet Sauvignon
Deep ruby-red with garnet hues, the Brentino offers seductive aromas of blackberries and dark cherries, along with hints of cedar and forest due to the year spent aging in French barriques. On the palate, the wine is dry, full-bodied, and harmoniously balanced with firm tannic structure and a persistent finish.

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ROSIE ROSÉS

- **2015 Di Giovanna Gerbino Rosato** (\$10)
Nerello Mascalese
This Sicilian rosé has aromas of ripe berry, grilled herb and a whiff of wild flower lead the nose. The fresh, enjoyable palate offers fleshy red cherry, nut and mineral alongside bright acidity. Organic. **Was \$15 now \$10**

- **2016 Eugene Carrel Jongieux Rosé** (\$14)
Gamay and Mondeuse
Outstandingly crisp, this Savoy rosé has aromas of black cherry, strawberry, wild flowers and minerals.
12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Mont Gravet Cinsault Rosé** (\$10)
A dry Languedoc rosé with aromas of raspberries and pears. 12% alcohol by volume

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
