Released just in time for Halloween, but good way after. □ 2012 Jean Luc Baldes Clos Tringuedina Cahors \$33 85% Malbec, 13% Merlot, 2% Tannat A big old school Cahor packed with mineraly red and back fruit and dry tannins. s □ 2012 Tranche Cabernet Franc \$35 Blue Mountain Vineyard Delicate aromas of rose petal, lavender and wildflowers above layers of dried redcurrant, wild fig and lignified wood. Rich flavors of raspberry, leather and thyme along with herbaceous notes of eucalyptus, and cedar combine with dusty mouth-filling tannins. ☐ 2012 Brulières de Beychevelle Haut Medoc \$22 82% Merlot, 12% Cabernet Sauvignon This wine comes from vineyards owned by Saint-Julien Château Beychevelle that lie just outside the appellation. Leafy cassis aroma. Dry but extremely creamy in texture, like a creamy coffee but with black fruits through the middle, dark texture and layers of attractive fruit and acidity. ☐ 2014 Quinta da Romaneria Touriga National \$30 DouroDelicate floral nose with notes of wild flowers and violets.
