

- ❑ **2011 Domaine De Frégate Bandol Rouge**

95% Mourvedre, 5% Grenache

Aromas of violet, the raspberry, blackberry, truffle and undergrowth. A robust wine virile and powerful.

- ❑ **2009 Château Siaurac Lalande de Pomerol**

85% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc

A ripe, soft, generous wine, laden with blackberry fruits as well as spice from wood aging. Rich and full-bodied, it has power and concentration from dark tannins as well as the ripe, opulent black fruits of the vintage.

- ❑ **2010 Elvio Cagno Langhe Rosso**

50% Nebbiolo, 50% Barbera

This Piedmont has hit its stride and is tasting great right now. Think of it as a baby Barolo with the right age on it.

- ❑ **2013 Domaine Pujol Cinq Ceps**

60% Syrah, 20% Carignan, 10% Cinsault, 8% Grenache, 2% Mourvèdre

Quite rounded and ripe cherry fruit with a tannic streak. Medium-weight and youthfull. **Was \$14 now \$12**

- ❑ **2015 Duseigneur La Chapelle, Côtes du Rhône**

50% Grenache, 50% Syrah

Domaine Duseigneur is located in the village of Châteauneuf du-Pape. The 70 acres estate straddles the appellations of Châteauneuf du Pape, Côtes-du-Rhône Villages Laudun and Lirac. Made naturally from low-yield old Grenache and Syrah, its round and supple tannins fully express red fruit aromas and Provençal aromatics of lavender and white pepper. Organic. **Was \$15 now \$13**

- ❑ **2016 La Querca Aglianico**

Harvested from a single cru owned by the family estate in Puglia. With the classic ripe plum and white pepper notes that this Noble varietal is known for, it is a rare opportunity to taste Aglianico in a fresh, immediate style, that deftly manages the soft tannins. Organic
