

- ❑ **2011 Domaine De Frégate Bandol Rouge** \$28
95% Mourvedre, 5% Grenache
Aromas of violet, the raspberry, blackberry, truffle and undergrowth. A robust wine, virile and powerful.

- ❑ **2009 Château Siaurac Lalande de Pomerol** \$30
85% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc
A ripe, soft, generous wine, laden with blackberry fruits as well as spice from wood aging. Rich and full-bodied, it has power and concentration from dark tannins as well as the ripe, opulent black fruits of the vintage.

- ❑ **2010 Elvio Cagno Langhe Rosso** \$25
50% Nebbiolo, 50% Barbera
This Piedmont has hit its stride and is tasting great right now. Think of it as a baby Barolo with the right age on it.

- ❑ **2011 Tenuta Sella Lessona** \$24
80% Nebbiolo, 20% Vespolina
The Northern Piemont Nebbiolo, the Lessona has a twist of balsamic, leather, berry, and licorice, making it a complex aroma. Savory herb undertones, with a stark raspberry and cinnamon combination.

- ❑ **2014 Château Angludet Reserve d'Angludet Margaux** \$35
50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 45% Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot
Surrounded as it is by Grand Cru Classé properties, Château Angludet would almost certainly have been included in the famous 1855 Classification, had the property not been broken up as part of an inheritance settlement. The Sichel family bought the estate in 1961. Since then, they have worked to restore and improve the vineyard and cellars, giving Angludet back the reputation its exceptional terroir deserves. The Reserve is fragrant and alluring, with classy, ripe, slightly spicy aromas and a palate that is rich, supple and loaded with exotic flavors of sweet blackcurrant, licorice and pencil shavings. It has elegance, aromatic finesse and their exceptional ageing potential.

- ❑ **2012 Kaesler Old Vine Shiraz** \$25
An ageworthy old-vine Shiraz from the Barossa Valley. Cherry, mixed dark fruits, spice and cedar notes. Full-bodied mouth-filling tannins, lifted with bright acidity. Perfectly balanced and a long finish.
