- ☐ **2014 Lyrarakis Mandialri Plakoura** \$24  
100% Mandilari  
Deep intense red color. Complex nose of juicy plums, toffee and licorice balanced by chocolate and vanilla notes provided by barrel aging. Concentrated mouthfeel with a lingering finish. Ageing potential at least 10 years. 13% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2013 Schiavenza Serralunga** \$35  
Nebbiolo  
Rose petal, new leather, forest floor and balsamic whiffs of menthol take the lead on this youthfully austere red. Linear and vibrant, the full-bodied palate delivers Marasca cherry, orange zest, cinnamon, licorice and an earthy hint of game. Bright acidity and taut tannins provide an age-worthy structure. Fans of classic of Barolo will love this. Drink 2023-2038. 92pts Wine Enthusiast.
- ☐ **2014 Naches Heights Syrah** \$20  
Grown at 1800' elevation on the Goat Rocks lava flow ten miles west of Yakima, this is a rich full wine of dark berry flavors, spicy tellicherry pepper and smooth silky tannins that linger long into your taste experience. Biodynamic
- ☐ **2011 Domaine de l'Herma Terrasses du Larzac** \$27  
60% Syrah, 40% Mourvèdre  
Domaine de l'Herma in the Languedoc makes just one white and one red wine. The red has a large percentage of Mourvèdre and is deeply knitted and full with notes of red and black fruit and, menthol, thyme, and small fine tannins. Organic
- ☐ **2015 Locus Nord** \$25  
64% Syrah, 23% Cinsault, 13% Mourvèdre  
A Syrah heavy Rhone blend from our Local Locus winemakers. A nicely balanced play between the dark fruit, the smooth tannins and the fresh acidity.
- ☐ **2009 Château La Tour de Mons Margaux** \$45  
34% Cabernet Sauvignon, 55% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc, 6% Petit Verdot  
A big, full, classic Margaux. "Bright blackberry and sweet currant aromas follow through to a full body, silky and refined, with an excellent density and a long, long finish. Soild and polished. Best ever from here" Wine Spectator 92-95 pts

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
