

## SIX REDS

- **2010 Vignalta Rosso Reserva** \$17  
60% Merlot, 40% Cab Sauvignon  
Good Italian Bordeaux , the nose is complex and deep, with mineral and spicy notes, which lead to fruity varietal notes of blackberry and marasca jam, then continue with hints of grass and undergrowth. On the palate it is elegant, balanced, with a lively yet young tannic texture. Long persistence. **Was \$23 now \$17**
  
- **2014 Borgo del Cedro Lazio Rosso** \$10  
Cesanese, Sangiovese, and Montepulciano  
This red blend from the center of Italy has red fruit and violet notes. The body is supple, but structured with elegant tannins 13.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2012 Château Saint-Hilaire Medoc** \$15  
50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 45% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc  
This Cru Bourgeois has a classic Bordeaux style, with fragrant berry fruit and sweet spice and a little earthy barnyard to make it interesting. 13% alcohol by volume. **Was \$23 now \$15**
  
- **2014 Terras do Dão Irreverente** \$10  
Touriga Nacional, Tinta Roriz, Jaen and Alfrocheiro Preto  
A a fine, accessible blend of all the Dão red grapes in a mélange that is full of blackberry fruits and acidity. 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2013 La Bioca Nebbiolo** \$12  
Vibrant, expressive nose; there's an openness and briskness here, without an overload of oak or tannin, and a minty freshness to the bright cherry fruit, perfect for drinking now.
  
- **2015 Tour de Boussuet Lalande de Pomerol** \$15  
80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc  
Deeply perfumed with violets, vanilla, cocoa, and warm cherry pie filling. The palate has a broad, mouthfilling texture that deftly straddles the line between rustic and modern. Excellent layers of mocha, roasted plums, and blueberry jam sit astride hints of fresh strawberries, scorched earth, and cigar box to deliver a palate that evolves with each passing swirl and sniff. 13.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$20 now \$15**

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## SIX WHITES

- **2015 Villa Gemma Bianco Masciarelli** \$13  
80% Bombino Bianco, 5% Chardonnay, 15% Cococciola  
Straw yellow color. Fairly intense bouquet, fine aroma. Hints of yellow fruit, apple, banana, white flowers like jasmine. Pair with raw fish, medium-fat fish, fish-based first courses. 13% alcohol by volume.  
**Was \$25, Now \$13**
  
- **2013 Kir Yianni Samaropetra** \$12  
60% Roditis, 40% Sauvignon Blanc  
A high elevation, single vineyard white from northwestern Greece. The nose is dominated by aromas of kiwi, passionfruit and citrus, typical of a green Sauvignon Blanc with a refreshing character. On the palate, Roditis adds structure and crispness, supporting the intense flavors and leading to a lingering, lip-smacking aftertaste.  
**Was \$16 now \$12**
  
- **2015 Collefrisco Vignaquadra** \$10  
Passerina  
Terre di Chieti Straw-like yellow color with green reflections. Citrus aromas, bergamot, white flowers typical of the mediterranean area. Good acidity, persistent on the nose. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$15 now \$10**
  
- **2016 Evesham Wood Blanc de Puits Sec** \$14  
85% Pinot Gris, 15% Gewurztraminer  
From the 1986 planting on the estate. The nose leaps from the glass with bright jasmine, honeysuckle and rose followed by a flavor of pear, balanced weight on the palate and bright acidity. It finishes with spice from the Gewürztraminer. Organic. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$17 now \$14**
  
- **2017 Château Darzac Bordeaux Blanc** \$11  
36% Sémillon, 26% Sauvignon Blanc, 23% Muscadelle, 15% Sauvignon Gris  
Entre-Duex-Mers Medium body with a rich mouthfeel and notes of fresh citrus, melon and green apples. Crisp and clean on the long finish. Pair with grilled snapper, roast chicken, summer salads, and mild cheeses.  
13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Herbauges Muscadet Sur Lie** \$12  
Melon de Bourgogne  
Planted on 30 hectares of pebble covered schistose subsoil, these 30 year old vines are managed under Sustainable Agriculture practices. Pineapple, melon, and lemony citrus lead in the nose, with minty underpinnings. A fine beam of minerals runs throughout, leading to a delightfully refreshing finish.  
12% alcohol by volume. **Was \$16 now \$12**

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## SIX MORE REDS

- **2016 Thulon Morgon** **\$15**  
Gamay  
A top cru beaujolaise for a non cru price. You'd expect to easily pay \$10 more for this than you have to. It is quite a bargain. 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2017 Col del Mondo Sunnai Montepulciano** **\$13**  
A fresh and berry packed Montepulciano with nice acidity and smooth dark fruit. 13.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2016 Radley & Finch The Prof's** **\$13**  
Pinotage  
Ripe, plush and spicy, with dark berries, pomegranate, and a hint of dried cranberry. A nice round expression of fruit. Organic. 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2015 Les Dauphins Cotes du Rhone Reserve** **\$10**  
Grenache, Syrah  
If you can look past the goofy packaging the Dauphins is a tasty little Rhone with ripe red fruits fragrance with blackcurrant and a hint of spices. Elegant structure with smooth tannins and harmonious finish.
  
- **2016 Solea Aglianico** **\$10**  
Amazingly approachable for a young Aglianico, the Solea makes a great easy drinking wine with still a bit left to chew on. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2012 Château De Macard Bordeaux Superieur** **\$10**  
50% Cabernet Franc, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot  
A great little value Bordeaux. The Cabernet Franc really comes through on the palate, with offerings of attractive black cherry fruit and spices. There is superb balance, purity and elegance with refined tannins, freshness and a seamless finish. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$16 now \$10**

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## THREE ROSÉS

- **2017 Col del Mondo Sunnai Montepulciano** \$13  
A fresh and berry packed Montepulciano with nice acidity and smooth dark fruit.  
13.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2017 Les Hauts Plateaux Alpes de Haute Provence Rosé** \$11  
40% Grenache 40% Syrah 20% Cinsault  
An amazing value rosé with aromas of white flowers and gooseberry. Very lush on the palate with strawberries, plum and melon notes. Nice acidity to give it balance and length. Supple in texture and easy to drink.  
13.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2017 Regaleali Le Rosé** \$11  
Nerello Mascalese  
Le Rose offers delicate aromas of cherry, raspberry, blackberry, and, appropriate to its name, rose petals. Rich on the palate with refreshing acidity and a long, flavorful finish, this is what Sicilians enjoy in the summertime. 12% alcohol by volume

## TWO BUBBLES

- **La Biòca Ricciante** \$10  
Freisa 85%, Barbera 15%  
This extra dry Vino Spumante pairs well fish-based main dishes, meat or mushroom-based appetizers. Fresh, crispy, red berries, bell pepper, strawberry, lime, medium-body, high acidity, bone dry. 12% alcohol by volume  
**Was \$15, Now \$10**
  
- **La Luca Prosecco** \$11  
Glera  
The nose is instantly defined and distinctive, offering up bold orchard fruits, crisp pears, and lemon curd, all of which come together in a rich, creamy off-dry style that is extremely appealing. 11% alcohol by volume

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
