

## SIX REDS

- **2016 Cesar Langa Frenesi** \$13  
35% Shiraz, 35% Garnacha, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot  
The Langa family owns more than 70 hectares of vineyards spread over two Biodynamic farmed estates. The Frenesi has a very mineraly aroma with spicy notes such as clove, cinnamon, pepper and vanilla. It has s ripe, even jam-like black fruit, beautiful tannins, a silky and round, muscular body. Organic
- **2012 Cap Léon Veyrin Lustrac-Médoc** \$15  
55% Merlot, 42% Cabernet Sauvignon, 3% Petit Verdot  
The nose is rich in black fruit aromas, with delicate notes of toasted bread and roasted coffee. Well-balanced and ample on the palate. The tannic structure is silky and velvety. **Was \$25 Now \$15**
- **2012 Casanova della Spinetta Terre di Pisa** \$15  
Sangiovese  
Aromas of wild cherry, black currant and sweet plum. On the palate, this wine offers silky tannins and a fruity chewy finish as well as lots of cherry with elegant richness. **Was \$20 now \$15**
- **2016 Tombacco Aglianico** \$14  
Big, rich, warming and smooth. Hints of cherry and red berries, with a marked vanilla and spicy note lead into an excellent mouth feel, elegant and warm, sapid and full-bodied with some spice on the long finish.
- **2012 Sichel Château Argadens** \$12  
63% Merlot, 32% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc  
Bordeaux Supérieur 2012 Château Argadens presents itself as the poster child for Right Bank Bordeaux. This delicious blend offers generous fruit, surprising complexity and supple balance. Aromas of boysenberry, cassis, cedar, and spice waft from the glass. **Was \$17 now \$12**
- **2015 Popolo di Indie Vino Rosso** \$13  
45% Nebbiolo, 35% Barbera, 20% Dolcetto  
The Barbera brings the acidity and bright fruit, the Nebbiolo brings the tannins and the aromatics, and the Dolcetto brings the softness and rounds out the blend. Good Piedmont juice at a great price.  
12.5% alcohol by volume

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## SIX WHITES

- ☐ **2016 Fattoria Monticino Rosso Pignoletto** **\$13**  
This Emilia Romagna White has nothing to do with what the winery's name suggests, but it has a spicy aroma, full of scents of flowers: Wisteria, hawthorn, broom, bitter almonds, apple, pear, apricot, peach, hints of ginger, herbs, white rose, grapefruit, papaya, almond blossom, hints of river stone. You could spend the afternoon trying to name them all while you drink the wine. 13.5% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2016 Domaine de Joy l'eclat Gascogne Blanc** **\$10**  
50% Colombard, 20% Ugni Blanc, 20% Gros Manseng, 10% Sauvignon Blanc  
This is an attractive blend with 20% Gros Manseng to give some richness to the herbal character of the Colombard and Sauvignon Blanc. There are pear and apricot flavors as well as the crisp green and citrus fruits. 12% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **Gertie & Max Gutedel Dry** **\$15**  
The Gutedel grape, also known as Chasselas. Its home turf in Germany is the tiny sub-region of Markgräflerland, Germany's warmest growing region. It sits at the edge of the Black Forest which protects the area from inclement weather. This is a gentle, dry, aromatic wine floral aromas and a palate with subtle notes of tropical fruit with a pleasing nuttiness. 12% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2017 Pascal Jolivet Attitude** **\$13**  
Sauvignon Blanc  
Attitude Sauvignon Blanc is produced from an estate-owned single-vineyard within the appellation of Chevery located to the west of Sancerre. The wine has a freshness in mouth, delicate green and lemon flavours, citrus fruits, green apple and kiwi aromas. 12.5% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2016 Aves De Sousa Branco** **\$13**  
Viosinho, Rabigato, Gouveio  
This fresh Portuguese white has a very rich nose, citrus notes along with a great minerality, a rich mouthfeel and a dry finish. 12.5% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2017 Solea Falanghina** **\$10**  
Vina Tribinalli's private bottling is crisp, fresh with herbal nuance and a great value. 12.5% alcohol by volume

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## SIX MORE REDS

- **2012 Château Mayne-Vieil Cuvee Alienor Fronsac** **\$12**  
Merlot  
The distributor was cleaning the closet and found a few bottles of this 2012 Fronsac. Smokey cherry aromas, with some leafy mocha tones. There is a lot of dark earthy notes here, mild tannins and acidity. One to drink not cellar. **Was \$18 now \$12**
  
- **2016 Novacella Schiava** **\$14**  
Quite light and thin in body, with a soft, uncomplicated nose of cherry. On the palate, it bursts with Rainier cherry, almond extract and a light trace of white flower, such as honeysuckle. Really pleasant texture that is silky yet nicely sticks to the tongue. Pairs well with anything you'd normally pair to a Pinot Noir.

- **2016 Travignoli Chianti Rufina** **\$12**  
Sangiovese  
A fresh and bright Chianti with notes of plum, star anise and white pepper notes alongside polished tannins. Very easy drinking without being simple.
  
- **2014 El Coto Crianza** **\$13**  
Tempranillo  
A clean, bright Rioja with fresh fruit, with notes of vanilla and toasted oak. On the palate it is silky and persistent presenting a taste of well blended spice. 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2014 Marchesi di Barolo Maraia** **\$13**  
Barbera  
An everyday Barbera when you don't want to pop for their Barolo. Starting with a forthright nose of wild, dark berries and clay earth, the medium-bodied wine carries forward zestily and playfully on the palate with those same tasty, flavorful notes of dark berries but finishes on the bright acidity of young cherries and raspberries. 13.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2017 Casas del Bosque Carmenère Reserve** **\$13**  
Carménère, originally from Bordeaux is now being cultivated in significant quantities in Chile. Characterized by the presence of spicy notes, Carménère is the last of all our red grapes to ripen. It is aged for 10 months in French oak barrels before release. On the nose heady notes of cedar, bacon fat, and graphite with just a hint of fresh lavender. In the mouth, an initial attack of black cherry, sweet tobacco and cinnamon gives way to just a touch of earthiness and ripe bell pepper. 13.5% alcohol by volume

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## SIX ROSÉS

- **2016 La Mascaronne Quat Saisons Rosé** \$15  
50% Cinsault, 30% Grenache, 20% Syrah  
An elegant Rosé with aromas of rose petals, citrus, tropical fruit and raspberries. 13% alcohol by volume  
**Was \$20 Now \$15**
  
- **2017 Two Birds One Stone Cinsaut Rosé** \$10  
A silky French Rosé of mysterious origin. Dry and very floral and hard not to like.
  
- **2017 Le Grand Ballon Touraine Rosé** \$11  
Gamay, Cabernet Franc and Malbec  
This Loire rosé delivers delicious nuances of red fruits and spring flowers. This wine is fresh and round on the palate. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2017 Henri Bonnaud Stef Rosé** \$13  
Mourvèdre, Grenache, Cinsault  
Family run for generations this organic wine greets you with a flowery aroma and mineral and citrus skin notes. Organic 13% alcohol by volume
  
- **2017 Vallevó Costa dei Trabocchi Rosatto** \$13  
Sangiovese  
This Rosé from the Marche region of Italy is fruity and crisp with notes of lean strawberry, red fruit and soft florality. It is bright and refreshing. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **Santola Vinho Rosé** \$10  
This Rosé version of Vinho Verde is light and crisp with a slight sparkle. 10.5% alcohol by volume

## TWO BUBBLES

- **Maset Cava Brut Nature Nu Reserva** \$12  
Macabeo, Parellada, Xarel·lo  
Bodegas Maset has been making their delicious Cava for more than 200 years. The Nu Reserva has crisp, clean, citrus fruit notes of apple & pear. 11% alcohol by volume
  
- **Luis Pato Baga Spumante Rosé** \$15  
Truly unique, this delicious, subtle pink sparkler is made from the бага grape ~ Fresh, fruity nose with a subtle herby edge. The palate is quite zippy but there's some breadth here.

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
