

SIX 3^M REDS

- **2012 Tionio Ribera del Duero** \$15
Tempranillo
Complex aroma with hints of red and dark fruits. It is a complex wine with different aromatic layers. In the mouth present a good structure, with volume, and good persistence. It is a wine characterized by its good balance between tannin and acidity. **Was \$25 now \$15**

- **2015 Cazal Viel Saint Chinian Vieilles Vignes** \$15
Produced from hand-selected old vines on the estate, this is a classic blend of Syrah, Mourvèdre and Grenache. The nose is intense and spicy with hints of black pepper and cloves. On the palate, this wine is round and full-bodied, showing a very fine balance between tannins and oak. **Was \$17 now \$15**

- **2016 Carlos Serres Old Vine Tempranillo** \$11
The Tempranillo grapes for this wine were selected by the winemaker from their growers' best sources of old vines, ones that are 50+ years old and in some of the best terroirs around Haro. Aromas of fresh, red and black fruit, liquorice and vanilla notes. Dark fruit in the mouth which is intense and long, but also finishes with fresh acidity. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2015 les Terrasses Château Neuf du Pape** \$30
A negociant, under the radar, CNDP that makes up in price what it lacks in pedigree. Aromas of dark cherry, licorice, orange peel and spice notes. The acidity is bright and fresh with more cherry, cinnamon and orange marmalade on the palate, land smoky tannins on the finish.

- **2009 Malvira Roero** \$25
Nebbiolo
From 25-35 year old vines in the Trinita and Renesio vineyards planted at 300 meters above sea level. Aged for 20 months in 450 liter casks. Wine rests in bottle for an additional 12 months prior to release. We got just a bit of this that got lost in the warehouse. See you this baby Barolo holed up.

- **2016 Andrew Will Merlot** \$30
A buoyant and appealing wine, the 2016 Columbia Valley Merlot offers up ripe fruit balanced with tannin and acid. It has a well-defined middle palate and a lasting finish, particularly after being opened for some time. Well-knit and full in the mouth. The fruit comes from the Two Blondes and Champoux Vineyards.

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SIX 3^M WHITES

- ☐ **2015 Terre Margaritelli Pietramala** \$10
85% Trebbiano, 15% Pecorino
From Torgiano, a small hill town in the heart of Umbria, The Pietramala has lovely grassy aromas and slightly citrus flavors and a fresh finish. Organic. 13% alcohol by volume. **Was \$12 now \$10**
- ☐ **2017 Firriato Altavilla Della Corte** \$13
Grillo
A sicilian white with delicate scents of white spring flower and citrus. On the bright, linear palate, fresh acidity supports peach and lemon zest while a hint of saline picks up the finish. 12.5% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2014 Vens le Haut Jacquère** \$14
The Jacquere vines are planted in Chautagne, a “cru” site in the Savoie; the specific lieu-dit is known as “les Carsines”. Jacquere is marked by a strong minerality with a vivacious acidity and an herbal bouquet. Organic 12% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2014 Seguinot Chablis** \$20
Chardonnay
A bright, high acid, crisp, mineral driven white. The light calcareous clay soils impart floral, fresh and mineral aromas. 12.5% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2014 Château D'Alix Pessac-Léognan** \$22
Sauvignon Blanc, Sémillon
Top quality Bordeaux Blanc, this is a full, fruity and textured wine, with quince and apple flavors that are freshened by the citrus acidity.
- ☐ **2015 Marangona Lugana** \$18
Turbiana
Aromas of white spring flower, mature orchard fruit and a whiff of graphite float out of the glass. The fresh, concentrated palate doles out ripe white peach, mature Granny Smith and Bosc pear while mineral and almond notes back up the finish. 13% alcohol by volume

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
