

SIX REDS

- **2015 Nitida Cabernet Sauvignon** \$15
Nitida is located in the hills overlooking the beautiful city of Cape Town. This is a very smokey SA Cab with notes of leather, cocoa, black currants, and rosemary. **Was \$18 now \$15**

- **2016 Nicolas Idiart Pinot Noir** \$13
This Loire Pinot is a great value. Red berries with licorice and spices. It is harmonious and balanced, with a plump fruitiness and silky texture.

- **2015 Cap Leon Veyrin Lustrac-Medoc** \$16
55% Merlot, 45% Cabernet Sauvignon
This wine is rich, dense and structured. It has plenty of tannins as well as generous black-plum and spice flavors. Wood aging added light toastiness and is smoothing out the fruit. **Was \$30 now \$16**

- **2015 Monte Santoccio Valpolicella** \$13
40% Corvina, 30% Corvinone, 20% Rondinella, 10% Molinara
Pure, mineral and fresh aromas with a hint of wild cherries, smooth tannins and pleasant taste.
Was \$20 now \$13

- **2016 Jean Claude Mas Mas de Mas Corbieres** \$13
45% Syrah, 35% Grenache, 20% Carignan
A big-shouldered wine from Corbieres, the Mas de Mas is deep purple with complex with spicy aromas, white pepper, cinnamon and figs. Garrigue notes and small ripe red berries flavors.

- **2012 Fattoria Giuseppe Savini Colleventano** \$10
Montepulciano d'Abruzzo
On the palate it's light, elegant, but also strong and majestic, with a great structure. Tannic, velvet and persistent in taste. Spicy and fruity flavors return in the end. 13% alcohol by volume

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SIX WHITES

- **2017 La Gustiniana, Gavi di Gavi** \$15
Cortese
Gavi di Gavi is the famous white wine region of Piedmont, known for bright, aromatic and elegant wines made from Cortese grapes planted in mineral-rich soils. This one from La Giustiniana displays classic notes of green apple, almond and hints of herb and minerals. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2017 Domaine de Maubert Cotes de Gascogne** \$10
Columbard, Ugni Blanc, Gros Manseng, Sauvignon
Côte de Gascogne Crisp and fruity with a nose of citrus aromas and a bigger body than most Gascogne Blancs. Good with salads, shellfish and light dishes. 11.5% alcohol by volume

- **2014 Folk Machine Tocai Friulano** \$10
A Mendicino Tocai. Super lean, crisp, a little saline, and very drinkable. Fermented and aged for a short time in stainless steel. No commercial yeasts or nutrients were used. 11% alcohol by volume. **Was \$14 now \$10**

- **2017 Kivelstadt Cellars The Family Secret** \$15
Sauvignon Blanc
From a small Sonoma winemaker with an old world sensibility, this wine is a composite of two styles of Sauvignon Blanc. The 50% in barrels bring texture and depth, which is balanced by a racy zing from the stainless tank. **Was \$19 now \$15**

- **2018 MontGras Sauvignon Blanc** \$10
Intense citrus fruits aromas, like passion fruit and lemon zest. Subtle floral notes with some herbal touches. This wine has a refreshing and very juicy mouth. The pleasant and intense citrus flavours are also present in the mouth, accompanied by lively acidity and a long finish. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Nicolas Idiart Sauvignon Blanc Touraine** \$14
Made from 35-year-old vines planted in sandy clay soils, this Loire Sauvignon Blanc has a lovely nose of apples, citrus, tropical fruits and dusty gravel. It is a bright and energetic wine that also carries good texture and finishing length. 12.5% alcohol by volume

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SIX MORE REDS

- **2013 MontGras Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva** **\$12**
Blackberry and plums framed by mocha, vanilla and cedar. This wine has structure, depth and fine texture with currant and black cherry fruit notes. Flavors of toast and mocha round out the lingering finish.

- **2016 Piantaferro Primitivo di Manduria** **\$14**
An oaked primitivo It is a single varietal Primitivo, from a small vineyard parcel in the heart of the superior Manduria DOC in the heel of Italy. This is a fine example of primitivo: full-bodied, jammy with tones of chocolate and raisins. Really meant to be drunk young, those that love fruity wines will not be disappointed.

- **2014 Domaine des Terrisses Gaillac Rouge** **\$14**
50% Braucon, 30% Duras, 20% Syrah
A distinctive blend from the Southwest of France. Expressive with aromas of dark berries, spice and peppers. On the palate the wine is rich and flavorful with a powerful acidity, firm tannins and a wonderful concentration of savory flavors balanced with bright fruit. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Monte Tondo Marta Corvina** **\$13**
A lighter, fresh veneto red. Perfect for summer sipping. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2015 Hernando y Sourdais Antidoto** **\$16**
Tempranillo
Ribera del DueroThe Antidoto is meant as an antidote to the many Ribera del Duero wines that substitute heavy-handed winemaking for a sense of place and variety. The wine comes from 80-year-old vines in the cooler part of Ribera del Duero and is unfiltered and unfinned and aged in neutral barrels. The wine has red fruit flavors, a racy acidity and considerable minerality on the palate. **Was \$25 now \$16**

- **2011 Kavur Gali Evreshe** **\$15**
34% Merlot, 33% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Cabernet Franc
The 2011 Evreshe has an intensely aromatic profile, with concentrated blackberry and plum flavors throughout. The acidity and tannin structure are complex, especially for an unoaked wine such as this. Rich and deep on the finish, ending with a savory note.

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THREE ROSÉS

- **2017 Campuget 1753 Rosé** \$15
80% Syrah, 20% Vermentino
This upper tier Rosé from Campuget, comes from a vineyard just south of Nîmes near the village of Manduel whose soil is formed of 'gress', an accumulation of rounded pebbles that have been rolled by many overflows of the Rhône river thousands of years ago. The vines also benefit from the Mediterranean sunshine, which bring the grapes to perfect maturity. The nose is full of grapefruit and exotic fruits. A delicate freshness offers a vibrant and delicate mouth with hints of red fruits. 13% alcohol by volume. **Was \$20 now \$15**

- **2018 Domaine du Petit Romain Costières de Nimes Rosé** \$13
70% Grenache, 30% Cinsault
Bright pink color, pleasant complex nose with floral and fruity notes. The mouthfeel is round and delicate. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2018 Coutale Rosé** \$13
Malbec
A Rose from Cahor in the SW of France. Fresh and crisp with lots of dark berry flavor underneath.

TWO BUBBLES

- **2011 Delmas Cuvée Mémoire Brut Nature** \$15
Mauzac, Chardonnay
A nod to Bernard's grandfather's ancestral technique of ageing (24 months) in oak barrels, this wine has generous aromas of pear, with good minerality and richness, and a long finish. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$25 now \$15**

- **Castell des la Comanda Cava** \$11
40% Xarello, 40% Macabeu,
20% Parellada A good inexpensive Cava -elegant nose, lime curd and aniseed, the palate is clean with terrific concentration of flavor. 11.5% alcohol by volume

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
