

SATURDAY NIGHT RED SELECTIONS

- ❑ **2015 Château Vaudieu Châteauneuf du Pape****\$40**

80 % Grenache, 15% Syrah, 15% Mourvèdre

Richly layered, with hedonistic fig, boysenberry and raspberry confiture flavors that roll over each other while mouthwatering anise, fruitcake and black tea notes chase from behind. Best from 2020 through 2040.

- ❑ **1996 Marqués de Tomares Grand Reserva****\$30**

Tempranillo

You would think it was only 5 years old. There is a ton dark blackberries, tobacco and leather on the palate. A ton of structure left. Aromas of berry , cherry , plum , earth , leather and herbs
- ❑ **1985 Chateau Haute Serre Cahors****\$30**

Malbec

A library release from Haut Serre. The nose opens generously with tart hints of blackcurrants, blackberries, plums, black pepper, smoke and slivers of oak. The palate is juicy, medium-bodied with good concentration; shows overall ripe tart fruits wrapped in oak, smoke, wet tobacco and a subtle spice note. An aged wine at an easy price. **Was \$65 now \$30**
- ❑ **2016 Yves Cheron Coteau de la Baume Crozes Hermitage****\$20**

Syrah

A great deal for a northern Rhone Syrah. Rich dark fruit and chalky minerality. 13.5% alcohol by volume.

Was \$23 now 20
- ❑ **2011 Rollan de By Medoc****\$25**

70% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc, 10% Petit Verdot

he ripe, full-bodied 2011 Rollan de By exhibits lots of black currant, cedar and lead pencil shaving characteristics. With good acidity, medium to full body and excellent depth, it should drink well for a decade. 13.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$30 now \$25**
- ❑ **2017 Gulfi Cerasuolo di Vittoria****\$23**

50% Frappato, 50% Nero d'Avola

Bright and snappy, this delightful Cerasuolo shows blackberry and cherry notes with a hint of spice, all bolstered by a lively acidity. Organic. 13.5% alcohol by volume

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SATURDAY NIGHT WHITE SELECTIONS

- **2016 North Valley Chardonnay** **\$25**
Willamette Valley
This 100% Chardonnay offers aromas of golden apple and honey dew. On the palate, it shows primary flavors of bosc pear and granny smith apple, as well as secondary flavors of oyster shell and lemon peel. The finish is racy, bright and lingering.

- **2017 J. Moreau & Fils Chablis** **\$30**
Chardonnay
Intense and fruity, with aromas of mandarin and pineapple on a soft background of fresh almonds. Fresh and generous, very typical of its appellation, showing a very pleasing minerality. The finale is long-lasting and saline, perfect to emphasize any type of sea food.

- **2018 Cherrier & Fils Sancerre** **\$23**
Sauvignon Blanc
The estate has limestone and calcareous clay soils that wonderfully influence the character of the grapes grown there. The Sancerre is consistently delicious, with citrus, chalky mineral and light floral notes. Its dry finish compliments seafood and cheese beautifully.

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
