

SIX REDS

- **2013 Di Stefano Meritage** \$15
64% Cabernet Sauvignon, 24% Petit Verdot, 12% Cabernet Franc
This traditional Bordeaux blend is full bodied and masculine. This wine is enticing with molasses, black cherry tobacco and brown sugar aromatics. The tannins are packed tight with the rich black cherry and cocoa

- **2017 Terre Margaritelli Roccascossa** \$11
70% Sangiovese, 30% Cabernet Franc
From the heart of Umbria, the Roccascossa is a blend of Sangiovese and Cabernet Franc. The flavors move between fruity cherry and savory smoke. The ripe, red berries are contrasted with hints of pepper and bright acidity.

- **2017 Fond Croze Cuvee Confidence Côtes du Rhone** \$13
70% Grenache, 30% Syrah
A rustic CDR with notes of forest floor, black fruits, blackberries and cassis followed by peppery notes and leather.

- **2015 Labastide Haute Cahors** \$14
Malbec
This old vineyard in the heart of the Cahors landscape has produced a rich, smoothly textured wine. The juicy black Malbec certainly has tannins, but the ripe fruitiness shines. **Was \$18 now \$14**

- **2015 Domaine de la Lande Bourgueil Les Gravieres** \$15
Cabernet Franc
A very mineral driven Cab Franc with dusty dried cherry fruit, with licorice and spice notes and a leathery finish. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$25 now \$15**

- **2017 Freehand Cellars Syrah** \$13
Aromatics of blackberry jam, plums and black currants followed by layers of smoked meats with a touch of anise and white pepper. The entry is smooth with lush tannins and a perfect balance of oak and dark fruits that envelopes the palate with rich layers of exotic spices, followed by a lush finish that showcases the gorgeous French oak.

SIX WHITES

- **2016 Sparkman Apparition** \$13
75% Roussanne, 12% Grenache Blanc a, 13% Marsanne.
This wine is mostly Roussanne (70%), with the balance equal parts Marsanne and Grenache Blanc, with the fruit coming from Olsen and Boushey Vineyards. Lemon verbena, grape-nut, peach and apple aromas lead to broad stone-fruit flavors.

- **2016 Monacesca Verdicchio Di Matelica** \$12
This wine's heady Spanish broom, acacia and yellow stone fruit scents lift out of the glass. The palate mirrors the nose, offering creamy peach, yellow apple and juicy citrus flavors alongside bright acidity. An almond note caps off the finish. 90 points Wine Enthusiast. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2018 Franchetto La Capelina Soave** \$13
Garganiga
The volcanic soil gives the wine a note of rare elegance and complexity. “La Capelina” has a beautiful freshness and mineral olfactory sensations of flint, citrus and flower, in particular cedar and lilies, apricot and elderflower. The palate is very persistent. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2018 Kuentz Bas Alsace Blanc** \$12
60% Sylvaner, 15% Muscat, 15% Auxerrois, 10% Gewürztraminer
This traditional blend shows notes of very ripe pear dominate the nose. The palate shows crisp acidity to aid the spicy pear fruit. It is bone dry with smoky yet bright flavors. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Pierre Henri Muscadet Sevre-et-Maine Sur Lie** \$12
100% Bourgone de Melon
Named after Pierre-Henri Gadais whose family also owns Domaine Gadais, this is a bright, lively wine, rich with layers of ripe fruit, minerality and tight acidity. It is intense, with great fruitiness and a cool edge of final acidity. 12% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Castel Sallegg Sauvignon** \$12
From Alto Adage ~ Classic and direct Italian Sauvignon Blanc. aromas of grapefruit, peach, freshly cut grass, tomato leaves and nettles. It is moderately heavy, juicy and fresh on the palate with a pleasant mellowness and a good length. **Was \$18 now \$12**

SIX MORE REDS

- ☐ **2018 Colosi Nero d'Avola** **\$14**
this Nero offers intense fruit notes with heavy cherry aromas. On the palate, it is dry, full-bodied and youthful.

- ☐ **2017 Marani Saperavi Qverri Red** **\$15**
Saperavi is Georgia's premier red varietal, it comes on with the intensity and longevity of an all night feast. The wine has firm tannins with an earthy element from 6 months spent aging underground in qvevri (clay pod-like vessels nestled in the earth for natural temperature control). That earthen quality is a signature trait of Georgian wines. Notes of tart pomegranate and currant jam give way to a peppery dill on the finish.
- ☐ **2017 Domaine De l'Espigouette Côtes du Rhone Vieilleis Vignes** **\$15**
70% Grenache, 10% Syrah, 10% Mourvèdre, 5% Carignan, 5% Cinsault
An old vine CDR with aromas of dark cherries, clove and spice. Medium to full bodied. Balanced, long and classy. Organic
- ☐ **2015 Chateau Vignol Brodeaux Superieur** **\$14**
Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc.
A firm workhorse Bordeaux with aromas of red currant, red plumb, mint and spices and leathery tannins.
13% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2016 Dommaine Allégret Laudun** **\$13**
52% Grenache, 48% Syrah
Bright and complex, the mouth is pleasant and round. Highly structured, it has an excellent balance of tannins. 13% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2018 Della Seta Rosso Di Montepulciano** **\$16**
Sangiovese
Ripe red-berry and fragrant blue-flower aromas lead the nose while the juicy savory palate offers crushed raspberry, wild cherry and baking-spice notes. It's already accessible, with supple tannins

THREE ROSÉS

- **2016 Domaine De Sainte Rose Coquille d'Oc Rosé** \$10
80% Grenache, 15% Syrah, 5% Mourvèdre
Elegant and complex blend of early picked Grenache, Syrah and Morvèdre. Pleasing pale strawberry color with aromas of grapefruit and pear drops. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2018 Domaine Montrose Côtes de Thongue Rosé** \$10
65% Grenache, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Syrah
Montrose is located in the Languedoc region of Southern France, 15 km away from the Mediterranean coast. Red berries and peach flavors with spicy overtones. Elegant wine combining roundness and freshness. Was 12% alcohol by volume. **\$13 Now \$10**

- **2018 Henri Bonnaud Stef Rosé** \$11
40% Syrah, 30% Grenache, 30% Cinsault
A coral robe with silver shades. The nose is delicate and complex with a palette of aromas spices pepper, little red fruits and almond notes Mouthfeel is full with gourmet final, close to red fruits with a pinch of liquorice. Organic. 12% alcohol by volume. **Was \$15 now \$11**

THREE BUBBLES

- **Domaine Saint Vincent Brut** \$13
80% Chardonnay, 20% Pinot Noir
Made by Gruet, the Domain Saint Vincent Brut is a soft yellow-gold, crisp and lively, with a nose of green apple and citrus mineral notes. This well balanced food-friendly sparkler offers bright, crisp acidity complemented by a touch of yeast on the delightfully long finish. 12% alcohol by volume

- **Domaine Brazillier Méthode Trad** \$14
100% Pineau de Aunis
From France's Loire Valley, 'Méthode Trad' Brut draws you in with rich aromas of fresh-baked bread & baked apples, & upon first sip, more than delivers, offering a lovely palate play of toast, baked bread, apples, cherry, and even a hint of orange rind. Awesome affordable French sparkler. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **Vincenzo Toffoli Prosecco di Conegliano-Valdobbiadene DOCG Extra Dry** \$15
100% Prosecco
Vincenzo grew up working the vineyards until 1964 when he was able to buy some of them and start making his own wines. Now most of the work has passed on to his sons. Their Prosecco is clean and fresh with a nice sparkle.

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
