

## SIX REDS

- **2015 San Polo Rubio Toscana** \$12  
85% Sangiovese, 10% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc  
An everyday super Tuscan, the Rubio has intense aromas of red cherries, violets and currants, followed by a hint of spice. Well-structured and balanced on the palate, Rubio is easy-going and versatile, but also notable for its intensity and elegance. **Was \$16 now \$12**
  
- **2015 Gryphon Crest Pinot Noir** \$13  
From the Baden region in Germany, Intense black plum and cherry perfume juxtapose savory tones of smoked nuts and wet earth in this fresh and fruity yet composed wine. Plump black fruit flavors are broad and rich but framed by brisk acidity and a trace of mineral complexity. A fantastic introduction to German Pinot. **Was \$16, now \$13**
  
- **2016 Campos de Risca Jumilla** \$10  
90% Monastrell (Mourvèdre), 10% Syrah  
From the sunny arid part of SE Spain known in Spanish as the 'Levante'. Intense and a deep-red Bordeaux color. The nose shows aromas of dried and some fresh fruits, red berries but also dried figs and prunes. The palate is explosive but full of soft fruit and tannins. Organic . **Was \$13 Now \$10**
  
- **2017 Quinta dos Roques Quinta Do Correio** \$12  
45% Jaen, 35% Touriga Nacional, 10% Alfrocheiro, 10% Tinta Roriz  
A rich dao region red. Wonderfully easy drinking, but full of fresh fruit and herbiness with enough body to stand up to barbeques and the like.
  
- **2016 Château Andriet Élevé en Fût de Chêne** \$12  
88% Merlot, 12% Cabernet Sauvignon  
A great entry level Bordeaux hits all the right buttons at a great price. **Was \$15 now \$12**
  
- **2016 Anne-Sophie Pic & Michel Chapoutier Côtes-du-Rhône** \$14  
Grenache and Syrah  
A joint project between a famous chef and a famous winemaker. Very bright & snappy, aromas of red fruits (mainly morello cherries) and spices (liquorice, grey pepper). The tannins are firm and silky and the wine has a great structure. **Was \$18, now \$14**

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## SIX WHITES

- **2018 Terredora Dipaolo Le Starse** \$12  
100% Coda de Volpe  
Floral and fruit aromas of honeysuckle and ripe orchard fruits while the linear, medium-bodied palate doles out ripe pear, acacia honey and almond. It has a tangy finish thanks to saline notes and bright acidity 13% alcohol by volume **Was \$18 now \$12**
  
- **2019 Antione Simoneau Estate Bottled Sauvignon Blanc** \$11  
Bright white currants and crisp acidity are star attributes of this simple, fruity wine. Its herbal texture is light and easy to drink. 12% alcohol by volume
  
- **2016 Lethaler Drago Pinot Grigio** \$12  
TrentinoA bright, fresh and fragrant expression of one of Italy's most versatile grapes. The bouquet opens to forthcoming aromas of cut grass, citrus and white peach. The finish is sleek and pure. 13% alcohol by volume **Was \$18 now \$12**
  
- **2018 Benito Ferrara Vigna Cicogna** \$15  
Grecco de Tufo  
Made from 15 to 60-year-old vines, this Italian white stands out from its rivals due to its intense structure and dry, mineral texture – a great example of why connoisseurs get so excited by Greco. This is lean, with incredibly fresh, mouthcoating acidity, and light aromas of green apple, grapefruit, chamomile, jasmine, and almonds. **Was \$27, now \$15**
  
- **2018 Ventenac "Coup de Chance"** \$13  
70% Columbard, 20% Chenin Blanc, 10% Gros Mansang  
Crisp, prominent acidity with lots of minerality on the palate backed up by citrus fruit notes. It drinks a lot like a young Petit Chablis but with a little dollop of Southern French sunshine. Organic.  
12% alcohol by volume
  
- **2017 Iovine Lacryma di Christi del Vesuvio Bianco** \$12  
Caprettone, Falanghina, Greco  
The soils (made up of volcanic deposits from eruptions of the Vesuvius) give this blend its distinct character. It is an elegant, floral wine with a slightly acidic, lovely freshness. 13% alcohol by volume

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## SIX MORE REDS

- ☐ **2017 Karas Armavir Region Rouge** \$15  
35% Syrah, 35% Cot, 20% Cabernet Franc, 10% Tannat  
Armenia  
From the Armavir Region, Armenia. This excellent blend is expressive and lively. Its fruity aromas and great acidity makes the wine elegant and easy to drink.
- ☐ **2017 Domaine Gassier Fluer de Syrah** \$14  
90% Syrah, 5% Grenache, 5% Carignan  
Hints of anise and roasted meat accent ripe black plum and cassis in this Syrah amplified by 5% each of Grenache and Carignan. Full bodied and plump in mouthfeel, it finishes on fine-grained tannins and a whisper of char. It's an approachably fruity but elegant wine for everyday.
- ☐ **2018 Grand Caumont Corbieres** \$15  
45% Carignan, 40% Syrah, 15% Grenache  
Intense & powerful with black berry fruits, violet & pepper aromas. The palate is dominated by dark berry fruit flavors; this wine is well balanced & structured with good length and a lingering finish.
- ☐ **2017 Ventanac Tet de Pioche!** \$12  
Merlot  
A playfull Merlot from the base of the Pyrenees.
- ☐ **2014 Owen Roe Rosa Mystica** \$15  
Cabernet Franc  
Aromas of dark plum and rich floral notes are enhanced with a mouthful of classic Cabernet Franc tannins, black pepper and licorice notes. A lovely mid-palate of candied fruit and blackberry preserves finishes with gripping acidity; a sign of great potential for cellaring over the next decade and beyond.
- ☐ **2016 Grand Bateau Bordeaux Rouge** \$10  
80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon  
Ruby color. Nose is delicately toasty and opens towards ripe fruit aromas of cassis and prunes, vanilla and spices. On the palate fleshy, soft, and elegant, sustained by ripe and savory tannins. 13% alcohol by volume

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## SIX ROSÉS

- **2019 Fratelli Cozza Figlia Della Notte Ramato** **\$11**  
Pinot Grigio  
Ramato (Italian for “auburn” or “copper”) wines are produced by macerating Pinot Grigio grape must with its skins. The skins’ pink hue give the wines color. Look for aromas baking spice, dried fruit, tropical fruit and herbs with good structure and tannin. 12.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2019 Cantarelle Madam Côtes de Provence Rosé** **\$15**  
Reveals itself in a glass of light rosé with delicate violet reflections, revealing a floral bouquet with aromas of citrus fruits such as grapefruit, some lime and delicate hints of orange blossom. 12% alcohol by volume
  
- **2019 Hito Rosado** **\$15**  
100% Tempranillo  
Clean on the nose with a crisp red fruit aromas and subtle hints of citrus. Fresh and well balanced in the mouth with a medium and warm finish.
  
- **2019 Mark Ryan The Vincent Rosé** **\$15**  
40% Merlot, 37% Syrah, 12% Cabernet Franc, 11% Cabernet Sauv  
delightful citrus and floral aromas that mirror on the palate. Soft fruit flavors include cranberries, salmon berries, melon, and pear. Bright acidity and honeysuckle combine and linger on the finish.
  
- **2019 Illahe Tempranillo Rosé** **\$17**  
The 2019 Illahe tempranillo rosé offers fresh aromas Lemon zest, spruce tip, rhubarb, and fleshy watermelon rind. A fresh, bright, and crisp harmonious pallet rounds into juicy honeydew melon and Oregon strawberry finish. Pair with sunshine. Hand Picked. 12% alcohol by volume
  
- **2019 Sleight of Hand Magician's Assistant Rosé** **\$18**  
Cabernet Franc  
Aromas and flavors of pomegranate, white flowers, and Spring rain, all buoyed by a backbone of minerality and acid. Fermented in stainless steel and aged in neutral barrels. 13.4% alcohol by volume

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## SIX BUBBLES

- **2018 Kir-Yianni Akakies Sparkling Rose Amyndeon** \$15  
Xinomavro  
The grapes are sourced from the viticultural zone of Agios Panteleimon within the Amyndeon appellation in Florina, Northwestern Greece. The high altitude (600m) and the poor sandy soils of the area lead to the production of wines displaying finesse and a rare aromatic character. Deep bright rose color. Overabundant bubbles pointing out the wonderful smells of Xinomavro. 12% alcohol by volume. **Was \$20 now \$15**
  
- **2018 Antech Émotion** \$15  
Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc, Mauzac and Pinot Noir  
Limoux  
A crisp rosé sparkler that has proved a favorite over the years. 12% alcohol by volume
  
- **Proa Cava Brut Méthode Traditionell** \$13  
40% Macabeo, 30% Xarel-lo, 30% Parellada  
Translucent pale yellow with foamy head effervescence. Nice composition with a quite dry profile, well-balanced and with a rather long refined taste. Pair with shellfish, appetizers and snacks, lean fish, cured meats, or just as an aperitif. 11.5% alcohol by volume
  
- **2015 Sarno 1860 Spumante di Qualità pas dosé 15** \$15  
Fiano  
Composite and fascinating bouquet, which tells of delicate fragrances of peach, bergamot, acacia flowers, wisteria, orange blossom, linden, sage and honey. Mineral and balsamic puffs. A sparkling, dry, fresh, aromatic, persuasive, sweet, elegant, intriguing and balanced sip enters the mouth. Seductive and creamy palate and then caressed by a deep and very expressive gustatory amplitude. **Was \$30 now \$15**

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
