

SIX SATURDAY NIGHT REDS

- **2016 Masseria Seteporte Etna Rosso** \$24
Nerello Mascalese, Nerello Cappuccio
Rustic, mineral, at times even herbal, but with a smooth and generous fruity core. This is the essence the Etna Rosso from Masseria Setteporte, produced with grapes from thirty-year-old vines which dig their roots deep into the volcanic soil of Mount Etna. **Was \$30 now \$24**

- **2014 Pasquale Pelissero Bricco San Giuliano Barbaresco** \$27
A family estate, single-vinyard Barbaresco that comes from an 8-hectare parcel at about 400 meters above sea level and is aged mostly in large botte. Plum, cherry, licorice and leather notes on a broad frame. Tight and dense, with a lingering, fresh finish. **Was \$40 now \$27**

- **2014 Sassetti Livio Rosso di Montalcino** \$21
Lots of earth and richness to this rosso with plums, mushrooms, violets and dark fruit. Full body with soft, velvety tannins and a long finish. This is masterful rosso. From one of the top producers of Brunello. 92 pts James Suckling. **Was \$30 now \$21**

- **2010 La Antigua Rioja Classico Reserva** \$20
60% Granacha, 30% Tempranillo, 10% Graciano
Ripe red berries, violet and cracked pepper on the nose; a vanilla nuance emerges with aeration. Seamless in texture and appealingly sweet, offering pliant raspberry and cherry flavors and a hint of mocha. Closes smooth and fruity, with subtle tannins coming in late.

- **2014 Jean Gardiés La Torre** \$20
70% Mourvedre, 20% Carrignan, 10% Grenache
Aromatic, fruity nose of black currant and spices with a light touch of vanilla. The palette is rich in flavors with a very powerful finish. Organic. **Was \$30 now \$20**

- **2017 Beaucastel Coudoulet Rouge** \$32
30% Grenache, 30% Mourvédre, 20% Syrah, 10% Cinsault
The vineyard for the Coudoulet lay just outside of the Châteauneuf du Pape appellation and the wine drinks much more like a Châteauneuf than a Côtes du Rhone. The nose evokes aromas of red fruit, blackberries, black cherries and licorice. In the mouth one finds hints of wild thyme and a finely structured wine that shows very good length.

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SIX SATURDAY NIGHT WHITES

- **2018 Santo Santorini** \$27
Assyrtiko
The island of Santorini has a 3,500 year tradition in vine cultivation. Santos Assyritiko shows its varietal character, which embraces white flowers, citrus fruits aromas and intense minerality. It is vivid, with full, well-balanced body and distinctive long after taste.
13% alcohol by volume

- **2018 Bernard Fleuriet Tradition Sancerre** \$25
100% Sauvignon Blanc
A blend of 50% grapes grown in clay-limestone soil which gives the wine its richness and power and 50% grapes grown in the stony, calcareous caillottes which gives it freshness, vivacity and fruitiness.

- **2017 Jean-Luc Colombo La Belle du Mai Saint Peray** \$20
60% Rousanne, 40% Marsanne
A full Rhone white. An intense floral and fruity nose with notes of iris, candied fruit and fresh hazelnuts. Full-bodied palate with rich, concentrated flavors of quince, vanilla, and a slight lemon zest.
13.5% alcohol by volume

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
