

SIX SATURDAY NIGHT REDS

- **2012 Neyers Sage Canyon Red Wine** \$20
45% Carignan, 25% Grenache, 15% Mourvèdre, 15% syrah
Some very-old-vine (120 years) Carignan anchors this very complex Rhone style red that drinks amazingly well for the money. Rich layered and delicious.

- **2015 Corte Volponi Valpolicella Ripasso** \$20
55% Corvina, 25% Corvinone, 20% Rondinella
Dried red and black fruit mingle with pepper spice, minerals/earth, leather and light tar. It's a nicely balanced wine, well-made wine. **Was \$25 now \$20**

- **2016 Domaine Berthet-Bondet Côtes de Jura Trio** \$25
Trousseau, Poulsard, Pinot Noir
A fine Jura red, primary aromas and flavors included strawberry, red cherry, tomato leaf, tea, tarragon, juniper, and rhubarb. Tertiary notes included dusty trail and cherry compote. Organic.
12% alcohol by volume

- **2013 Owen Roe Ex Umbris** \$20
Syrah
This 100% varietal wine offers generous notes of fig, chocolate and smoke. It's restrained yet rich, supple and layered with boysenberry and chocolate flavors that linger. **Was \$30 now \$20**

- **2014 Delille D2** \$40
58% Merlot, 36% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc, 1% Petit Verdot
Here's a chance to get some D2 with some age on it.. There is a proliferation of red and black fruits on the nose and palate, including blackberries, cranberries, raspberries, pomegranates, black cherries and marionberries. Wrapped around these fruit characters is a presence of mint chocolate, black olive, cedar, toasty oak and vanilla. With bright acidity and good structure, this wine is extremely well built and offers a dollop of red fruit flavors in its lengthy finish.

- **2009 Abadia Retuerta Ribera del Duero** \$24
70% Tempranillo, 17% Syrah, 13% Cabernet Sauvignon
From the neighbor of Vega Sicilia. This red shows density and structure, with firm, well-integrated tannins and balsamic acidity supporting plum, currant, dark chocolate and mineral flavors. Polished and harmonious.
Was \$30 now \$24

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SATURDAY NIGHT WHITES

- **2017 Terlano Terlaner Classico** \$25
60% Pinot Bianco, 30% Chardonnay, 10% Sauvignon Blanc
This really captures the mountain freshness of this Alpine region and the minerality of the stony soils of this appellation, and marries them with extremely attractive citrus fruit and just the right amount of creaminess. Long, very pure finish. 13.5% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Valenti Enrico IV** \$20
Carricante
Etna Bianco
Spicy nuances of mango, kiwi, mandarin orange zest and lime, accompanied the fruit aroma by curled aromas such as mint and basil. In the end, there is something flint that reproduces the distinctive terroir of Etnas with its volcanic soils. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Du Mont Epin Mâcon Peronne L' Etoile** \$18
Chardonnay
Mont Epin extends on 13 hectares of vines, located on clayey limestone slopes and planted with 100% chardonnay. These beautiful soils are revealed through meticulous, rigorous and passionate work of Richard and Stephane Martin. The result is great white wines, with subtle balance between floral notes, minerality and fruity notes. With signature freshness. 13% alcohol by volume. **Was \$22 now \$18**

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
