- ☐ **2018 Domaine de la Denante Macon Verze** \$18  
Chardonnay  
The soil in Verzé produces a wine with more tension. This wine is harder, but still with a nice richness, full of ripe apple and crisp pear flavors. Acidity comes with citrus and kiwi fruit. 13% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2016 Du Mont Epin Mâcon Peronne - L' Etoile** \$18  
Chardonnay  
Mont Epin extends on 13 hectares of vines, located on clayey limestone slopes and planted with 100% Chardonnay. These beautiful soils are revealed through meticulous, rigorous and passionate work of Richard and Stephane Martin. The result is great white wines, with subtle balance between floral notes, minerality and fruity notes. With signature freshness. 13% alcohol by volume. **Was \$22 now \$18**
- ☐ **2017 Famille Perrin Vinsobres Les Cornuds** \$15  
50% Grenache, 50% Syrah  
Vinsobres, a beautiful village located north of Châteauneuf du Pape is cultivated primarily on terraces particularly suitable for Syrah. It develops notes of violet, smoked meat and blackberries. The Grenache is also suited to this terroir, full bodied and not heavy, with notes of black chocolate, cherry and typical Garrigue aromas. Well-balanced and complex in the mouth, it offers a nice acidity, freshness and a hint of bitterness reminiscent of limestone.
- ☐ **2014 Aston Troy Bisou** \$15  
64% Merlot, 27% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Petite Verdot.  
The 2014 'Bisou' begins with aromas of dark fruits and a touch of milk chocolate. Flavors of red cherry, pencil shavings, coffee grounds and red bell peppers show nicely on the palate. This red should continue to evolve nicely over the next few years. Part of the proceeds from this sale go to families in need from Covid 19.
