

SIX SATURDAY NIGHT REDS

- **2013 Rutherford Hill Cabernet Sauvignon** \$30
Napa Valley
Dark and lush with ripe plum and blackberry fruit; intense, balanced and rich with depth, style and finesse; juicy and balanced with ripe flavors and no herbaceousness; deep and long. **Was \$50 now \$30**

- **2016 Mas de Boislauzon Chaussy-Laget No.6 Châteauneuf-du-Pape** \$40
70% Grenache, 30% Mourvedre
Mas de Boislauzon is managed by Daniel Chaussy and Christine Chaussy. Daniel Chaussy and Christine Chaussy, brother and sister are the sixth generation in their family to manage Mas de Boislauzon. Biodynamic

- **2014 Château Priere-Lichine Confidences Margaux** \$35
65 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 30 % Merlot, 5 % Petit Verdot.
From the southern part of Margaux, the 2014 Château Priere Lichine is little gem well worth seeking out. Offering lots of classic black cherry fruit, tobacco, herbs, and damp earth, it's medium to full-bodied, impeccably balanced, and has moderate, chalky tannins on the finish. **Was \$45, now \$35**

- **2016 Clos de Gamot Cahors Malbec** \$25
Fruits noirs, mûres, pruneaux et mentholé, Bouche: belle fraîcheur, harmonie, équilibre et longueur en bouche. Classic.

- **2014 Domaine Gardié Clos des Vignes** \$20
40% Grenache, 30% Carignan, 20% Syrah 10% Mourvedre
This medium to full-bodied, ripe, layered and concentrated 2014 has plenty of dark fruit, obvious minerality and notable acidity.

- **2016 Château Rozier Saint-Emilion Grand Cru** \$28
80% Merlot, 18% Cabernet Franc, 2% Cabernet Sauvignon
Deep purple color, the flavor lends a great freshness associated with red and black fruits, with a woody and slight vanilla edge. The tannin gives it a fleshy, smooth and delicious yet elegant taste.

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THREE SATURDAY NIGHT WHITES

- **2016 Domaine Chante Cigale Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc** \$30
25% Grenache Blanc, 25% Clairette, 25% Roussanne, 25% Bourboulenc
Nose of exotic fruits and white flowers. Mouth marked by its roundness, finesse and its final mineral. Orange sherbet aromas give way to mixed citrus, but they're all backed by zesty, briny complexity and fabulous length.

- **2017 Domaine Belle Les Terres Blanches** \$21
70% Marsanne, 30% Roussanne
Crozes-Hermitage
A bright style, with a wet stone note running under the mix of white peach, verbena and yellow apple fruit flavors. Light honeysuckle and chamomile accents show on the finish. Organic

- **2017 L'Archetipo Fiano** \$20
The wine has a fine floral, fruity and grassy nose. Medium-body, soft and very fresh. Bio-Dynamic

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
