

SIX REDS

- **2015 Tomera Reserva** \$15
Petit Verdot
This supple, juicy red wine is 100% Petit Verdot from Finca Los Alamos, high in the Uco Valley of Mendoza, Argentina. It shows herbal aromas with subtle notes of tobacco and cocoa. On the palate you are met with abundant stone fruit flavors of wild plum and inklings of minerality. Silky tannins and a pleasing medium body mouthfeel culminate with a pleasing, lengthy finish. **Was \$25 now \$15**

- **2017 Basel Cellars Claret** \$15
30% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Franc, 23% Cabernet Sauvignon, 17% Malbec
The vibrant bouquet shows hints of ripe cherry, cedar, perfume and pencil shavings. Ripe red berry fruits integrate well with soft toasty oak on the palate, with smooth tannins and good acidity framing the structure of this Claret. **Was \$22 now \$15**

- **2017 Domaine Pélaquié Rive Droite Lirac** \$14
70% Grenache, 30% Mourvèdre
The medium to full-bodied Domaine Pélaquié 2017 Lirac starts with scents of black olive, but then those blend easily into red fruit flavors on the palate. Most impressive is the rich, velvety texture, which lingers elegantly through the long finish. **Was \$16, now \$14**

- **2018 Palazzo Margara Nerello Mascalese** \$12
Sicily
Violets. Red fruits (dried cherry, red plums) with notes of herb and crushed rock. Light to medium in body. Pleasantly dry. 13.5% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Château Saint Seurin Bordeaux** \$13
60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot
A great everyday Bordeaux with flavors of red small ripe fruits, spices, and vanilla. Flexible wine, with a good intensity, very pleasant in mouth. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2018 Domain des Grand Rocs Juliéнас** \$15
Gamay
Cru Village Beaujolais at a very pleasant price. Medium-bodied cherry and berry fruit layered over a mineral backbone.

SIX WHITES

- **2019 Villa Sparina Gavi** \$15
Cortese
A great Piedmont white with a delicate bouquet of dried pineapple and peach. Full and rich in flavor, yet mineral and refreshing. Fine aromatic flavor to the end. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2019 Campos De Luz Cariñena** \$7
100% Viura
Ok so the labels look like they have been run through a rock grinder. This fresh little wine from the Aragon Region of Spain is and easy quaffer. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$12 now \$7**

- **2016 Leth Reid Steinagrund, Grüner Vetliner** \$15
From Steinagrund vineyard; vine age 30 years; stony, gravelly soils with loess cover;. The bouquet promises fresh fruits and ripeness as well: yellow apple, honey melon and a hint of quince. On the palate a classic Grüner Veltliner, rich in fruit, a peppery spice, charming and full of finesse. Organic. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$25 now \$15**

- **2017 Villa Chiópris Sauvignon Blanc** \$12
Friuli
100% Sauvignon blanc, which grown in the Collio area, near the Italian- Slovenian border. It has intense and typical aroma, dry taste with a long lasting final note. 12% alcohol by volume

- **2019 Rock Meadow Cellars Viogneir** \$13
Lake Chelan
A very affordable Washington white the showcases a smooth rich body with notes of peach and pear and a touch of spice. 12.8% alcohol by volume

- **2018 Viladellops Penedés White Wine** \$13
100% Xarel·lo
From very old Xarello vineyards, this Spanish white is fresh with notes of white fruit and aniseed.
Was \$15 now \$13

SIX MORE REDS

- **2017 Sharecropper Cabernet Sauvignon** \$12
Bright aromas of blackberry, candied fruit, vanilla and brown sugar leads to a more savory palate of pomegranate, green pepper and oil cured olives. This Cabernet finishes with bright acidity and lingering tannins. Banged up bottles. 13% alcohol by volume. **Was \$17 now \$12**

- **2018 Villa Sparina Barbera del Monffato** \$14
A red with lots of dark-berry, asphalt and slate aromas and flavors. Full body, loads of fruit and a long, flavorful finish. Balsamico, too. Characterful. Refined and transparent style.

- **Roadside Cellars, Roadside Red** \$10
Columbia Valley
A smooth and juicy Washington red blend that goes down as easily as the price.

- **2018 Marani Gemieri** \$13
60% Saperavi, 20% Aleksandrul, 20% Malbec
A unique Georgian blend. Ripe blackberry and blackcurrant with the hints of prune aromas. Young with soft sweetness, accompanied with aromas of red fruits, which is balanced with grape tannins during the finish.
12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2015 Lorenzo Sassetti Montecucco Rosso** \$15
100% Sangiovese Grosso
The bouquet is dark and earthy in the best possible way, as savory herbs give way to crushed black cherry, encased in an air of smoky minerals, sous-bois, and hints of animal musk. The 2016 La Querciolina Montecucco Rosso then floods the palate with silky textures, offset by cool-toned red fruits and minerals, riding a core of brisk acids. It finishes with medium length yet brimming with energy, as a mix of savory spice and minerality slowly tapers off, leaving just a hint of dried cranberry. **Was \$22 now \$15**

- **2019 Vina Gormaz Ribera del Duero Joven** \$10
Tempranillo
A “little” Ribera with “big” personality. Aromas of crushed red fruits, spices, and leather. Medium bodied with a smooth, dry finish.

SIX PINK

- **2019 Moulin de Gassac Guilhem Rosé** \$14
40% Grenache, 40% Cinsault, 20% Carignan
Nuances of peach, strawberry, wildflower and “flint” all harmonize on the nose. Flavors of not-quite-ripe raspberry, apricot and peach delight the palate and finish with crisp sweet/tart acidity balanced with a hint of minerality. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2019 Vetriccie Corse Rose** \$13
50% Niellucciu, 35% Sciaccarellu, 15% Grenache
The wine jumps out of the glass with aromas of red berries, melon and pomegranate kissed with a touch of wet stone. This rosé is deliciously delicate and washes over the palate with wave after wave of energetic fresh fruit flavors. Perfectly balanced, this wine exhibits a beautiful marriage of fine minerality and elegant acidity. 12% alcohol by volume

- **2019 Trasiego Quartz Rosé** \$11
100% Pinot Noir
A Chilean rosé for Leyda Valley, where the cool ocean breezes keeps the grapes crisp and fresh. Fresh peachy aromas with citrus and red fruit flavors. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2019 La Domitienne Grenache Gris Rosé** \$14
Terrific notes of peach, strawberry and orange blossom on the nose. Fresh and light, showing a floral edge to the brisk core of peach pit on the attack, medium-bodied, layered and elegant, with a full-mid-palate, integrated acidity and a great crispy finish. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2019 Fattoria Svetoni Felice Rose** \$13
100% Sangiovese
A Tuscan rosé with an intense bouquet, hints of rose and white violet. Fresh, mineral, round, sapid. Good structure. Persistent finish. 12% alcohol by volume

- **2019 Jean Orliac Le Loup dans la Bergerie Rosé** \$15
60% Syrah, 40% Cinsault
A new Languedoc pink from the Orliac family to round out the Le Loup trio. With crunchy red fruit aromas and an energetic palate, this Southern French rose is as value you can't turn down. 12.5% alcohol by volume

FOUR BUBBLES

- **Achard-Vincent Brut Sparkling** \$14
Clairette de Die
This brut bottling is a dry wine made exclusively from Clairette, crafted by the méthode traditionnelle that is also used in Champagne. With refreshing citrus and a hint of honeysuckle on the nose followed by a delicious-with-anything palate, this minerally sparkler ensures palate stimulation with every sip. 11.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$20 now \$14**

- **Ameztoi Hijo de Rubentis Extra Brut Rosé** \$12
Hondarrabi Zuri and Hondarrabi Beltza
Sparkiling Txakolina!! This salty spritz shows flavors of grapefruit, tart red berries, and sea spray. Think of it as an instant transport to the sandy shores of northern Spain. 12% alcohol by volume. **Was \$25 now \$12**

- **Domain D'Orfeuilles Brut Rosé** \$12
100% Malbec
This artisanal product is completely hand-crafted using the méthode champenoise (traditional champagne production method that promotes a second fermentation in the bottle). The first aromas are fresh with dark fruit and notes of fresh baked brioche. The refreshing crisp flavors of blueberries and fraise des bois (wild strawberries) just dazzle the palate. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was 18, now \$12**

- **d'Astruc Blanc de Blancs Brut** \$10
Chardonnay
100% Chardonnay, this fantastic sparkler is a clear, bright yellow with fine, lively bubbles. Fragrant aromas of white flowers and tropical fruits. Fresh and elegant on the palate with elegant bubbles. **Was \$15 now \$10**
