

SIX REDS

- **2018 Vignerons Proprietes Associse Ozilhan Reseve Cotes du Thone Rouge** \$13
60% Syrah, 40% Grenache
Ripe red fruits, raspberries, black cherries, integrated spices and lush finish. Organic

- **2016 Chateau Les Aubiers Blaye** \$12
80% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Malbec
A rustic Bordeaux with spice cedar, woody baking spice and dark berry aromas on the nose. Rich, full-bodied and intense on the palate with ripe dark fruit, spiced plum, black currant, cedar brush flavors lingering on the finish. Biodynamic

- **2017 Casata Monticello Barbera d'Asti Superiore** \$11
A complex little Barbera for very little money. Aging for one year in wood barrels adds class and body.

- **2018 Luigi Bosca Malbec** \$15
Mendoza
Deep ruby red color, with aromas of ripe red fruit, spices and black pepper. The palate intensity is complemented by the softness and sweetness of tannins. Full-bodied and well structured. **Was \$20 now \$15**

- **2019 Pietra Majella Montepulciano d'Abruzzo** \$9
This little Montepulciano out performs its price. Lots of medium-bodied ripe red fruit. That will go great with food or just by itself. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Casa de Illana Tres de Cinco Crianza** \$15
36% Petite Verdot, 28% Syrah, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 16% Bobal
From Ribera del Jucar comes this big wine. Plum reduction, black cherry and really crispy tannins. The structure is solid with fine acidity balancing the tannic bite. The mid palate has iodine and more black cherry with a touch of charcoal. The finish is long and dry, the tannins starting to get ahold of the gums.

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SIX WHITES

- **2017 Le Terre di Stefano Massone Gavi** \$12
Garganega
Stefano Massone is devoted solely to white winemaking, with vineyards located in the warmer southeastern part of the region in Gavi, where the Cortese grape achieves maximum ripeness. The nose is delicate, but the persistent aroma of fruit and flowers makes it particularly elegant. Dry with a crisp acidity and a pleasant mineral flavor. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$15, now \$12**

- **2011 Pascal Jolivet Pouilly Fume** \$15
Sauvignon Blanc
This SB has a bit of age on it which fills out the fruit core making it seem like a cross between Sancerre and Chenin Blanc. It has aged beautifully. Terroirs are blended: 50% limestone, 30% flint, and 20% limestone clay. Limestone brings minerality and finesse. Limestone-clay enhances fruit and richness. Flint provides structure and minerality. **Was \$30 now \$15**

- **2018 Domain Brichot Les Pierres Blanches** \$13
50% Gros Manseng, 40% Sauvignon Blanc, 10% Ugni Blanc
This crystalline wine expresses itself on a nose of acacia flowers, a superb fruit of wild peaches and a very fresh mineral finish. "We persevere in the search for the mineral and floral expression of this wine." 8 months aging on fine lees with stirring. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Darting Pinot Blanc Trocken** \$13
Pfalz
A dry German Pinot blanc the matches body with spicy acidity. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2019 Soie d'Ivoire La Lisse** \$13
Chenin Blanc
This ripe yet crunchy fruit gives this wine it's freshness, vigor and spine, at the same time it's luscious texture which is further complemented and enriched from one third vinified and matured for nine months in seasoned French oak barrels. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2019 Vignerons Proprietes Associ Cotes du Rhone Blanc** \$13
40% Grenache, 30% Viognier, 16% Clairette, 8% Rousanne
Floral fragrances, and lime flower, The palate is round and fleshy in the mouth, nice acidity. Well balanced with warm summer apples. Organic

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SIX MORE REDS

- **2018 Mas de Boislauzon La Chaussyette** \$14
Grenacche, Syrah, Mourvedre, and other grapes
A field-blend from the Rhone with enough non-traditional grapes in there to make it a Vin de France. All stainless tank aged, this wine has lots of dark, dry, spicy flavors that lurk around in the glass waiting to come out with a bite of food. Organic

- **2017 Domaine Alary La Gerbaude Côtes du Rhône** \$15
70% Grenache, 30% Syrah
This Rhone has intense aromas of herbs, spice, black fruit, plum and cassis. The palate carries over the black fruit, with a dense texture on the finish. Hand Picked

- **2018 Stephen Vincent Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon** \$13
Classic Cabernet Sauvignon notes with aromas of blackberry liquor, boysenberry, and anise with hints of pipe tobacco and exotic spices and a slight suggestion of spearmint. Flavors of the darkest fruits such as ultra ripe raspberry, black currant, dried black cherry, and blood plum with oakderived notes of caramel, toasted coconut, and briarwood. Tight tannins create texture while a delicate thread of acidity maintains flavors well into the finish. **Was \$20 now \$13**

- **2015 Guido Berta Barbera d'Asti** \$15
Bright on the nose, with plenty of floral and ripe strawberry aromas. The fresh and focused palate features notes of juicy fruit and summer berries with clean acidity and a subtle herbal finish.

- **2019 Sixty Clicks Shiraz** \$10
Victoria, Australia
A really expressive, bright, contemporary Aussie red. The nose of soft, open, chocolatey fruit has a clove note with a palate of fresh brambly, cherry-red fruit that leads to a gently spicy finish.

- **2018 Casa Contini Verso Rosso Salento** \$14
60% Negroamaro, 35% Primitivo, 5% Malvasia Nera
Puliga
Dried fruit, plums and spice with a silky texture and structured elegance. Verso is a very full-bodied, luscious wine made with a small percent of 'appassimento', or raisined, grapes.

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SIX PINKS

- ☐ **2019 Jean-Luc Colombo Cape Bleue Rosé** \$13
67% Syrah, 33% Mourvèdre
Soft, delicate pink. Subtle hints of peach, rose petal and pepper on the nose. Dry and complex, with intriguing notes of raspberries, fresh cherry, black olive, and fennel. A great rosé to enjoy on its own or with a wide range of appetizers, fish, poultry dishes and vegetarian fare. 12.5% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2019 Maison Philippe Vaillet Savoie Rosé** \$10
100% Gamay
Fresh and intense with aromas of redfruits (strawberries, red currants). The palate is crisp with spicy notes on the finish. 12% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2019 Blanville Solal Rosé** \$12
50% Grenache Gris, 50% Cinsault
This Languedoc rosé opens with soft aromas of white cherry, peach, cantaloupe and cranberry. The melony flavors continue through to the palate, while the finish offers a refreshing astringent citrus-pith flavor. 12% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2017 Château de la Bonneliere Rive Gauche Chinon Rosé** \$10
Cabernet Franc
This wine comes from the alluvial soils on the left bank of the Vienne river composed of sand and gravel. The freshness of the Cabernet Franc planted in these soils creates a fresh aromatic rosé. Organic. 13% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2019 Cantarelle Madam Côtes de Provence Rosé** \$15
Reveals itself in a glass of light rosé with delicate violet reflections, revealing a floral bouquet with aromas of citrus fruits such as grapefruit, some lime and delicate hints of orange blossom. 12% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2019 Trasiego Quartz Rosé** \$11
100% Pinot Noir
A Chilean rosé from Leyda Valley, where the cool ocean breezes keeps the grapes crisp and fresh. Fresh peachy aromas with citrus and red fruit flavors. 13% alcohol by volume

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THREE BUBBLES

- **Domaine Brazilier Methode Traditionelle Brut** \$10
100% Pieneau d'Aunis
This sparkling pineau d'aunis brut rosé is absolutely delightful, so fresh, with snappy citrus and wild red berry aromas and flavors. the creamy mousse makes it an irresistible sparkler to enjoy at lunch or dinner, on its own or with a range of cuisines
12.5% alcohol by volume

- **Cune Cava Brut** \$11
50% Xarelo, 35% Macabeo, 15% Parellada
A rich and crisp Cava with more body than you'd expect for the price. 11.5% alcohol by volume

- **JP Chenet Brut Blanc de Blanc** \$12
Airén, Ugni Blanc
Great bubbles for the price. A very expressive bouquet highlighting subtle notes of lime fruit. Fresh and lively on the palate, a perfect balance between fruit and acidity. 11% alcohol by volume

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
