

SIX REDS

- **2017 Domaine Vetriccie Île de Beauté Rouge** \$11
40% Niellucciu, 30% Sciaccarellu, 20% Merlot, 10% Syrah
A great Corsican red with aromas of black olive, currant, a hint of violet and licorice and rounded with spice. The wine is fleshy and medium bodies with fresh blackberry.

- **2016 Saint-Jacques de Siran Bordeaux Supérieur** \$15
Château Siran dates back to 1428. At one point in time, it was owned the grandparents of the famous French painter, Toulouse Lautrec. Their Saint-Jacques cuvée is sourced from a plot adjacent to their Margaux holdings, but outside that appellation and hence much more affordable. This wine is smooth, rich, and beautifully structured.

- **2016 Valdipiatta Rosso di Montepulciano** \$13
90% Sangiovese, 5% Caniolo Nero, 5% Mammolo
Aromas of toast, scorched underbrush, leather and a whiff of spiced berry lead the nose. On the palate, the wine has well-balanced tannins, vibrant acidity, and dark fruit notes. **Was \$19 Now \$13**

- **2013 Marques de Griñon Caliza** \$15
40% Petit Verdot, 35% Graciano, 25% Syrah
Caliza is the Spanish word for limestone. It aged in French barriques for ten months. It has a fresh, herbal, balsamic nose with contained ripeness. The palate is medium-bodied, with unnoticeable tannins and good freshness. **Was \$20 now \$15**

- **2013 Verum Malbec Reserva** \$15
Patagonia
From a sustainably-grown vineyard in Alto Valle de Rio Negro, Patagonia Argentina. Verum Malbec expresses its unique Patagonia terror, showcasing fresh flavors of violets and red fruits along with spice notes The wine is much more elegant than Medoza's full bodied wines. **Was \$28 now \$15**

- **2012 Weinbau Erich Sattler** \$12
Zweigelt
Burgenland
Zweigelt is Austria's most widely planted red. The wine matures on the lees for six months and is bottled after minimal filtration. This wine is dense and juicy with hints of strawberries and fresh herbs on the nose. It exhibits ripe fruit on the palate, reminiscent of plum with pleasant acidity and pepper. It is an elegant wine with a spicy balanced finish. 13% alcohol by volume. **Was \$20, now \$12**

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SIX WHITES

- **2017 Boedecker Cellars Pinot Gris Whillamette Valley** \$12
A rich Oregon PG. Ripe and polished, bursting with peach and apricot aromatics with lively flavors of melon and citrus on the palate combine with solid acidity and a light, creamy texture. Organic. **Was \$17 now \$12**

- **2017 Le Moerette Lugana Mandolara** \$15
Turbiana
Produced from the Turbiana grapes, that grow in the narrow strip of land on the shore of Lake Garda. Its characteristic balanced bouquet is pleasant and fresh, with flower sensations. At taste it is attractively fruity, with apple and peach hints characterized, at the end, by a trace of bitter almonds. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$21, now \$15**

- **2016 Viñedo de los Vientos Estival Blanc** \$12
60% Gewurztraminer, 30% Chardonnay, 10% Moscato
From Uruguay, the Estival is a blend, but it's fermented all together. The Chardonnay is harvested unripe like in "Champagne" to get the high acidity to balance the fully ripe Gewurztraminer and the Moscato Bianco's fruity flavors. You can feel the sweetness of the Gewurz and Moscato and the sharp acidity of the Chardonnay with lots of different flavors in between. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$18 Now \$12**

- **2019 Viv á Vias Le Ballon Blanc** \$11
50% Vermento, 50% Sauvignon Blanc
Le Ballon produces affordable and delicious organic wines in Languedoc-Roussillon France. A fresh and crisp style with notes of stone fruit and white flowers. An ideal aperitif wine to be enjoyed alongside seafood or onion tarte. Organic. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2019 Vignerons du Pallet Les Petites Sardines** \$10
Muscadet Sèvre et Maine
A good value Muscadet. The nose, dominated by the fresh aromas brought by the sea spray of the Atlantic, also has light floral notes. The wine is characterized by its finesse and has a slight pearliness that is pleasant on the palate. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Bovio Alessandro** \$13
Chardonnay
Langhe
Aromas of fresh hay and papaya. Rich in texture with flavors of tropical fruit and lean acidity. 13% alcohol by volume. **Was, \$18 now \$13**

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SIX MORE REDS

- **2016 Dashe Les Enfants Terribles** \$15
Grenache
Dry Creek Valley
The grapes come from a dry, rocky riverbed north of Healdsburg where nightly fogs help maintain high acidity. Low interference in the cellar and maturation in large barrels, leaves all the pretty minerality and luscious red berries on the nose and palate of this wine. Bright and lithe, the wine shows vibrant red fruit (raspberry, currant), peppery spice and dusky tannins. Native Fermentation. **Was \$28 now \$15**

- **2016 Château de la Brandille Bordeaux Supérieur** \$13
65% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Cabernet Franc
From 40-year-old vines located close to the vineyards of Saint-Emilion, this Château has been in the Borderie family for five generations. The house style is classic: savory and elegant with ample fruit graced with a dusting of mineral aromatics. 13.5% alcohol by volume

- **2016 Bargemone Provence Rouge** \$15
40% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Syrah, 30% Grenache.
This classic, unoaked red is rich, ripe, and spicy, offering the essence of Provence with its layers of raspberry/blackberry fruit, light garrigue notes, soft, plush tannins, and long, lingering finish.
Was \$20 Now \$15

- **2019 Château Vaugelas Cuvée Fut de Chene Corbieres** \$13
60% Syrah, 20% Grenache, 15% Carignan, 5% Mouvèdre
An old favorite Southern French red with a nose of red fruits (strawberry, raspberry) leading to more dominant black cherry aromas. Lightly spicy, with peppery notes finishing with vanilla and licorice.

- **2019 Vic á Vias Le Ballon Rouge** \$11
50% Grenache, 30% Cinsault, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon
Grenache, Cinsault and Cabernet Sauvignon varietals blend agreeably to create a deep cherry, pomegranate and earthy nose. Medium-intensity meets medium-acidity to appease any porch-wine seeker. Organic.
12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2018 Rivera Rupícolo** \$11
50% Montepuliano, 40% Nero di Troia, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon
This great everyday red from Puglia shows a bouquet of wild red berry fruit; smooth and juicy, with a well balanced with subtly tannic finish. 13% alcohol by volume

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THREE PINK

- **2019 Château Barbebelles Cuvée Madeleine d'Aix en Provence Rosé** \$16
50% Grenache, 25% Syrah, 25% Cinsault
A smoothly textured rosé, this is ripe with tangy mandarin and lime flavors allied with ripe red-berry fruits. The classic blend of Grenache, Syrah and Cinsault gives pepper, some light structure and a fresh aftertaste. 13% alcohol by volume

- **2019 Terra Nostra Corsican Rosé** \$11
Sciaccarellu
A rosé wine from Corsica. It has a slightly spicy nose (clove type) with hints of red berries (gooseberry). The mouth is frank and lively, supple with grain and fruit. **Was \$15 now \$11**

- **2019 Bernard et Ollier Coste Montrose Rosé** \$13
65% Grenache, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Syrah
Languedoc
Grown in rocky soils, The Montrose offers up lovely notes of red berries, white peach, citrus, and fresh herb. Possessing a wonderful combination of roundness and freshness, it is elegant and delightful. 12.5% alcohol by volume

THREE BUBBLES

- **Maset Cava Brut** \$13
40% Xarel·lo, 30% Macabeau, 30% Parelada
Aged 12 months in bottle this Cava has Creamy, well-integrated bubble. Aromas of fruit (apple) and white flowers (chamomile flower) over a refreshing lemon and anise background. Herbal memories of ageing (brioche). On the palate, it is smooth and balanced, with a long, slightly sweet finish. 11.5% alcohol by volume

- **San Martino Prosecco Extra Dry** \$11
Glera
This extra dry sparkling prosecco has notes of pear and stone fruit with small, fast-rising bubbles. 11% alcohol by volume

- **Proa Cava Brut Méthode Traditionell** \$13
40% Macabeo, 30% Xarel·lo, 30% Parellada
Translucent pale yellow with foamy head effervescence. Nice composition with a quite dry profile, well-balanced and with a rather long refined taste. 11.5% alcohol by volume

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
