

SIX REDS

- **2019 Château Haut Pourjac, Bordeaux Rouge** \$13
65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot, 10% Petit Verdot
A Cab heavy Bordeaux with full aromas of red and black fruit (cassis, blackcurrant). The palate is elegant and round with expressive structure and velvety tannins, a very well-balanced wine.

- **2016 Vina Santa Marina, Equus** \$12
85% Tempranillo, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Syrah
A lively, brilliant wine with impetuous fruit, a rich texture and a subtle aftertaste of vanilla and toasted coffee.
Was \$14 now \$12

- **2019 San Lorenzo, il Casolare** \$15
50% Sangiovese, 50% Montepulciano
Marche
A blend of 60-year-old vines from the Marche region, San Lorenzo declassified their upper tier wine this year and put it into the Il Casolare. Very rich and succulent. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- **2018 La Cabotte, Colline Côtes du Rhône** \$15
Grenache Syrah
The Coline uses Carignan and Cinsault to zing up the Grenache and Syrah, and Mourvedre to add stuffing. Plenty of spice and earth are coated with sweet fruit. Blackberries and raspberries are in abundance, with some pepper. In the mouth it is rich and unctuous. Bright fruit with good acidity balance out this dark red wine. Bottled unfiltered. Organic, biodynamic

- **2018 Odfjell, Armador** \$10
90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot
Valle de Maipo
Outstanding value from the winemaking team at Odfjell, such briary aromas of forest berries and cedary notes with fresh purple flowers here, too. The palate has good depth of fruit, in the purple-berry spectrum, and a fine web of fresh, juicy tannin. Organic

- **2019 Casata Monticello, Dolcetto d'Asti** \$11
A good little value Dolcetto from the the Sperone family, who have been engaged in wine production for four generations. Not Cru by any means but a great everyday drinker with pure Dolcetto character.
13% alcohol by volume

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SIX WHITES

- ☐ **2017 Thymiopoulos Apostolos, Alma White** \$15
70% Xinomavro, 30% Malagouzia
A very different white made from a red grape (Xinomavro) and a white one (malagouzia). The wine has lovely floral notes of Malagouzia but also “something different” as a result of the Xinomavro. The wine is medium bodied with medium to high acidity and a lingering finish. Biodynamic. 12% alcohol by volume
Was \$19 now \$15

- ☐ **2019 Colosi, Bianco** \$8
50% Inzolia, 50% Catarratto
A great little value white from Sicily. Aromas of flowers and vibrant fruit. Round with generous fruit and excellent length. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- ☐ **2019 Domaine de Marcé, Touraine Oisly Coulée Galante** \$15
Sauvignon Blanc
Touraine Oisly is a relatively new Appellation for the very best Sauvignon from Touraine. Intense, aromatic, with herby, grassy and gooseberry aromas. Deep flavors on the palate, with ripe fruit and some tropical hints. Fresh, dry with a long, crisp, elegant finish.

- ☐ **2020 La Yunta, Torrontés** \$10
A fresh Argentinian white. Notably aromatic of green melon and white peach. It has balanced citrus flavor with a touch of French oak to provide a crisp yet lingering finish. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- ☐ **2018 Budureasca, Vine In Flames** \$15
Fetească Regală
Romania
Fetească Regală is a white grape variety, created in the 1930s, in Mureş County, Romania. It is a natural crossing of Grasă and Fetească albă. It makes a fresh and savory white wine. The wine has a medium lemon color, with a pleasant nose of ripe pear and wild flowers. The body is delicate, with high acidity and aromas of peach, yellow apple and a short to medium aftertaste.

- ☐ **2019 La-Vis Dipinti, Sauvignon Blanc** \$12
Intense aromas of fig, nutmeg and peach on the nose. Medium-bodied with vibrant citrus fruit and undertones of white pepper. Clean and bright with a crisp finish.

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SIX MORE REDS

- ☐ **2020 La Puerta, Malbec Famatina Valley** **\$12**
Aromas full of fruit with hints of violets mingle with flavors of ripened plum and cherries accompanying this wine's characteristically smooth and sweet tannins. This unique and delightful Malbec is well-balanced across the palate with a long and persistent finish. 13.5% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2018 Protos, Tinto Fino** **\$15**
100% Tempranillo
"Ribera del Duero" was this winery's until 1982. Protos gifted the name to the region, creating the Ribera del Duero appellation. The Tinto Fino has black fruit aromas, well balances with the oak, bringing sweet spicy and nice toasty notes. It is tasty, sweet, well-balanced, with pleasant smooth tannins and toasty reminders on the finish.
- ☐ **2015 Vie del Conte, Veneto Merlot** **\$9**
From vineyards on the border between the Veneto and Friuli, in North-East of Italy. It has pleasant aromas of cherry and violet, currants and raspberries. The taste is fresh and fruity, and very easy to like.
12% alcohol by volume
- ☐ **2018 Château La Maroutine, Bordeaux Rouge** **\$11**
80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon
The nose is attractive with cherry and strawberry notes that are supported by nice toasted notes. On the palate, the attack is smooth and round with nice soft tannins leaving the place for round, soft fruit.
- ☐ **2018 Domaine de Fages, Cahors** **\$15**
85% Malbec, 15% Merlot
Aromas of ripe blackberry, plum and red fruits flint and graphite. The palate is full round and balanced with lots of juicy cherry prune and mineral notes, a hint of clove with a long pleasant finish. Organic
- ☐ **2018 Castro Ventosa, El Casto de Valtuille Bierzo** **\$15**
Mencia
A very expressive wine, with a lively nose and great aromatic potential, with hints of wild berries, cherry, raspberry and blackberry. The palate offers ample velvety sensations, with a very expressive fruity finish. Overall it is harmonious, balanced and concentrated. 13.5% alcohol by volume

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PINK

- **2019 Cavalchina, Bardolino Chiaretto** \$13
55% Corvina, 35% Rondinella, 10% Molinara
Fresh and savory, this tangy rosé has aromas of red berry, peach and yellow wild flower. On the crisp palate, vibrant acidity accompanies strawberry, sour cherry and baking-spice notes before a lemon-thyme close. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$17, now \$13**

- **2019 Sparkman, Cellars This Old Porch Rosé** \$15
TOP is bone dry, full of flowers and luscious red fruit flavors. It's not from Provence, but is kinda intended to drink like it is. **Was \$22 now \$15**

- **2019 Domaine de l'Amauve, Le Rosé d'Yvonne** \$13
Grenache, Cinsault, Carignan
Citrus fruits, redcurrant and a subtle hint of flowers and spice. Ethereal in flavour, with a welcomed fresh and aromatic palate. An easy-drinking and refined rosé with restrained exuberance. 12.5% alcohol by volume
Was \$15, now \$13

BUBBLES

- **2019 Montelliana, Millesimato Prosecco Rosé** \$12
Glera and Pinot Noir
This Millesimato (vintage) Charmat-method sparkling wine has fine and persistent bubbles. With a good structure, the nose is delicate, with floral aromas and hints of red fruit. In the mouth it is fresh and elegant, with pleasant returns of fruity aromas. 11% alcohol by volume. **Was \$14, now \$12**

- **Valdo Marca, Oro Prosecco** \$15
Glera
A fine perlage, and crisp fruity palate with hints of golden delicious apples and white fruits. Crisp and refreshing. 11% alcohol by volume

- **Weingut Resch, Anna Lioba Sket Rosé Cuveé** \$12
70% Pinot Noir, 30% Chardonnay
From the Klosterberg vineyard in the Mosel planted in 1989. Fermented using wild native yeast in stainless. Andreas Resch is the fifth generation winemaker at Weingut Resch. It was started by his great (several times) grandmother in 1873 when she was 36-years-old. A widow no less, but determined to save her bankrupt estate and create a life for her children with a sustainable business, she single handedly founded Weingut Resch. This sparkling cuvée is named after her. 12% alcohol by volume. **Was \$20 Now \$12**

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
