- ❑ **2018 Real Companhia Velha Porca de Murca**

30% Touriga Nacional, 30% Touriga Franca, 20% Tinta Barroca, 20% Tinta Roriz

A lighter style of Douro red. With no oak ageing, it shows a clean, deep and bright ruby coloured wine with red berry and cherry notes showing intensity and freshness. Ripe fruit flavours, excellent structure, velvety and very well balanced.

- ❑ **2020 J Mourat Collection Rouge**

Pinot Noir, Cabernet Franc, Negrette, and Gamay

Val de Loire

From the area south of Muscadet known as Fiefs Vendéens, this unique red blend has a juicy cherry nose with a little kick of fresh orange zest. The fruit is ripe, sappy and jewel-bright: redcurrant and cranberry, with a pencil-graphite slender minerality

- ❑ **2019 La Ferla Nero d' Avola**

This Nero d'Avola retains great freshness despite the long Sicilian summer days. This juicy red has a soft, full mouthfeel with cherry and plum flavor with good length on the finish

- ❑ **2019 Domaine de la Brunely Ventoux**

50% Grenache, 30% Syrah, 20% Carrignan

Notes of toasted cacao and licorice accent plump, pristine red cherry and raspberry in this sun-drenched but briskly structured blend of Syrah, Grenache and Carignan. Sourced from limestone soils, it's a freshly balanced, easy-drinking sip rimmed by soft, chalky tannins and a subtly mineral finish.

- ❑ **2020 Finca Os Cobatos Ceba Viejas**

Single Vineyard Mencia

This “old vine” Mencia is produced from 65-year-old vines cultivated in northwestern Bierzo. The nose is intense with dominant aromas of red berries backed by subtle floral notes of violets. Nine months of aging in French and American oak barrels lends a hint of toasted oak and spices to the bouquet.

## 6 Whites

- ❑ **2020 Rive Droite, Rive Gauche Côtes du Rhône Blanc** \$12  
Grenache Blanc, Bourboulenc, and Viognier  
from vineyards on both banks of the Rhône, this tasty a Côtes du Rhône Blanc is dry but creamy with delicate hints of apricot.  
Natural, No Sulfites Added

- ❑ **2015 Pierre Sparr Pinot Gris Grande Reserve** \$15  
A perfect match for Asian food. Mellow notes of ripe pear and fresh earth combine on the nose. The palate majors in ripe juicy pears, boosted by a touch of residual sweetness. The aromas are fresh and easy. Drink this while they are at their peak. The finish is just off dry. Was \$20 Now \$15
  
- ❑ **2014 Laroche Bourgogne Blanc** \$15  
Chardonnay  
With grapes coming from the Mâcon region in southern Burgundy, this is ripe, fresh and roundly crisp. With attractive acidity and a sweetened lemon character. This wine has filled out with a bit of age.

- ❑ **2020 Hubert Brochard Les Carisannes** \$14  
Sauvignon Blanc  
Just over the border from Sancerre. Les Carisannes shows classic aromas and flavors of citrus, fresh herbs, and minerals. This Vin de Pays du Val de Loire is lighter in weight and texture than Sancerre but its fresh and fruity character make it a delicious wine for warm-weather refreshment and simple food pairings.
  
- ❑ **2020 Musio Pinot Grigio Delle Venezie** \$13  
The Mussio stands out above a lot of insipid PG that kind of floods the market. Fruity, balanced, hints of nuts and toasted bread. vegan

- ❑ **2020 Long Story Short New Zealand Sauv Blanc** \$12  
100% Sauvignon Blanc  
Bright aromas of white peach, guava and lemon zest. Floral nuances reminiscent of honeysuckle and elderflower reflect the wild flora and fauna that grow alongside our Wairau Valley vineyards. Mouth: Brimming with juicy flavors and bright acidity,

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## Three Rosé

- ☐ **2020 Routas Coteaux Varois en Provence Rosé** **\$14**  
46% Cinsault, 30% Grenache, 15% Syrah, 9% Cabernet Sauvignon  
Freshly cut watermelon, ripe peach aromas and floral notes lead to a palate alive with wild strawberries and hints of mineral notes. Crisp acidity and a refreshing finish.
- ☐ **2020 La Domitienne Mourvedre Rosé** **\$11**  
Like Bandol but not the price? This languedoc Rosé is you pick. The silky texture adds to the flavors of peach, nectar, and cherry blossom to produce a complex and crisp quaffrer. Was \$14 Now \$11
