Intense and complex bouquet, with berry and cherry aromas and flavors, and well-integrated hints of vanilla. On the palate, it is full-bodied, with velvety ripe tannins, and a long finish. ☐ 2020 Château Pierre Bise, Schistes Anjou Villages \$23 70% Cabernet Franc, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon A mineral heavy Cab Franc from The Anjou. Organic. 12% alcohol by volume □ 2018 Montfaucon, Lirac \$20 60% Grenache, 30% Syrah, 10% Cinsault Just across the Rhone river from Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Lirac extends itself on the low hills alongside the river planted on very old terraces made up of rocky pebbles. This Lirac rouge shows notes of lavender, cinnamon dusted black cherries and plums. Bright acidity and slightly dusty tannins provide a nice structure. ☐ 2014 Agnes Paquet, Auxey Duresses \$34 Pinot Noir Aromas of small red berry fruits explode from the glass mingled with subtle notes of earth and underbrush. On the palate the wine is fresh, vibrant and juicy with lively acidity and compact, integrated tannis. Flavors of alpine strawberry, raspberry and pomegranate cascade across your mouth in a long, concentrated wave that flow into a long, subtle finish. □ 2018 Pablo Fallabrino, Anarkia \$20 **Tannat** Bodega Pablo Fallabrino is located 4 km's from the Atlantic Ocean in Atlantida, Uruguay, a sub region of Canelones, one of the coolest growing regions in Uruguay. The Anarkia has fruity aromas lead to notes of plum, cassis, and blackberry on the palate. Textured and mineraly with a finish filled with soft flavors of rose

The palate delivers unbelievable concentration, depth and length as all the complex mineral, fruit and herbal flavors grow build to a crescendo and monumental finish.
