

SIX REDS

- ❑ **2014 Vina Herminia Rioja Reserva** \$15
85% Tempranillo, 10% Garnacha, 5% Graciano
Unmistakably Rioja, with an excellent balance between blackcurrant and oak aromas. The palate shows a velvety texture which flows wonderfully, with a round and lingering finish. **Was \$20 now \$15**

- ❑ **2017 Chanson Pere & Fils Bourgogne Rouge** \$15
Pinot Noir
Super "everyday" Burgundy. Aromas of ripe berries (raspberries and cherries) mixed with liquorice. Well-structured. Deep and tight texture. Well-integrated tannins. **Was \$22 Now \$15**

- ❑ **2015 De Vescovi Ulzbach Teroldego Rotaliano** \$15
Coming from 50-to-70 year old vines, and aged for 10 months in French oak vats, Teroldego is a native grape of Trentino. It is related to Syrah, Lagrein, and Pinot Noir The wine displays concentrated aromas of juicy dark currants, violets, graphite, and stony minerals on the finish. **Was \$22 Now \$15**

- ❑ **2016 Veema Languedoc Rouge** \$13
45% Grenache, 35% Syrah, 20% Mourvèdre
Leather and smoked meat give a brawny edge to a nose of pure, fragrant black fruit, brown spice, vanilla, and violets. A crack of grip braces one for the rush of robust plum and saturated boysenberry that courses across the palate, gaining power and peppery depth on the way to a long, savory finish laced with anise, espresso, and a bloody tang of iron. **Was \$18 now \$13**

- ❑ **2020 Cala Civetta Ciliegiole** \$14
Maremma
Ciliegiole is a traditional Tuscan blending varietal here enjoying its own small spotlight in coastal Tuscany. Fragrant and fresh with lots of energy and flavor, the woody potpourri aromas lead to a soft mouthfeel of plump cherry and red plum, generous flavors that linger on the stretchy taffy-textured finish.

- ❑ **2019 Domaine Philémon Croix de la Bouscarié** \$14
Duras
Gaillac
This 100% Duras shows off notes of violets, Mediterranean herbs like sage and fennel, robust berry fruit and a peppery finish. All with a crown cap. Organic

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SIX WHITES

- ❑ **2019 Fattoria Svetoni Opera**

100% Vermentino

Intense and persistent bouquet with notes of peach blossom, jasmine, and ripe white fruit. Well balanced and persistent that makes it fresh and pleasant. 12% alcohol by volume

- ❑ **2021 Bonny Doon Central Coast Picpoul**

90% Picpoul, 10% Grenache Blanc

"Picpoul" translates to "lip stinger." It is a high acid, savory, white, rustic grape variety, especially well-suited for seafood. This wine shines with aromas and flavors of dried savory spices, earth, and tart fruit.

- ❑ **Castillo Perelada Pescador Blanc**

60 Macabeo, 20 Xarello, 20 Parellada

Basically a still Cava, but there is nothing wrong with that. This wine isn't about complexity; it's about chuggability. Both the nose and palate are dominated by bright, zippy lemon citrus and rocky minerality, like lemon water filtered through a rock garden and spritzed by salty sea breezes. 11.5% alcohol by volume

- ❑ **2020 Dozoe Rías Baixas Albarino.**

97.8% Albariño, 1% Loureiro, .5% Caiño Blanco, .4% Trexadura, .3% Godello

Crisp and refreshing with aromas of fruit, white flowers and mineral nuances which come from the vineyard. Persistent in the mouth and well – balanced in acidity maintaining the citric notes. 12.5% alcohol by volume

- ❑ **2020 Vetricchie Île de Beauté Blanc**

50% Vermentinu, 50% Chardonnay

Corsica

A great everyday white. The wine is mineral and rich with citrus aromas on the nose. Lively as it hits the palate, it develops into a rich, smooth, and unctuous mouthfeel.

- ❑ **2017 Turasan Emir**

The Emir grape only grows in one place in the world – Cappadocia, Turkey. The nose has notes of citrus peel and white flowers along with pears and fennel pollen. On the palate it comes across as balanced, bright and lively with refreshing floral and Meyer lemon.

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THREE PINKS

- ❑ **2020 Château Terrebonne Côtes de Provence Rosé** \$13
25% Cinsaut , 15 % Syrah, 40% Grenache, 10% Ugni blanc, 10% Vermentino
A crisp Provence Rosé Intense nose of fresh strawberry, small red fruits and white peach. Round on the palate, this rose is well balanced thanks to its pleasant acidity. **Was \$16, now \$13**

- ❑ **2020 Hault Blanville Solal** \$12
50% Grenache Gris, 50% Cinsault
Languedoc
The nose of this rosé starts off with delicate scents of red cherry and strawberry hull that are hit by a dusting of garrigue herbs. It's light and clean in the mouth, with bright acidity and a lime-fueled citrus impression that carries through to the close alongside notes of watermelon rind. 12.5% alcohol by volume. **Was \$15 now \$12**

- ❑ **2017 Westmont Pinot Noir Rosé** \$12
This aged Oregon Rosé is drinking nicely. Smooth notes of strawberry, sweet cherry and the fresh acidity.

ONE SPARKLING

- ❑ **Poderi Morini Morosé Spumante Brut Rosè** \$14
Centesimino (aka Savignon Rosso)
From Emilia-Romagna, this textured and creamy rose is made from an all but lost grape varietal. Lots of fruit and herbal elements~red berries~from raspberry to cherry as well as something like a fennel or tarragon herbalness here. 12% alcohol by volume

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
